Star Wine List celebrated Nordic countries' best wine lists

On October 9, Star Wine List of the Year celebrated the great wine lists in the Nordic countries. Gold stars were given to wine bars and wine restaurants in four of the countries.

"The judging process was guite a challenge and scores were really tight, as the level of wine lists was high. I was impressed by their complexity, depth and a clever, inventive touch," says jury member Piotr Pietras MS.

Sweden won three gold stars, with Norway and Denmark picking up two golds each. Finland won one award. Star Wine List of the Year is a celebration of the great wine lists in the world and the teams behind them. The prize was awarded in eight categories. Nyetimber and Austrian Wine were category sponsors.
