Star Wine List to celebrate Austria's top wine lists

On 15 June 2025, Star Wine List will celebrate the best wine lists in Austria for the fourth time, with an awards ceremony held in Vienna.

The Star Wine List of the Year competition recognises the greatest wine lists in the world – and the teams behind them. It is free to enter for all restaurants and wine bars in each specified region, with winners receiving a Gold Star listing on the Star Wine List website and app for the coming year. In Austria, prizes will be awarded in eight categories, and the winners will also qualify for the International Final, to be held the following day, on 16 June 2025.

“Austria is not only an exciting wine growing country but also a great place to enjoy gastronomy and exciting wine lists,” says Krister Bengtsson, Founder and Publisher of Star Wine List. “We can’t wait to go back to Austria to celebrate with the Austrian sommeliers and restaurateurs in June.”

The Austrian wine list awards will take place in Vienna on 15 June 2025.

International categories

- Grand Prix – the best list overall
- Best Long List – for wine lists with more than 600 references
- Best Medium-Sized List – 200-600 references
- Best Short List – fewer than 200 references
- Best By the Glass List
- Best Sparkling Wine List
- Best Newcomer List
- Sustainable Wine List – recognises a wine list that has put extra emphasis on the wine program’s overall impact, including vine growing, winemaking, packaging and transport. Assessed via a questionnaire during the application process.
