THE BENTLEY BUILDING



The heritage-listed building in which Bentley Restaurant + Bar is located has existed since 1929. Originally built for John Fairfax & Sons the inter-war renaissance palazzo-styled edifice housed Australia's oldest surviving newspaper, The Sydney Morning Herald pioneering within the city of Sydney.

The final edition of The Sydney Morning Herald to be printed in the building was dated December 21st 1955, after which it was sold to the then Bank of New South Wales. It was not until 2000 that the building was reborn as a five star hotel and in 2013 Brent Savage and Nick Hildebrandt brought their acclaimed Crown Street restaurant to the building's grand vestibule.

SPARKLING + CHAMPAGNE STYLES

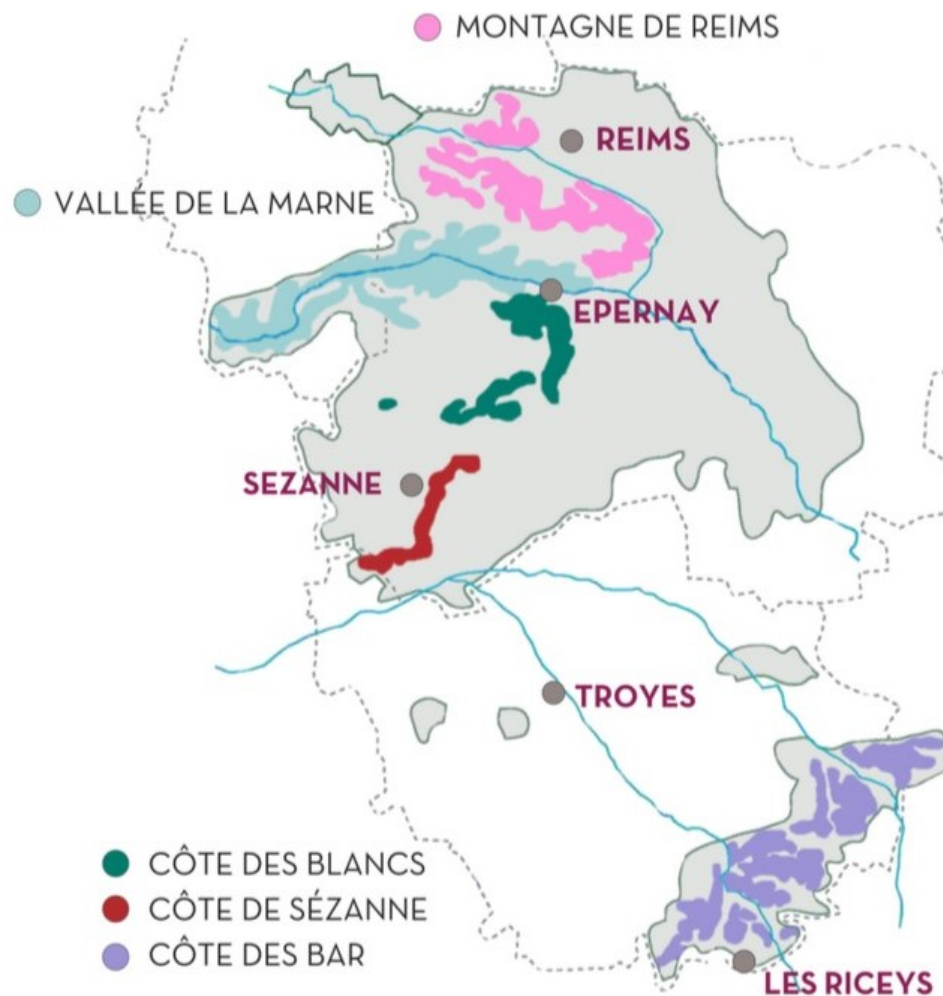
Coco Chanel said it best: "I only drink Champagne on two occasions, when I am in love and when I am not."

Through centuries of refinement Champagne has become the world's leading sparkling wine and the vinous embodiment of luxury and celebration.

Many names have shaped the region's history, the Benedictine monk Dom Pérignon, and his lasting contribution of blending different grape varieties (Assemblage). Equally famous, Madame Barbe-Nicole Ponsardin, the Veuve ("widow") Clicquot, which pioneered the process of remuage, or riddling. Or Jean-Antoine Chaptal, the French chemist for whom the process of chaptalization is named.

Nowadays the beverage comes in multiple styles: whether from a small grower or an iconic Champagne house, there seems to be a common purpose, the expression of terroir.

NV Louis de Grenelle Saumur 'Ivoire' (Brut) 18

Loire Valley, France

Located in the heart of the valley of kings, the Val de Loire; the Estate was founded in 1859.

Still independent and family run Maison Louis de Grenelle has passed down its expertise through the generations.

The Cuvée Ivoire showcase a crisp fruit driven quality, with persistent floral aromas.

NV Gosset 'Grande Réserve' (Brut) 32

Ay, Champagne, France

The oldest wine house in Champagne, established by Pierre Gosset in 1584. Made from

45% Chardonnay, 45% Pinot Noir and 10% Meunier, aged 3 years on lees. Subtle and fresh, both on the nose and the palate, delicate creamy texture with a clean soft finish; a true Icon in the region.

2013 Salima & Alain Cordeuil 'Clair Obscur' (Brut Nature) 38

Noé-les-Mallets, Champagne, France

Salima and Alain have been cultivating 4ha organically in the Côte des Bars area since 2009.

The Clair Obscur is 55% Chardonnay and the balance Pinot Noir, coming from two Lieu dits, Les Charmottes and La Commelle Blet.

The wine is precise with lively acidity supporting warm and generous yellow fruits.

NV/22 Pertois-Moriset 'Rosé Blanc' Grand Cru (Extra Brut) 39

Le Mesnil-sur-Oger, Champagne, France

Yves Pertois and Janine Moriset created the Domaine in 1951; nowadays their grandson Dominique and his wife Florence, farm a little over 20 hectares of vineyard spread across a number of villages.

A delicate Rosé Champagne with just a touch of Pinot Noir bringing layered complexity.

NV/21 Pertois-Lebrun 'L'Ambiteuse' Grand Cru (Extra Brut) 22 43

Cramant, Champagne, France

L'ambiteuse by Pertois-Lebrun Blanc de Blancs Grand Cru is made from 100% Chardonnay.

Vinification occurred in fût de chêne and ageing on its own yeasts for at least five years before the final low dosage of only 2.5g/l is acquired. Fine citrus and chalky notes evolving towards intense

pastry, almonds and nutty aromas. The family started producing wine in the early 1900s, but it was only in 1955 that the Pertois-Lebrun brand was born.

2012 Charles Heidsieck (Brut) 37 70

Reims, Champagne, France

Created in 1851, by the charismatic and adventurous Charles Heidsieck, the Champagne House has evolved through the years into an emblematic and unique estate.

This cuvée has been meticulously selected from 10 Grands and Premiers Crus, enticing for its pleasant smoothness, rich mouthfeel and the saline freshness that is so typical of the House.

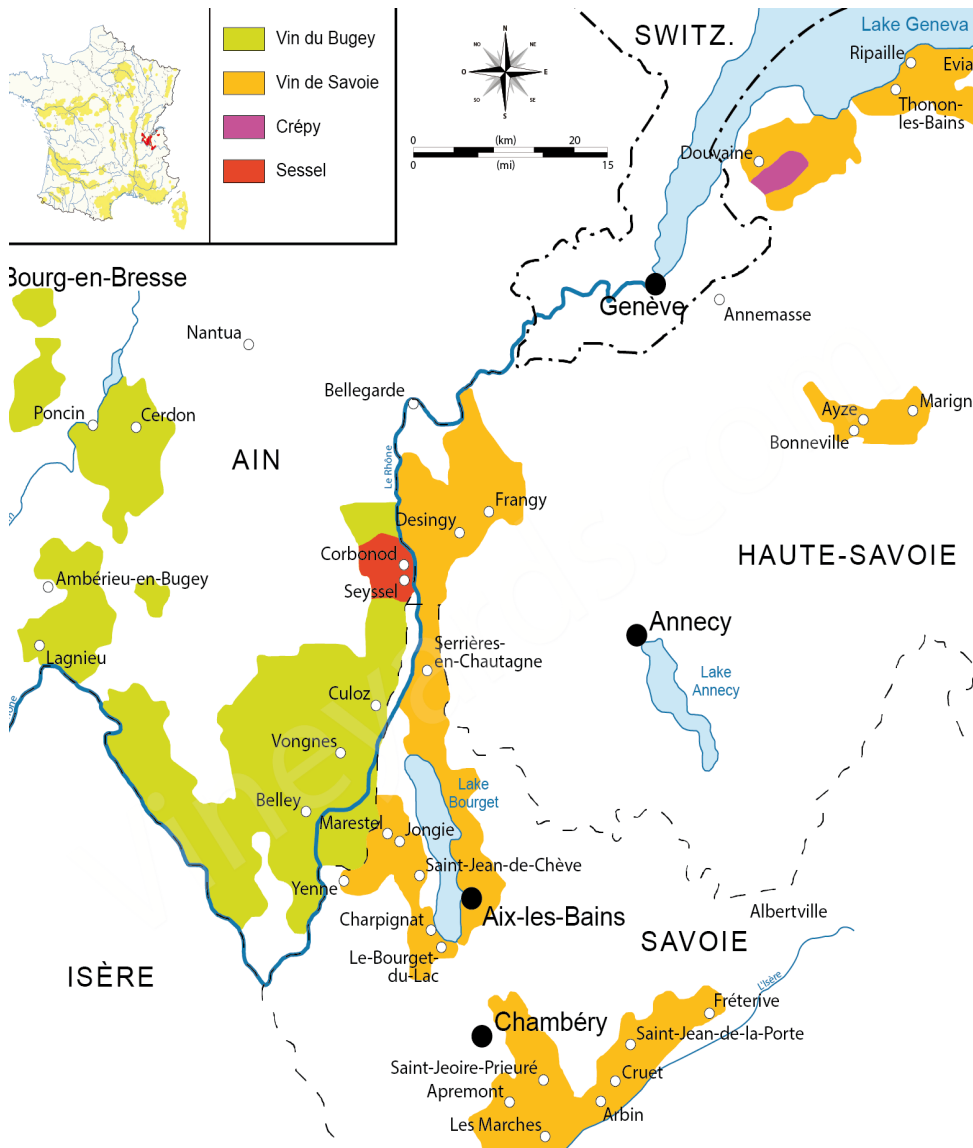
Savoie, France

The picturesque Savoie region is located in the eastern part of France, in the mountainous areas just south of Lac Léman (Lake Geneva) and the border with Switzerland.

As a wine region, Savoie consists of many isolated plots of vineyards scattered across the foothills of the Prealps mountains, spreading over four departments.

All in all, wine production is marginal, accounting for a mere 0.5% of French wines.

One of the most attractive features of the region, is the singularity of its endemic grape varieties; including some unique whites like Jacquère and Altesse, or rarely encountered reds such as Mondeuse and Persan.

Saint-Pierre d' Albigny, Savoie

Savoie's favourite grape variety for sparkling production, made by the traditional 'Methode Champenoise', this wine exhibits rich toasty characters with ripe citrus fruits, and a fresh finish.

NV **Patrick Bottex 'Bugey-Cerdon' Gamay-Poulsard** 19

Bugey, Savoie

The village of Cerdon exclusively specialises in semi-sweet sparkling Rosé, made by the 'Ancestrale Methode'; the wine shows intense flavours of candied Alpine berries with persistent bubbles.

2021 **Adrien Berlioz 'La Cuvée des Gueux' Jacquère** 24

Chignin, Savoie

The most planted grape variety in the region, perhaps the most underrated too. Here, Adrien Berlioz produced a lighter and crisper version than usual, with chalky finish and a hint of salty minerality.

2020 **Maison Bonnard 'De Montagnieu' Roussette de Savoie** 29

Seillonaz, Savoie

Sometimes called Altesse, the variety produces wines with great complexity of aromas and flavours. Delicate nose showcasing a bouquet of yellow flowers, citrus peel and stone fruits.

2016 **Domaine Saint Germain Persan** 24

Saint-Pierre d' Albigny, Savoie

The almost forgotten Persan variety can only be found in the region, the wines express the cool mountainous climate, with crunchy wild berries, intense earthy aromas and a touch of smokiness.

2017 **Prieure Saint-Christophe Mondeuse** 19 37

Chapareillan, Savoie

Without doubt Mondeuse is the flagship red variety of Savoie. Not many producers master its expression like Prieure Saint-Christophe. The wine is elegant, with fresh black fruits, peppery notes, delicate violette aromas, and mediterranean herbs.

VIN JAUNE OR SOUS VOILE 50ml 100ml

The Vin Jaune style (or Sous Voile) denotes a wine that has spent at least 5 years under a thin veil of flor while ageing in the barrel, solely made from Savagnin grape variety.

During the process, the wine will gain powerful and unic characters; expect savoury aromas of mushroom, nuts, dry citrus and stone fruit with an earthy finish.

Jura's Vin Jaune is the most iconic of the category, and has been an integral part of the regional culture.

Chateau-Chalon area is viewed as the pinnacle expression of Vin Jaune.

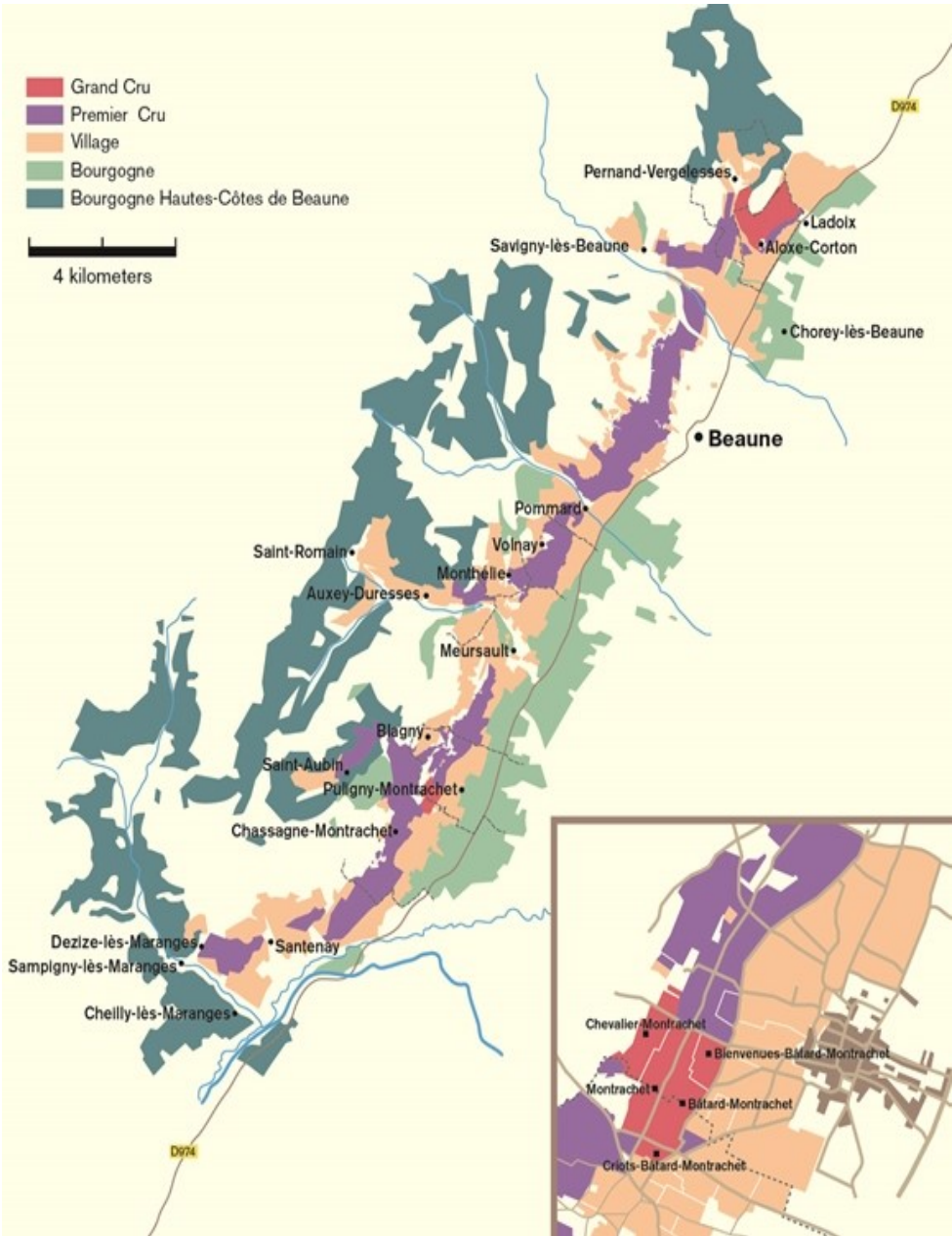
PINOT NOIR CÔTE DE BEAUNE, BURGUNDY

Piedmont, Italy
- Giuseppe Rinaldi is one of the great 'traditionalists' of Piedmont. He wants (and makes) a Barolo that is "austere, severe, that demands research. It takes time. You have to study, to think, to understand, like all of art". Known as "Citrico" (the citric one) to his peers he is a man that pulls no punches and takes no shortcuts. No surprise then that he would make a single varietal Ruche, a grape so old-fashioned that it was not deemed worthy inclusion in the DOCG rules. A simple 'vino da tavola' from anyone else but in Rinaldi's hands an exotic, sweetly-spiced wine with the dusty tannin of his Barolo but approachable now with layers of dried spices and flowers and ripe red and purple fruits.
- 2008 **Jasper Hill 'Georgia's Paddock' Shiraz** 44
Heathcote, Victoria
- Jasper Hill was established in 1975 by Ron and Elva Laughton on a prime patch of ancient red Cambrian soil and quickly stood out as one of Australia's leading Shiraz producers. At 300m elevation the vineyard benefits from cool evenings, giving a freshness to the Laughton's ripe full-bodied reds. An adherence to biodynamic principles also seems to lend a liveliness to their wines, which shows in this complex nine year-old Shiraz. Sour black plums and berry compote combine with dry spices, nutmeg and sandalwood on the way to a long, warming finish.
- 2013 **Jean Foillard 'Cote du Py' Morgon Gamay** 34
Beaujolais, France
- Jean Foillard is one of the 'Gang-of-Four' winemakers who helped reform the image of Gamay and Beaujolais in the late 1980s. A return to 'natural' farming practices and more traditional vinification methods has made Foillard a shining light in the Beaujolais and hero to young wine-makers around the world. The 'Cote du Py' vineyard is probably the region's most famous, with iron-rich schist soils yielding wines of power and opulence. Combine this with Foillard's meticulous handling and his choice to only finish his wines in old DRC barrels and you have a deep, brooding expression of Gamay. Red berries, black plums, wet earth and dried spices.
- 2015 **Les Fils de Charles Trosset 'Confidentiel' Arbin Mondeuse** 28
Savoie, France
- Few producers can call themselves 'alpine' winemakers but Louis and Joseph Trosset are making cult wines in a region more famous for its ski slopes. With a viticultural history that stretches back to the Romans the Savoie hosts a range of indigenous grape varieties including Mondeuse, a distant cousin of the Syrah and Refosco grapes. The 'Confidentiel' cuvee is made with the brother's oldest vines growing on steep slopes behind the winery. The vines produce a gamey wine with bitter black cherry, unripe strawberries and cured meat notes with anise and ground pepper on the finish.
- 2004 **Lopez de Heredia 'Viña Tondonia' Reserva Tempranillo Blend** 36
Rioja, Spain
- Established in 1877 Bodegas Lopez de Heredia has long been considered one of the great treasures of the wine world. Their winery holds a coveted site by the Haro railway station but their vineyards are planted between the Rioja Alta and Alavesa sub-regions with the most famous being 'Viña Tondonia'. Wine making for Tondonia is ultra-traditional with egg-white fining and minimal filtration (through bundled vines!) The Reserva is only released in great years and is only bottled after six years in old oak barrels. The result is a deep, complex wine with a nose

of dried flowers, leather and smoke with velvety tannins warm, macerated red fruits on the palate.

2014 Kühling-Gillot 'Ölberg GG' Trocken Riesling 32

Rheinhessen, Germany

When Carolin Spanier-Gillot was named Germany's winemaker of the year in 2015 by Falstaff Journal it recognised not only her amazing talents in the winery but also her work converting the family's vineyards to biodynamics and her efforts with the German wine association, the VDP. Her family's 200 year-old estate has holdings in five 'Grand Cru' (Grosse Lagen) sites and from south-facing vineyards in the Ölberg Grosse Lagen comes this Grosses Gewächs, a powerful yet restrained dry wine in which the oily mineral characters of the red slate soil combine with white peach and nectarine fruit to a long saline finish.

2014 Gérard Duplessis 'Montmains' 1er Cru 28

Chablis, Burgundy

Lillian Duplessis is among the new generation of winemakers in Chablis showing that there's more to the region's wines than just "minerality" and "gunflint". He converted his family's vineyards to organic farming in 2008 (achieving certification five years later), is using less and less sulphur every year and has worked around the world before returning to Chablis. The result is wines that have the focus and persistence associated with the region but also show an expression of juicy, fleshy white and yellow fruits. Welcome to the new 'old world'.

2008 Mas d'Españet 'Camille' Grenache Blanc Blend 22

Languedoc, France

Agnes and Denys Armand took over the family land in 1980 and began the task of rehabilitating the old vines. The vineyards have been certified organic since 2007 and are set among the foothills north of Montpellier and planted to the same local grapes their ancestors grew. Their 'Camille' cuvee is an oxidative wine made by aging Grenache Blanc and Viognier on skins and in large barrels for three years. The result is a complex wine with a sherry-like, savoury nose, golden plum and kumquat on the palate and a long mineral-driven finish.

2013 By Farr 'Sangreal' Pinot Noir (from magnum) 40

Geelong, Victoria

The Farr family has been making wine in the Bannockburn sub-region of Geelong since 1978 but it wasn't until 1999 that father and son team Gary and Nick managed to acquire their own vines. With more than a dozen vintages at Domaine Dujac in Burgundy and countless others in the Rhone Valley and the USA between both men, their cumulative experience has quickly seen them establish By Farr as the leading light on the Geelong peninsula.

The Sangreal vineyard is unique among the Farr's vines in that it is planted on bluestone over limestone soils with a northern exposure. It's always the first vineyard to ripen and produces a pretty and intensely aromatic wine. The 2013 is no exception to that rule with an explosive nose of cured meats, toasty oak and ripe purple fruits. Plums in abundance on the soft smoky palate.

2016 Domaine Tempier Mourvèdre Rosé 32

Bandol, France

When Lulu Tempier's father gave her and Lucien Peyraud the family estate as a wedding gift he probably didn't know it would trigger a passion in Lucien that would shape the Bandol appellation as we know it today. Few people can claim to have single-handedly resurrected the fortunes of a one grape variety but Lucien's faith in Mourvèdre to make powerful, complex and long-lived wines has given birth to some of the most exciting reds and rosés in France. Lulu, Lucien and their seven children continue to run the estate with a joy and energy that can be felt in this Mourvèdre-driven wine. With Grenache, Cinsault and Carignan making up the

difference the result is an intense and evolving nose of pomegranate, blackcurrant and myrtle. These flavours are joined on the palate by ripe stone fruit to a rich spicy finish.

2014 Jean Luc Mader 'Rosacker' Grand Cru Riesling 28
Alsace, France

Jean Luc's son Jerome runs the family estate now and he has done an amazing job building on his father's legacy. The small 9 hectare estate is run biodynamically and still farmed by hand and while the family only has two Grand cru holdings they include a prized lot of 60 year old vines at the top of the Rosacker vineyard. The Grand Cru is most famous for providing the raw material for Trimbach's famed 'Clos Ste Hune' Riesling and in Mader's hands we see again the balance of fruit, minerality, power and length that is achievable from the site. The 2014 Rosacker has a pronounced acidity classic of the vintage as well as a nose and palate filled with lime, lime blossom and white flowers. Racy, creamy, delicate and powerful all at once.

2014 Domaine de Marcoux Châteauneuf-du-Pape Grenache blend 46
Rhone Valley, France

When the Armenier sisters took over the family estate in 1996 the domaine was already a pioneer for Biodynamic viticulture in the Rhone. A tiny artisan estate (their annual production is about half that of Domaine de la Romanee Conti) means that the sister have total control over the family's 17.5Ha , which are spread over 13 different parcels and four different soil types. Marcoux didn't make an 'old vines' cuvee in 2014 which means this bottling contains all the estate's oldest vines (many well past their 100th birthday). The wine itself is seductively textured; ripe yet elegant it unfolds in layers of red and purple fruit. Complex and ethereal.

2005 Domaine Rolet 'Arbois' Pinot Noir (from Magnum) 27
Jura, France

Rolet is an estate that has been rejuvenated by the latest generation of its family. All four siblings played their role in elevating this domaine and its vineyards to highest levels in the Jura region. The family's vineyards are just east of Burgundy's Cote du Beaune planted on the lower mountain slopes of the Jura above ancient Jurassic limestone soils. This light earthy pinot noir has evolved slowly in the magnum retaining its fresh, sour acidity and red plum and berry fruits but also developing a smoky toastiness and a dry finish.

VINCENT DAUVISSAT Chablis, Burgundy

Along with François Raveneau, Dauvissat is unquestionably Chablis' greatest producer owning some of the oldest and best sites. Burghound has quoted Vincent Dauvissat as having said that "terroir is everything."

2015 L'Anglore Lirac Grenache blend 36
Rhone Valley, France

Eric Pfifferling started his professional life as a beekeeper but after inheriting 4 hectares of vines in Tavel from his grandmother in 1988 he turned his meticulous hand to winemaking and one of the great 'cult' wineries of France was born. His vines in Tavel, and now Lirac, share the same gallet-strewn soils as neighbouring Chateauneuf-du-Pape but the similarities end there. Pfifferling eschews all chemical additions, farms organically and happily declassifies his vines if he feels he can make a more interesting wine outside of the AOC regulations. This is one of Eric's few AOC wines but still bears the L'Anglore trademarks of silky smooth texture, spiced black and purple stone fruits, mouth-watering acidity and a warm moreish finish.

2013 Georges Descombes Brouilly 'Vieilles Vignes' Gamay 34

Beaujolais, France

As the unofficial fifth member of the 'Gang of Four' Georges Descombes was one of the winemakers responsible for holding back the tide of Beaujolais Nouveau in the late 80s and espousing the use of more traditional viticultural methods. No filtration, no chemicals, minimal sulphur and organic viticultural are par for the course for Descombes and he only differs from his peers by including a portion of carbonic maceration in all his cuvees.

The 2013 'Vieilles Vignes' comes from Georges' oldest vines in his home commune of Brouilly and see a year resting in oak and another in bottle before release. A precise and mineral Gamay, with a concentrated nose of pepper, kirsch and cherry jam that just keeps evolving in the glass.

2014 **Julien Labet 'en Billat' Chardonnay** 40

Jura, France

The Labet family owns 12 hectares of vines around the small southern town of Rotalier, from which they make more than 20 different cuvees every year. This represents an uncompromising commitment to terroir but perhaps surprisingly it is not what the estate is most famous for. In 1992 current patriarch, Alain Labet, started making white wines in a non-oxidative or 'topped up' style, which while common elsewhere was unheard-of in the Jura at the time.

The 'Billat' vineyard was planted by Alain's ancestors post-phylloxera on Jurassic marl and limestone. It makes a Chardonnay that is at once generous with white and yellow stone fruits and flowers but also linear and racy with ripe citrus notes. Too rich for Chablis, too lean for Côte de Beaune, so distinctly Jura.

2006 **Domaine Rolet Arbois 'Vieilles Vignes' Poulsard (from magnum)** 28

Jura, France

Rolet is an estate that has been rejuvenated by the latest generation of its family. All four siblings played their role in elevating this domaine and its vineyards to highest levels in the Jura region. The family's vineyards are just east of Burgundy's Cote du Beaune planted on the lower mountain slopes of the Jura above ancient Jurassic limestone soils.

This twelve year old Poulsard is developing slowly in magnum and still shows some beautiful ripe red berry fruit. A gentle but persistent acidity gives the wine vitality as it reveals vegetal notes of mustard leaf and tomato bush, wild strawberries, cured bacon and chopped herbs.

2016 **Thomas 'Sweetwater' Shiraz** 18

Hunter Valley, NSW

From a single vineyard planted on limestone soil at Sweetwater Ridge comes a fuller-bodied Hunter red with clove, vanilla and cured meats on the nose. In the mouth there's dried spices with red and black berries, menthol, black liquorice and drying oak tannins.

2016 **Perrault-Jadaud Vouvray 'Les Grives Soules' Chenin Blanc** 20

Loire Valley, France

This brilliantly precise dry Chenin comes from organically managed vines in the north-east of Vouvray. Piercing acidity plays off ripe peach, quince and apricot fruit with hints of beeswax.

2016 **Ochota Barrels 'Impeccable Disorder' Pinot Noir** 34
Adelaide Hills, South Australia

Tarras Ochota is a rock star, literally. He's also a talented winemaker and keen surfer, hence the double meaning of 'barrels' in the winery name. Tarras and wife Amber make minimal intervention wines out of the Piccadilly sub-region of the Adelaide Hills and their two top wines are both Pinot Noirs. 'Home' made exclusively by Amber and 'Impeccable Disorder' made to Tarras' tastes. The wine is 100% whole bunch fermented and while lighter bodied it is a textured and complex red. Cherries, red fruit and a sweet amaro-like bitterness layered with dried citrus peel and herb savouriness make for a very adult and satisfying Pinot.

2015 **Lucien Muzard Meursault 'Les Meix Chavaux' Chardonnay** 40
Burgundy, France

Hervé and Claude are the ninth generation of the Muzard family to run their estate based in Santenay and while you think they might rest on their family's long history the brothers have kept one eye firmly on the future. Cutting grape yields, eliminating fining and filtration and slowly increasing vineyard holdings beyond their home village have all been part of the quiet revolution at the Muzard domaine.

One such addition was a tiny .75 hectares plot in the cooler northerly 'Les Meix Chavaux' lieu-dit in Meursault. Here they produce a pure and powerful Burgundy with a nose drenched in Acacia honey, butter and brioche. On the palate there is baked lemon curd, citrus peel, toast and peach.

FRANÇOIS COTAT Chavignol, Sancerre

"François Cotat is one of the Loire's most revered producers. Based in Chavignol, he has just three hectares, of which 0.5 ha is Pinot Noir. The Sauvignon is picked quite late, and barrel fermented in old demi muids with natural yeasts."

2010 **Ettore Germano Barolo 'Serralunga d'Alba' Nebbiolo** 44
Piedmont, Italy

Sergio Germano is a second generation winemaker trained in Alba. He named his estate after his father, who used to make tiny quantities of wine for private customers from the family's vines in the commune of Serralunga. With its limestone and clay rich soils the commune has always produced Barolos of great structure and combine this pedigree with that of the cool late-ripening 2010 vintage and you have here a sneak peek at wine with a very long life ahead of it.

Red flower petals and plums on the nose evolve to cloves, star anise and dried warm spices.

The opulent palate is full of plums and dark berry fruit with well integrated tannins on a long finish.

SEPPELT Seppeltsfield, South Australia

Seppelt 'Para' Vintage Liqueur Port is arguably Australia's finest wine treasure and a window into our colonial past. The wine is an emblematic representation of the history of Australian wine production.

2014 **de Ladoucette Pouilly-Fumé Sauvignon Blanc** 30

Loire Valley, France

All Sauvignon Blancs are not created equal. The Comte Lafond and Ladoucette families have had some 230 years to gather holdings in the best vineyards in Pouilly-Fumé and to perfect their expression of the grape. They own coveted sites in Pouilly-Sur-Loire, Saint-Andelin and the Château du Nozet estate planted on a mixture of flint-rich clay and limestone soils. Their 2014 is a precise and focussed Sauvignon with a piercing acidity and herbaceous notes of nettle, sap and lemon verbena as well as acacia and a classic fruit profile of gooseberries and citrus fruits.

2012 **By Farr Shiraz (from magnum)** 36
Geelong, Victoria

The Farr family has been making wine in the Bannockburn sub-region of Geelong since 1978 but it wasn't until 1999 that father and son team Gary and Nick managed to acquire their own vines. With more than a dozen vintages at Domaine Dujac in Burgundy and countless others in the Rhone Valley and the USA between both men, their cumulative experience has quickly seen them establish By Farr as the leading light on the Geelong peninsula. The 2012 By Farr Shiraz is co-fermented with viognier and a portion of whole bunch creating an opulently textured and aromatic shiraz. Medium to full bodied with dark black fruits, soft warm spices and a deep, smoky finish.

2014 **S.C. Guillard Gevrey Chambertin 'Reinard' Vieilles Vignes Pinot Noir** 36
Burgundy, France

Michel Guillard is old school. So old school he doesn't even own a computer. He owns a fax machine but he admits it rarely has paper in it. This is a humble, low-profile producer making wines of striking purity. The domaine was started by Michel's grandmother who bought her first vines in 1913 with money she saved working as a maid in Gevrey. While the domaine has stayed true to its humble origins a little more new oak has crept into the cellar and carefully balances the expressive purple fruits of the 2014 'Reinard', a lieu-dit in the south of Gevrey. Expect ripe plums, dark sour cherries and savoury toasted oak to finish.

2011 **Leon Barral 'Jadis' Faugères Carignan Blend** 34
Languedoc-Roussillon, France

new estate 1993 named after his grand father. adopted biodynamic almost immediately. cows, horse and pigs graze the cover crops and creates healthier ecosystem and by extension vines that have more good nutrients. Simple approach that has won him many admirers mainly south facing vineyards catching the harsh sun of the south west. Vines are goblet trained (bush vine) and planted to hardy sun se Jadis is a majority blend of Carignan with Syrah and Grenache .

2011 **By Farr 'Tout Pres' Pinot Noir (from magnum)** 42
Geelong, Victoria

The Farr family has been making wine in the Bannockburn sub-region of Geelong since 1978 but it wasn't until 1999 that father and son team Gary and Nick managed to acquire their own vines. With more than a dozen vintages at Domaine Dujac in Burgundy and countless others in the Rhone Valley and the USA between both men, their cumulative experience has quickly seen them establish By Farr as the leading light on the Geelong peninsula. The 'Tout Pres' vineyard, so called because of its extremely close planting density, is the highest of the Farr's vineyards. Planted across three different soil types to six different clones it is a later-ripening vineyard that often produces the family's most brooding and structured wine. The 2011 is full of black fruit with a hint of smoky oak and firm but ripe tannins all perfectly integrated.

2014 **Julien Labet 'Lias' Chardonnay** 38

Jura, France

The Labet family owns 12 hectares of vines around the small southern town of Rotalier, from which they make more than 20 different cuvees every year. This represents an uncompromising commitment to terroir but perhaps surprisingly it is not what the estate is most famous for. In 1992 current patriarch, Alain Labet, started making white wines in a non-oxidative or 'topped up' style, which while common elsewhere was unheard-of in the Jura at the time.

'Lias' is from 200 million year-old limestone and shale soils and translates as a searingly mineral and dry wine. Citrus peel and fruits and lemon curd adding a creamy aspect to this incredibly taut and linear Chardonnay. Too rich for Chablis, too lean for Côte de Beaune, so distinctly Jura.

2015 **Marcel Lapierre Morgon 'Cuvee MMXV' Gamay** 36
Beaujolais, France

Marcel Lapierre is another of the 'Gang-of-Four' winemakers who helped reform ideas of Gamay and Beaujolais in the late 1980s. A follower of Jules Chauvet's call for a return to "natural wines" and traditional winemaking, Lapierre was quick to spearhead the movement and convert his vineyards to organic farming, remove all synthetic pesticides and chemicals, cutting yields and the use of sulphur. Lapierre's children tend the vines now but their father's spirit permeates every bottle. This 'Cuvée Marcel Lapierre' is a blend of all Lapierre's oldest plots in Morgon, with an average age of 100 years. It is a massive, ripe brooding Gamay reflecting the warmth of the year. The wine retains its slate mineral finish but is preceded by masses poached red fruits, violets and earth.

2016 **Circe Pinot Noir** 18
Mornington Peninsula, Victoria

Dan and Aaron don't love Shiraz. They tried but the more they worked with it the more they yearned for something lighter and fresher. That's how Circe was born and that's what it is; a pure, bright expression of Pinot. Smokey and toasty but filled with mouthwatering red and purple fruit.

2013 **Julien Labet 'Bajocien' Chardonnay** 38
Jura, France

The Labet family owns 12 hectares of vines around the small southern town of Rotalier, from which they make more than 20 different cuvees every year. This represents an uncompromising commitment to terroir but perhaps surprisingly it is not what the estate is most famous for. In 1992 current patriarch, Alain Labet, started making white wines in a non-oxidative or 'topped up' style, which while common elsewhere was unheard-of in the Jura at the time.

The vines used to make this cuvee were planted in the 1960s on Bajocien limestone soils and this decomposed, free-draining soil is the perfect building block for fine, elegant wines. Ripe red apple and citrus fruits combine with candied peel, warm spices and cream toward a long dry finish.

2015 **Matassa 'Cuvée Marguerite' Muscat Petits-Grains blend** 26
Roussillon, France

Tom Lubbe is New Zealand-born, South Africa-raised winemaker that found his calling in the South West of France. While working for the legendary Domaine Gauby in Roussillon he fell in love with the region and its local varieties eventually jumping at the opportunity to purchase a tiny vineyard in the village of Calce in 2001. He immediately began farming to biodynamic principles in order to restore soil health and took a very natural approach to his winemaking. 'Cuvée Marguerite' is an **orange** wine made from Muscat Petits-Grains, Muscat d' Alexandria and Maccabeu, which has spent 35 days on skins. The result a hauntingly aromatic wine, with aromas of musk and dried flowers, that is also bone dry with crunchy white and yellow fruits and a grippy tannic finish. Natural winemaking as it should be; clean, complex and precise.

2016 **Marcel Lapierre Morgon Gamay** 18

Beaujolais, France

Marcel's region-changing legacy is being carried on beautifully by his children. Working with 60 year-old vines on granite soils they have crafted a strikingly pure Gamay with notes of redcurrant, raspberry and white pepper, a touch of sap and a nervy, clean finish.

2014 **Domaine Valette Viré-Clessé** 44
Burgundy, France

The Valette brothers, Baptiste and Philippe, come from a family of growers rather than makers. Until the 1970s the family sold all their grapes but now they make what is considered some of the Macon's best wines. The latest generation of Valette's have taken production to the next level, going organic in the vineyards, minimal sulphur and handling in the winery and extended aging on fine lees (for nearly ten years for some cuvees).

The fruit for their Viré-Clessé is left to hang late and long on the vine before spending 24 months on lees. The result is a wine that is both extremely ripe and extremely savoury. It is a complex, evolving wine with notes of spicy oak, marzipan and cream mixed with pears, quince and tart golden plums finishing with an aloe-like herbaceousness.

2015 **Matassa 'Cuvée Marguerite' Muscat Petits-Grains blend** 26
Roussillon, France

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2015 **Joh. Bapt. Schäfer 'Burg Layer Schlossberg' Erste Lage Riesling** 28
Nahe, Germany

Sebastian Schäfer is a protégé of dry Riesling superstar Klaus Peter Keller and since taking over his family estate he has slowly worked his 8 hectares of vines into some of the most respected in the Nahe. Sebastian's winemaking is meticulous and old-fashioned in the best senses of the word: gentle pressing, spontaneous fermentation and maturation on fine lees in large format old oak.

The *Erste Lage* (think, Grand Cru) of 'Schlossberg' is a steep south-facing vineyard on weathered blue and red slate and has long been recognised as one of the best sites in the Nahe. Schäfer's 2015 combines the lifted, almost spritzy, acidity emblematic of the vintage with a complex nose of floral, fruit and vegetal characters. Passionfruit, guava, lime zest, lemon blossom and honeysuckle lead on to a dry, moreish finish.

Loire Valley, France

Domaine Pichot has crafted this fresh and lively expression of Chenin Blanc highlighting the grape's versatility. The wine shows apple and pear fruit, citrus and toast. Light, linear and fresh.

NV **Gosset 'Grande Reserve' Brut** 26

Ay, Champagne

With a production history dating to 1584 Gosset is a very highly regarded Champagne house. This red berry dominant blend delivers layers of complexity; red currant and hot cross bun.

2011 **Louis Roederer Rosé** 38

Reims, Champagne

Roederer's vintage rosé is a wonderful example of the style with bright maraschino cherry and red fruits bursting from the glass. The wine is a blend of 65% Pinot Noir and 35% Chardonnay with a pale salmon colour and a notable aroma of fresh brioche, cream and strawberries.

2016 **Domaine La Suffrene Bandol Rosé** 18

Provence, France

This Mourvèdre-based rose from the south of France is a pale salmon coloured dry wine with dried strawberries and stone fruit notes, fresh spices and a long saline finish.

2009 **Pannon 'Szamorodni' Furmint blend** 28

Tokaj, Hungary

'Szamorodni' is a traditional style of Tokaji and refers to a wine that is made with both healthy and botrytis-affected berries aged under flor yeast. The result is a complex dry wine that has the nutty character of a good Amontillado sherry or Vin Jaune with unique spiced fruit notes from the dry botrytis.

2015 **Akilia 'Tosca Cerrada' Palomino Fino** 14

Jerez, Spain

Bierzo winemaker Mario Rovira travels south to produce an unfortified Palomino that is aged in ex-Manzanilla botas under a layer of flor yeast. A savoury oxidative wine that balances white fruit with dried herb and cured meat characters.

2016 **Le Vignoble du Reveur 'Singulier' Pinot Gris Riesling** 16

Alsace, France

Mathieu Deiss is stepping out of his father's shadow in dramatic fashion. This orange wine accentuates aromatic varieties with partial carbonic maceration and balances the noses and fruit with tangy, savoury oxidative characters.

Rheinhessen, Germany
 Carolin Spanier-Gillot was recently named Germany's winemaker of the year and also finished converting her family estate to biodynamics. What better way to celebrate it's 200th birthday. Qvinterra is a dry Riesling with plenty of fleshy golden plums, stone fruit and crushed mint.
- 2015 **Kientzler 'Osterberg' Grand Cru Riesling** 32
Alsace, France
 The Osterberg Grand Cru has the gentlest slopes and sun exposure of the three that sit behind the village of Ribeauville on calcium-rich soils. Kientzler's wine from this vineyard reflects the minerality of the site combining white flower, lime zest and white peach with flinty acidity to long, concentrated finish.
- 2016 **Les Fruits 'Loiraine' Sauvignon Blanc** 14
Adelaide Hills, South Australia
 Made from a biodynamically farmed vineyard in the Forresteron sub-region of the Adelaide Hills this dry white is packed with citrus, guava and crushed herbs to a tangy, mouth-watering finish.
- 2015 **Domaine Belluard 'Pur Jus' Gringet** 36
Savoie, France
 Dominique Belluard is as close to an alpine winemaker as you can get; his vineyards just about back onto the ski slopes of Chamonix. Planted in an old glacial valley his vines are biodynamically managed and his 'Pur Jus' cuvee sees no sulphur at all. A rare wine of amazing purity and depth that shows jasmine, elderflower, white peach, pear and a hint of smoke.
- 2016 **Domaine Cauhape Jurancon Sec 'Geyser' Petit Manseng blend** 20
Jurancon, France
 A pun-intended explosion of flavours can be found in Cauhape's rare blend of all five white Jurancon varieties. Honeysuckle, grapefruit, pineapple and garrigue with a mouth-watering finish.
- 2009 **Brokenwood 'Oakey Vineyard' Semillon** 17
Hunter Valley, NSW
 The misleadingly named Oakey Vineyard is in fact a perfect example of bottle-aged, unoaked Hunter Semillon. Citrus peel and lemongrass balanced with wax, lanolin and almond.
- 2016 **Cascina Val del Prete 'Luè' Roero Arneis** 15
Piedmont, Italy
 Biodynamic producer Val de Prete lets their 'Luè' Arneis sit on lees for three months in stainless steel. Dried, salted plums, quince and lemon curd balance a zippy, crisp acidity.
- 2016 **Martin Nittnaus 'Manila' Grüner Veltliner** 19
Burgenland, Austria
 Taking fruit from his parent's renowned estate Martin has crafted a natural wine that is clean, textured and intensely savoury. Creamy lees, white pepper, quince, aloe and grapefruit.

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- 2016 **Francois Chidaine Limoux 'le Chenin d'Ailleurs' Chenin Blanc** 19
Languedoc, France
 The Loire superstar's first white from the South is a playful riff on his wines from Montlouis. He retains the racy acidity of the Chenin grape but with a riper stone fruit and dried pear character.

- 2014 **Julien Labet 'Fleur de Savagnin' en Chalasse Savagnin** 38
Jura, France
 The Labet family owns 12 hectares of vines around the small southern town of Rotalier, from which they make more than 20 different cuvees every year. This represents an uncompromising commitment to terroir but perhaps surprisingly it is not what the estate is most famous for. In 1992 current patriarch, Alain Labet, started making white wines in a non-oxidative or 'topped up' style,
- 2015 **Yeringberg Marsanne Roussanne** 28
Yarra Valley, Victoria
 Since 1969 the de Pury family has kept Yeringberg one Australia's true boutique wineries. Yields are small, production is small and the house style favours elegance and longevity over showiness. This is evident in their Marsanne Roussanne, which unfolds slowly in the glass to reveal notes of white pepper, quince, poached pears, white flowers and nectarine. Waxy and medium-bodied.
- 2015 **Gerard Duplessis Chablis 'Vaillons' 1er Cru Chardonnay** 36
Burgundy, France
 Lillian Duplessis is among the new generation of winemakers in Chablis. He converted his family's vineyards to organic farming in 2008, is using less and less sulphur every year and has worked in regions around the world. The result is wines that have a typical focus and persistence but also show an expression of juicy, fleshy white and yellow fruits.
- 2013 **Jean-François Ganevat 'Chamois du Paradis' Chardonnay** 40
Jura, France
 A patchwork of 200 million year-old soils, a winemaking history once on par with its neighbour, Burgundy and one man's obsessive pursuit of 'terrior'. So began the story of Jean-Francois Ganevat and how his stunning wines, like this Chardonnay a 70 year-old vineyard on red marl and limestone, have shone the spotlight on one of France's humblest and most exciting regions.
- 2015 **Pierre-Yves Colin-Morey St Aubin 'Le Banc' Chardonnay** 46
Burgundy, France
 Pierre-Yves' wines always seem to jump out of the glass. They are seductive and intense, rich but never fat. From the pure limestone soils of 'Le Banc' lieu-dit comes a Chardonnay of great charm and length with citrus curd, pineapple, white pepper and a saline finish.
- 2015 **Warner Vineyard Chardonnay** 19
Beechworth, Victoria
 The 'Warner Vineyard' became famous when Giaconda started buying grapes from them but now they make great wines in their own right. Full-bodied, creamy, generous and round.

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- 1999 **Domaine Rolet Arbois Trousseau (Magnum)** 30
Jura, France
 Rolet is an estate that has been rejuvenated by the latest generation of its family. All four siblings played their role in elevating this domaine and its vineyards to highest levels in the Jura region. This 19 year-old red shows...
- 2015 **L'Anglore 'Véjade' Mourvedre Blend** 28
Rhône Valley, France
 Eric Piffierling has always been happy breaking the rules, happily declassifying his wines if he

feels he can make a more interesting wine outside of the AOC regulations. Here he blends Mourvedre and Grenache to make an ultra-light red full of wild red berries and cherries.

2013 **Jean Foillard 'Cote du Py' Morgon Gamay** 34
Beaujolais, France

Jean Foillard is one of the 'Gang-of-Four' winemakers who helped reform the image of Gamay and Beaujolais in the late 1980s. A return to 'natural' farming practices and more traditional and his choice to only finish his wines in old DRC barrels and you have a deep, brooding expression of Gamay. Red berries, black plums, wet earth and dried spices.

2015 **Faiveley Mercurey 1er Cru 'Clos des Myglands' Pinot Noir (Magnur** 32
Burgundy, France

From 55 year-old vines in the Cote Chalonnais comes a beautiful example of modern Burgundy. Faiveley are sole owners of this 14 acre 'monopole' vineyard and manage its fruit meticulously. A nose of violets and ripe plums with a supple palate of sour red cherries and warm spices.

2016 **Taturry 'Mosselini Vineyard' Pinot Noir** 19
Mornington Peninsula, Victoria

Produced from fruit in the Merricks sub-region of Mornington from 20 year-old vines this is a classically light but smokey Pinot with bright red fruit, toasted spices and a juicy finish.

2017 **JJ Morel 'Antipodes' Pinot Noir Syrah** 22
Adelaide Hills & Barossa Valley, South Australia

Cult Puligny Montrachet winemaker Jean Jacques Morel threw off the confines of France's strict AOC system on a recent visit to Australia to

2008 **La Rioja Alta Reserva 'Vina Arana' Tempranillo** 22
Rioja, Spain

2013 **Escoda Sanahuja 'Nas del Gegant' Grenache blend** 17
Conca de Barbera, Spain

This Garnatxa, Cabernet Franc, Samsó blend comes from a single biodynamic vineyard that is 450m above sea level. Limestone soils and cool evenings lend this wine a crisp acid backbone that balances flavours of baked red berries, star anise, crushed fresh herbs and nettle.

2015 **Castello Monsanto Chianti Classico Sangiovese** 18
Tuscany, Italy

A blend of 90% Sangiovese with the difference made up of Canaiolo and Colorino, Monsanto's Chianti is everything great traditional viticulture in the region. Italian wine bible Gambero Rosso agrees awarding the 2015 its top award, Tre Bicchieri. Meaty, earthy and packed with cherries.

2012 **Traversa Barbaresco 'Staderi' Nebbiolo** 42
Piedmont, Italy

Established in 1834 Traversa is a small family winery based in the hills of Nieve. This Nebbiolo comes from the Staderi Hill, a gentle slope near the family farm, and has all the classic hallmarks of Barbaresco. Violets on the nose and a palate that is red fruit, velvet and firmly tannic.

- 2015 **Clos Troteligotte 'K-nom' Malbec blend** 14
Cahors, France
 Manu Rybinski is a rising star in the South-West. Farming organically on an iron-rich plateau he produces unusually pure and expressive Malbecs. His 'K-nom' cuvee is an unoaked medium-bodied Malbec-Merlot blend with ripe red fruits, iron-like minerality and a soft, juicy finish.
- 2014 **Château Sociando-Mallet Haut Medoc Cabernet Sauvignon blend** 46
Bordeaux, France
 Overachieving Cru Bougouris producer Sociando-Mallet is based far North on the Left Bank in Haut Medoc
- 2014 **Craiglee Cabernet Sauvignon** 16
Sunbury, Victoria
 Craiglee's Cabernet may be less well known than its Shiraz but it's made with the same love and generosity. This savoury medium-bodied wine has the tell tale Cabernet blackberry and black-currant fruit, liquorice, smoke, cured meats and soft, ripe tannins.
- 2014 **Bois de Boursan Chateauf-neuf-du-pape Grenache blend** 36
Rhône Valley, France
- 2014 **Spinifex 'Bête Noir' Shiraz** 18
Barossa Valley, South Australia
 'Bête Noir' is a nightmare for winemaker Pete Schell to make but a pleasure for us to drink. A blend of 12 different vineyards across various sub-regions this wine is a real snap-shot of new-wave Barossa Shiraz. Ripe black fruit and soft tannins mixing with star anise and clove.
- 2014 **Rockford 'Basket Press' Shiraz** 42
Barossa Valley, South Australia
 Since its establishment in 1984 Rockford has cemented itself as one of the most beloved and celebrated wineries in Australia. Their iconic red takes its name from the ancient basket press still used to make the wine. Massive and brooding with lashings of raw red and black fruit.
- 2016 **Spinifex 'Bette Noir' Shiraz** 18
Barossa Valley, SA
 Peter Schnell is one of the modern pioneers of the Barossa that has re-ignited great interest in the region over the last decade. This wine from old vines is full bodied, generous, yet fresh and bright. A big, dense wine with spice and a touch of oak - broody stuff.
- 2019 **Unico Zelo 'Slate Farm' Fiano** 16
Clare Valley, SA
 Whether through winemaking, or more increasingly distillation, Brendon and Laura Carter are true forces of nature. Since launching Unico Zelo five years ago they've injected some much needed Dolce Vita into Australian Fiano - creating a modern classic in the process.
- 2017 **Fattoria di Rodano 'Chianti Classico' Sangiovese** 18
Chianti, Italy
 Rodano is run by the Pozzesi family based in the heart of Chianti. Enrico Pozzesi, who

is now in charge after taking over legendary Guilio Gambelli when he passed away in 2012. Enrico continues with their families tradition of minimal intervention and traditional winemaking. The Chianti Classico is bright, with red cherries, tobacco and dried herbs.

2010 **Conde Valdemar 'Gran Reserva' Tempranillo Blend** 24
Rioja, Spain

Established in 1889, this family owned winery have definitely made their mark in Rioja. Balancing tradition and innovation, this classic wine truly represents all that can be achieved in the region. Expect tarry notes with dark plum, sweet spice, and vanilla.

2019 **Entropy Wines Pinot Noir** 18
Mornington Peninsula, Victoria

Ryan Ponsford, a newcomer on the block, has worked along side the likes of Willaim Downie and Patrick Sullivan. With the same dedication and attention to detail, Ponsford began making his own wines under his own label. This Pinot Noir is made from the Balnarring area of Mornington Peninsula. An absolute must try from this rising star.

2016 **Miloš Plavac Mali** 26
Dalmatia, Croatia

Plavac Mali is a red grape variety related to Primitivo (aka Zinfandel) grown along coast of Croatia. This wine is well structured and unveils characters of dark plum, cherries, black olive and dried herbs. Rarely seen in Australia, this wine is an absolute must try.

2017 **Koerner 'Classico' Cabernet Sauvignon Blend** 24
Clare Valley, SA

The Koerner brothers are a name to watch. Since their first vintage and 2014 they have consistently produced wines of great quality, purity and complexity. The clasico red is their top red cuvee and is blended with Petit Verdot and Malbec. Rich, robust & varietal

2019 **Hughes & Hughes Pinot Noir** 16
Northern Tasmania

From a real up and coming producers this floral, delicate and perfumed Pinot Noir ticks all the boxes. Well balanced and with flavours of wild berries, violet and tar. Lovely wine.

2018 **Inama 'Vin Soave' Soave Classico** 16
Veneto, Italy

Giuseppe Inama began buying plots of land in the 1950s with the mission of producing wine capable of restoring Soave's tattered reputation. On the basis of this pleasantly archetypal Soave with waxy texture, a faint nuttiness and clean, green fruit, we say he succeeded.

2018 **Domaine La Clef du Recit Sancerre** 26
Sancerre, France

Established in 2012 by Anthony Girard, a young and ambitious winemaker. Fine acidity and an enduring minerality are great companions in displaying the
