Star Wine List celebrated the top wine lists in Denmark

On October 23, Star Wine List of the Year celebrated the great wine lists in Denmark for the fourth time. The Grand Prix was won by Grimal in Copenhagen, also winner of the Best Short List.

"Once again the passion, drive and inspiration of Danish Sommeliers is shining through the many wine lists we received," says Jury member Julie Dupouy-Young about the Danish wine lists.

Star Wine List of the Year is a celebration of the great wine lists in the world and the teams behind them. The prize was awarded in eleven categories, and the winners in each category got a Gold Star and several also qualified for the international final (to be held in June 2024). For the first time ever we also had a category for the Best Digestif List, presented by Juuls.

Best Short List

The best wine list with fewer than 200 listings Gold Star: **Grimal, Copenhagen**

Best Newcomer List

Recognizes a venue that has opened recently Gold Star: **Josephine Vinhandel & Bar, Copenhagen**

Best Digestif List

Recognizes the best post dinner spirits list, a category presented by Juuls Gold Star: **Alchemist, Copenhagen**
