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## 2014 LOUIS ROEDERER "CRISTAL" BRUT

FRANCE | CHAMPAGNE | SUSTAINABLE

Legendary producer with a legendary champagne in 1876 for the Russian Tsar Alexander II. 60% pinot noir and 40% chardonnay. No malolactic transformation. The second fermentation took place according to traditional bottled method. Dosage 8 grams/liter. The wine was stored a full seven years on the lees .....3790

## NV DHONDT-GRELLET "DANS UN PREMIER TEMPS" EXTRA BRUT

FRANCE | CHAMPAGNE | ORGANIC/BIO (NOT CERT.)

50% Chardonnay, 30% Pinot Noir, 20% Pinot Meunier from various plots across Sezanne, Cuis, Avenay Val d'or. 70% comes from 2016 and the rest is from a solera that was started in 1986. Manual harvest, whole bunches pressed and fermented with natural yeast in steel tank and barrique. No chaptalization, clarification or filtration, malolactic fermentation started naturally, around 4-5g/L dosage.....1000

## NV DHONDT-GRELLET CHAMPAGNE "CRAMANT" GRAND CRU EXTRA BRUT

FRANCE | CHAMPAGNE | CÔTE DES BLANCS | CRAMANT | ORGANIC/BIO (NOT CERT.)

100% Chardonnay from old vines (about 55 years old) from the two *lieu-dit* (individual vineyard locations) La Garennes and Les Longues Verges in the Côte des Blancs. 70% of the wine is from 2018 and the rest is reserve wine accumulated since 1986. Fermentation in old small oak barrels with full malolactic transformation. 24 months sur lattes and disgorgement in May 2021. Dosage 2g/l. A large powerful wine with elegant minerality .....1500

## 2016 LAHERTE FRÈRES "LES LONGUES VOYES R16"

FRANCE | CHAMPAGNE | BIO (NOT CERT.)

100% directly pressed Pinot Noir from 37-year-old vines in east position. Spontaneous fermentation, 18 months on the lees in older barriques with regular batonnage. No malolactic transformation. 24 months on the lees. Degorged by hand in January 2020 with 4 g/l dosage. 25 mg/l SO<sub>2</sub> when pressing. Organic yeast and cane sugar for second fermentation. Organic MCR (concentrated grape must, dosage). Very structured and open considering its young age .....1200

## 2019 LAHERTE FRÈRES "NATURE DE CRAIE R19" 1ER CRU BRUT NATURE

FRANCE | CHAMPAGNE | BIO (NOT CERT.)

100% Chardonnay. Spontaneous fermentation and seven months of aging on the lees in older barriques (3-10 years old) with regular batonnage. Full malolactic transformation. 15 months sur lattes. Disgorged by hand in May 2021 without dosage. No addition of SO<sub>2</sub>. Organic yeast and organic cane sugar for other fermentation. Surprisingly open to its small age with a seductive fruitiness and minerality .....1200

## NV LAHERTE FRÈRES BLANC DE BLANCS BRUT NATURE

FRANCE | CHAMPAGNE | BIO (NOT CERT.)

100% Chardonnay from vines with an average age of 35 years. Organic/biodynamic farming without certification. Spontaneous fermentation in older burgundy barrels and foudres. Six months of aging with regular stirring. Partial malolactic conversion (20%). Base year 2018 with 50% reserve wine from 2016 and 2017. 15-24 months sur lattes. Degorged by hand in January 2021 without dosage.....850

## 2015 EMILIE FENEUIL "CUVÉE TOTUM" BRUT NATURE

FRANCE | CHAMPAGNE | ORGANIC

Pinot Meunier, Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and a gable Petit Meslier, from 40-year-old vines. The proportions are approximately 60/30/8/2. The different grape varieties and parcels are pressed and fermented together. Spontaneous fermentation in old 228-liter and 400-liter barrels. 30 mg/l so<sub>2</sub> added when pressing. Organic yeast and cane sugar. Bottled September 2016. Degorgerad June 2019 without dosage. Complex taste where flowers and tropical fruits are combined with umami. 1100 bottles in total.....1800

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## OTHER SPARKLING WINES

### 2018 DOMAINE DU PÉLICAN SAVAGNIN ARBOIS BRUT "S° ZERO"

FRANCE | JURA | VIN DE FRANCE | BIO (NOT CERT.)

Not many people make sparkling wine at Savagnin and Domaine du Pelican (owned by the legendary Domaine d'Anerville in Burgundy) is of course not like everyone else. Since it is 100% Savagnin and the rules only allow 30% it must not be sold as Crémant du Jura. The wine was stored for 12 months before the second fermentation was started with 10% must from the previous year. Disgorging was done after 13 months. Taste-wise, it's all about yellow plums, pears, aromatic herbs, nuts and salty minerality .....890

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### 2019 SONS OF WINE "RAONI" RIESLING VIEILLES VIGNES

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ALSACE | BIO (NOT CERT.)

Farid Yahimi a.k.a Sons of Wine is an organic négociant, based in Beblenheim, Alsace, which has a very distinctive and rebellious style of winemaking. Grapes from vines with age from St Hippolyte, a well-known quality location. Good concentration with tropical elements backed by fine salty minerality and freshness that cools. The label portrays Raoni Metuktire, chief of the Kayapo people in the Brazilian Amazon and known as a strong voice for the preservation of the nature of the Amazon and the tribal peoples who live there. ....800

### 2019 LINDENLAUB "ORIGINE L" RIESLING

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ALSACE | ORGANIC/AB-CERT

The Lindenlaub family has been growing wine in Dorlisheim, Alsace since 1759. Christophe, who now manages cultivation and winemaking, converted to organic in 2009 and received his certification three years later. Cuvée on grapes from one of Christophe's highest locations in Mutzig - a south-facing vineyard with soil of clay and limestone on top of sandstone. Yields were intentionally kept low to explore a more concentrated, age-worthy style. Directly pressed, natural yeast and aged for 2 years on steel tank, A remarkable texture and complex wine. No added sulfite.....910

### 2016 KUENTZ-BAS "GEISBERG" GRAND CRU RIESLING

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ALSACE | BIO/VIN BIOLOGIQUE

The Geisberg ("Goat Mountain") is one of Alsace's foremost crus, known for producing long-lived Rieslings. Only three wine farmers grow wine on this complex terroir of limestone, marl and sandstone. Manual harvest of biodynamically farmed grapes, careful pressing for 10-12 hours, natural yeast, Ten months on the lees in steel tanks. Residual sweetness 8.8g/l. Quince, pineapple, peach, spicy grilled lemon, some ripening tones, razor sharp acidity and salty minerality.....880

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### 2019 DOMAINE ELENI ET EDOUARD VOCORET CHABLIS "LES PARGUES"

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BOURGOGNE | CHABLIS

The cult-declared Eleni and Edouard Vocoret have been praised for their wines that show tremendous precision. Grapes from 30-year-old vines from a small individual vineyard with southeast exposure. Fermentation takes place in steel tanks after which the wine rests in old oak barrels for 12 months. Seashells, pineapples, green apples and flowers in a nice mix .....870

### 2019 DOMAINE ELENI ET EDOUARD VOCORET CHABLIS "LES BUTTEAUX" 1ER CRU

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BOURGOGNE | CHABLIS | BUTTEAUX

Eleni and Edouard Vocoret have in a short time gathered a cult following and have been praised for their wines that show tremendous precision. The grapes come from the upper part of Butteaux in the lower part of Montmains, where they grow in lime-rich white clay soils. Nice, detailed and very mineral with a lovely tense structure and mouthfeel. Fine tones of herbs, lemon and grapefruit .....1100

### 2018 CHÂTEAU DE BÉRU CHABLIS "CÔTE AUX PRÊTRES"

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BOURGOGNE | CHABLIS | ECOCERT

Lieu-dit (individual vineyard location) Côte aux Prêtres, Béru (the village declined to be included in the classification in 1938, so all locations are Chablis AOP). High altitude, wind-swept west facing just southeast of Béru. The name comes from a nearby ancient pilgrimage route that led to the monastery of Vézelay. Lean mineral-rich soil of weathered limestone from marine fossils (Kimmeridge). Hand harvesting and direct pressing of whole bunches. Spontaneous fermentation with malolactic transformation, 18 months of aging on the lees in old medium-sized oak barrels and steel tank, in roughly equal parts. No clearing or filtering. 20 mg/l added sulphite. Intense fresh fruity taste with fine acidity and salty minerality.....910

### 2020 JEAN-MARIE BERRUX BOURGOGNE BLANC "LE PETIT TÊTU"

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BOURGOGNE | CÔTE DE BEAUNE | CORPEAU | BIO/ECOCERT

A blend from three different vineyards located between Puligny Montrachet and Meursault in the Côte de Beaune. 24 hours of clearing the must by natural sedimentation (*débourbage*). Spontaneous fermentation and one year of aging on the lees in Burgundy barrels of varying age, from new to nine years old. Assemblage in stainless steel tank before bottling in November, without clearance or filtration. No additives, of course. A crisply dense Chardonnay, which exhibits mouthwatering acidity and crispy minerality that moves us to a salt-sprinkled Atlantic coast filled with seashells.....850

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**2017 DOMAINE PIGNIER "SAUVEGEON" SAVAGNIN**

JURA | CÔTES DU JURA | BIO/DEMETER

Sauvegeon is the old local name of the grape Savagnin, suggesting that the grape has historically been wild-growing. The grape material comes from farms mentioned back in the 13th century. In 1794, the Pignier family took over the farms from monks. This cuvée has been raised for 12 months on topped egg-shaped barrels, providing minimal oxidation. Here we talk elegance, purity and salty aromatic energy .....950

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**2019 DOMAINE DE L'AIGLE À DEUX TÊTES "LES CLOUS NATURÉ" SAVAGNIN**

JURA | CÔTES DU JURA | ORGANIC

The grape Savagnin is locally called Naturé and then usually when it comes to wines that are made without contact with oxygen. The name Savagnin is said to come from the French word "sauvage" which means wild and the perfumed Alsace grape Gewurztraminer is a relative. The taste is clean, straight and honest with original minerality and freshness but with Burgundian finesse.....870

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**2018 DOMAINE DU PÉLICAN "GRAND CUROULET" SAVAGNIN OUILLÉ**

JURA | ARBOIS | ORGANIC

Domaine du Pélican is owned by legendary Burgundy producer Marquis de Angerville. Grand Curoulet is a lean vineyard location in Arbois where the conditions are ideal for Savagnin, which here gives late maturity and very energetic mineral wines with enormous precision and length. Topped up barrels with 1/3 of the wine had skin contact. Amazing concentration of exotic fruit, roasted hazelnut and peppery spiciness ..... 1100

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**2020 HUGHES BEGUET "OH YEAH" SAVAGNIN**

JURA | ARBOIS | BIO/DEMETER

The domain today consists of 4 hectares around the village of Mesnay and Pupillin. Hand harvesting and natural fermentation in topped up barrels to prevent oxidation (of which the name Oh Yeah, which sounds like *ouillé*, the local name for topped up barrels). Bottling without added sulphur or filtration. Wonderful fresh grape-typical taste with a length that leaves you in awe .....950

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**2018 PIERRE MÉNARD "PLUTON" ANJOU BLANC**

LOIRE | ANJOU-SAUMUR | ANJOU | BIO (NOT CERT.)

Pierre Ménard's flagship made from specially selected grape material from logs growing in phthanite (a blue shimmering stone that is the pre-stage to schist). The result is Chenin Blanc extra everything! 7.1 g/l residual sweetness balanced perfectly against 4.04 g/l acid. Only 497 bottles of this vintage.....1250

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**2017 THIBAUD BOUDIGNON "À FRANÇOIS(E)" ANJOU BLANC**

LOIRE | ANJOU-SAUMUR | ANJOU

Fantastic Chenin Blanc from one of wine world's brightest shining stars. The grapes come from his finest location in Anjou. The wine is dedicated to his mother who died of cancer when Thibaud was 17 years old. The taste is of course wonderful — tight, fruity, with crisp acidity and well-defined minerality .....1100

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**2018 THIBAUD BOUDIGNON "LA VIGNE CENDRÉE" SAVENNIÈRES**

LOIRE | ANJOU-SAUMUR | SAVENNIÈRES

A truly phenomenal Chenin Blanc with a nice creaminess in Burgundian style. Grapes from 0.5 ha in lieu-dit La Vigne Cendrée in Savennières, with southern exposure and clay soil. Fermentation takes place in steel tank and then the wine is stored for 12 months on 226 l old Burgundian oak barrels and foudres .....1300

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**2020 DOMAINE DU FACTEUR "LE FACTEUR SU'L VÉLO" VOUVRAY SEC**

LOIRE | TOURAINE | VOUVRAY | ORGANIC

Fabien Brutout worked as an apprentice with Sébastien Brunet before starting his own farm. He then teamed up with Mathieu Cosme under the name Le Facteur. A beautiful dry, fresh and very ripe Chenin. The right balance between the minerality of the terroir, the acidity of the wine and the ripeness of the grapes. Vines 60 years old. Fermentation and ageing in old 400-litre oak barrels for six months. Natural yeasts, light filtration, no clarification and no added sulfite. 8 mg/l residual sweetness ..... 735

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**2015 VALLÉE MORAY MONTLOUIS-SUR-LOIRE "AUBÉPINE"**

LOIRE | TOURAINE | MONTLOUIS-SUR-LOIRE | ORGANIC/AB-CERT

The vines are between 50 and 100 years old growing in flint clay. The grapes were harvested by hand after which they were pressed carefully and rested on mainly old oak barrels for 2 years. A structured Chenin Blanc with rich seductive ripening tones. No added SO<sub>2</sub> .....760

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**2018 DOMAINE DE VEILLOUX ROMORANTIN**

LOIRE | TOURAINE | CHEVERNY | VIN DE FRANCE | ORGANIC/BIO

Domaine De Veilloux's Romorantin grows in lime-rich sandy and clay soils where the basic soil gives the grape must a boost of freshness. Handpicked grapes, natural yeast, 10 months on the lees in large old oak barrels. No clearance but a lighter mechanical filtration. Large, elegant, fresh and herbaceous .....830

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## GERMANY

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### 2020 PETER LAUER AYLER RIESLING "FASS 6 SENIOR" TROCKEN FEINHERB

MOSEL | SAAR | ORGANIC WITHOUT COPPER SULFATE (NOT CERT.)

Classic Mosel with wet stones, green apples and white flowers. Young but already fully drinkable. Because of Germany's somewhat messy rules, it is classified as Ortswein but the grapes origin is really Ayler Kupp, that is Grand Cru. Some of the vines are 120 years old and ungrafted..... 740

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### 2019 PETER LAUER UNTERSTENBERG "FASS 12" TROCKEN FEINHERB

MOSEL SAAR RUWER | ORGANIC WITHOUT COPPER SULFATE (NOT CERT.)

Ayler Kupp Unterstenberg Fass 12 comes from Lauer's best *lieu-dit* (small single vineyard location) south-southwest of the original Ayler Kupp. The must was fermented down to a delicate semi-dry wine where the creamy residual sweetness is balanced against a wonderful tart freshness and minerality with complex layers of mirabelle, grapefruit, herbs and spices.....880

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### 2019 PETER LAUER AYL NEUENBERG "FASS 17" TROCKEN FEINHERB

MOSEL | SAAR | ORGANIC WITHOUT COPPER SULFATE (NOT CERT.)

In Fass 17 Neuenberg you will find some notes of botrytis, due to the fact that the vineyard is a little further down where the fog gives noble rot a chance to develop. This gives a slightly yellow-fruited and spicy character. In addition, the wine goes in the same spirit as all Florians wines with a lot of freshness, primary fruit and high minerality. Natural yeast, growing up on old 500l old oak barrels..... 950

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### 2017 PETER LAUER SAARFEILSER "FASS 13" GROSSES GEWÄCHS RIESLING

MOSEL | SAAR | ORGANIC WITHOUT COPPER SULFATE (NOT CERT.)

Saarfeilser gives the most generous of the GG wines, due to the fact that it is Lauer's warmest vineyard. It is situated across the river from Kupp, with deeper gravelly soils over the typical slate. Green apples, lime, wet pebbles, herbs, flowers and a creaminess from 8 months on the lees with battonage (stirring).....1200

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### 2019 ANSGAR CLÜSSERATH TRITTENHEIMER "APOTHEKE" RIESLING SPÄTLESE

GERMANY | MOSEL | ORGANIC WITH MED BIODYNAMIC METHODS (NOT CERT.)

Eva Clüsserath runs this vineyard which has been a family estate since 1670. Piesporter Goldtröpfchen is known for producing fantastic sweet wines. Here is instead a semi-dry (feinherb). Aged with the lees for more than six months in 1000 litres fuder..... 740

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### 2018 WAGNER-STEMPEL GUTSWEIN SCHEUREBE TROCKEN

RHEINHESSEN | ORGANIC

Scheurebe is a crossroads at Riesling and Bouquetsaube that Dr. Georg Scheu developed in 1916 in an attempt to produce a more frost-resistant grape than Riesling and Silvaner. Most often it is used for sweet wines because it is extremely difficult to make dry wines without losing balance. Wagner-Stempel is the exception. The taste is reminiscent of a fresh Riesling with large doses of grapefruit, rhubarb and juicy peach that blooms out in green herbaceous tones..... 620

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### 2018 WEINGUT KELLER RIESLING RR RESERVE

RHEINHESSEN

Klaus-Peter Keller's wines can be found in Buckingham Palace's wine cellar, among other places. He is known for his meticulous handling of the entire process from grape to bottle that produces powerful wines with tremendous precision. An aromatic powerhouse, very fresh taste of yellow apples, peach, lemongrass, honey, herbal spiciness and lime. The grapes come mainly from Kirchspiel, which is Grosse Lage.....1150

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### 2017 WITTMANN "KIRCHSPIEL" GROSSES GEWÄCHS RIESLING

RHEINHESSEN | RESPEKT-BIODYN

From the steepest slopes in Rheinhessen, with unusually rocky soil forcing the roots of the vines to find their way deep into the ground for water and nutrition. The location and soil produce fantastically lively and spicy wines that are nothing like the tighter wines of the more famous Morstein and Kirchspiel..... 1300

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**2016 DÖNNHOFF "DELLCHEN" GROSSES GEWÄCHS RIESLING**

NAHE | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

The vines are 15-30 years old and grow on a steep slope with roots in slate and porphyry soil. A very refined bouquet of peach, rosehip and wild berries in the nose. Amazing concentration, elegance and finesse. The finish is so long and mineral-rich that you almost lose your breath .....1200

Walkenberg's south-east location protects against direct sunlight while the sun's rays are reflected up from the river. Red and white sandstone with loess provides minerals and warmth. Spontaneous fermentation in large, old oak barrels, maturation on the yeast in the same barrel until bottling in December 2019.....1650

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**2018 SECKINGER "KIESELBERG" RIESLING WURZELECHT**

PFALZ | ORGANIC

Rising star Jonas Seckinger's top spot with 70-year-old vines growing in red sandstone. Seckinger's rieslings always undergo malolactic fermentation, which gives a nice creaminess without losing freshness. The grapes fermented spontaneously in old oak barrels, no filtration or clearing. Only 5 mg/l sulphur added .....1200

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**2017 SECKINGER "ÖLBERG" RIESLING**

PFALZ | ORGANIC

No additives and no clarification or filtration. In terms of taste, you could describe it as a very dry piña colada with lovely tropical floral and freshness.....730

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### 2020 MARIA & SEPP MUSTER "GELBER MUSKATELLER VOM OPOK"

STEIERMARK | LEUTSCHACH | BIODYNAMIC

Maria and Sepp Muster have a total of 10 hectares of vineyards that have never been treated with pesticides. Grapes come from 20-year-old vines planted on steep slopes with a soil of limestone and clay sludge known locally as *opok*. Spontaneous fermentation with domestic yeast in 2,400 liter oval wooden barrels where the wine rests for 10 months, followed by 20 months in 1,200 and 2,400 liter wooden barrels. No clarification or filtration and only minimal addition of sulfur. Fine aromatics including mint, elderberry and passion fruit. The fresh acidity and salty minerality leave a clean taste.....840

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### 2015 E&M LANG GRÜNER VELTLINER "DRITTER AKT" SCHRECK

NIEDERÖSTERREICH | KREMSTAL | BIO

Freshness like a Chablis but storage on the yeast precipitate has given a rich texture. The fine grape-typical herbiness is there, backed by even more sting like ginger and fine fruitiness of yellow apples and peaches. The grapes are grown biodynamically and harvested by hand .....1200

Delicate aroma with fresh spicy fruit, mineral, as well as discreet petroleum tones. Well-structured dry fresh taste with nice mineral note, hints of apple, gooseberry, ripe pear, banana and apricot .....1200

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### 2016 FRANZ HIRTZBERGER "SINGERRIEDEL" RIESLING SMARAGD

NIEDERÖSTERREICH | WACHAU

Wonderful wine from one of the world's most celebrated wine makers. Fresh and fruity with ripe tropical fruit, honey, peach, citrus and mineral. Well structured, tightly woven but velvety, richly fruity, very fresh and nicely mineral driven, hints of honey, citrus and tropical fruit in an elegantly balanced, dry, elegant style .....1700

The goal is to extract tannins that protect against oxidation without adding sulphites. The skin contact has given a huge boost in flavors as well as body and structure, but not tannins enough to be classified as an orange wine. 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### 2019 VALENTINA ANDREI "PAÏEN"

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VALAIS | FULLY | BIO

Savagnin (known from Jura in France) is called Heida in the Upper Valais and Païen in the central Valais where Valentina is located. The vines are 45-70 years old and are grown biodynamically in shale clay in Pepiat and Les Pris à Leytron. Short cold fermentation with the skin. Spontaneous fermentation with wild yeast. Full malolactic conversion. The wine then rested on used barriques (small oak barrels). Pure finely tuned taste of juicy grey pears, yellow flowers, spices and gently acidity and minerality990

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### 2020 VALENTINA ANDREI PETITE ARVINE "BELLE USINE"

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VALAIS | FULLY | BIO

The emblematic grape from the Valais, Petite Arvine, takes on a new dimension in the hands of Valentina. 26 years old vines grown biodynamically in barren granite soil on terraced vineyards. All work is done by hand since working with a machine is impossible. Spontaneous fermentation with wild yeast, full malolactic conversion followed by aging on old barriques (small oak barrels). For the riesling lover, the Swiss grape Completer feels both familiar and titillating new. Here we find aromatic tropical fruits such as passion fruit, green mango and pineapple, salty minerals and razor sharp dry acidity. The 6-year-old vines are grown biodynamically in shale clay. Spontaneous fermentation with wild yeast, followed by full malolactic conversion. Aging on old small French oak barrels. Only 624 bottles made .....1100

### 2019 MUCHADA-LÉCLAPART "LUMIÈRE" PALOMINO FINO

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ANDALUCIA | BIO (NOT CERT.)

Here we have something so unusual a wine made from 100% Palomino Fino, thus the grape that you usually find in sherry. 0-year-old logs growing chalk, limestone and clay (albariza). This grape is not considered to be able to produce quality wine, but this wine refutes that thesis by far. Direct pressing of whole bunches. Settling the must in tank. Spontaneous fermentation in old Bourdeaux barrels, with nine months on the lees. No clarification or filtering. 3 g/hl added sulfite before fermentation to counteract oxidation. Juicy pears and apples with citrus freshener and salty mineral. And certainly there haunts a hint of nutty sherry note .....970

### 2018 COLLECAPRETTA "PIGRO DELLE SORBE"

UMBRIA | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

100% Greco grown on slopes at 500 meters in lime and iron-rich clay. Direct pressing, spontaneous fermentation in open amphorae without temperature control. Storage in fiberglass tank. A rerouting to separate the lees. No clearing or filtration and no added sulfur ..... 725

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## GREECE

### 2017 VASSALTIS ASSYRTIKO

CYCLADES | SANTORINI | BIO (NOT CERT.)

Grapes from un-grafted vines with roots deep in the volcanic soils on the beautiful island of Santorini. Fermentation of whole bunches with natural yeast followed by 6 months sur lie in stainless steel vats. The result is a fresh generous wine with a tremendous minerality that keeps everything in place ..... 920

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## SLOVAKIA

### 2019 STREKOV 1075 "VELTLÍN" GRÜNER VELTLINER

SLOVAKIEN | JUŽNOSLOVENSKÁ | BIO (NOT CERT.)

Grüner Veltliner with its austere white pepperiness is one of our favorite grapes for our food. Here an umami aromatically healthy Grüner from Slovakia's most natural wine pioneer Zsolt Sütő. Soil is settled clay with a high content of iron and lime, which gives wines with minerality and fine acidity. The wine has been with the lees for 10 months before it was bottled unfiltered, unclear and without added sulphur ..... 790

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## HUNGARY

### 2019 BENCZE BIRTOK CHENIN BLANC

BALATON | BADACSONYI | BIO

Finely tuned, fresh and fruity unfiltered biodynamic Chenin Blanc from Hungary. The handpicked whole bunches were pressed and set to ferment in 330 liters of terracotta amphorae and 300-400 liters of old oak barrels. After about 11 months, the wine was bottled without clearing or filtration and without any added sulphur ..... 750

### 2017 ATTILA HOMONNA "HATÁRI" TOKAJI FURMINT

TOKAJI | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

Unlike many other winemakers in the region, Attila does not strive for power and fruity sweetness. Instead, it is finesse, minerality and high acidity that are his goals. He gets this through early harvesting, long fermentation in cool cellars, natural yeast, old vines and low harvest yields. Growing up takes place in old barrels until Attila thinks they are ready to be bottled. Grape material from over 120 years old vines. The wine was allowed to ripen for a year in large old oak barrels. Wet pebbles, fresh sourdough bread, toasted chestnuts, Darjeeling tea, lilacs and fresh pears. The acidity is razor sharp ..... 950

### 2018 SHIMANOCHI FUJIMARU "DELA TABLETOP"

TOKYO | KANTŌ

Delaware is a vitis labrusca grape, i.e. a grape of North American origin, but has been grown in Japan for many years. You can find it mainly in Yamagata in the north. Here we find a palpable scent of jasmine flowers backed by tones of fennel and wild herbs. The acid is fresh, long and food-friendly ..... 750

### 2020 J.M DREYER "ORIGIN" PINOT GRIS MACÉRATION

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ALSACE | BIO/DEMETER

Jean-Marc has one piece of advice for us – “don't confuse what you need with what the wine needs” – and he has a motto – “zéro, zéro, zero.” In other words, it concerns doing/adding as little as possible to get the most out of it, something that a Zen master could have said. 100% Pinot Gris grown in lime-rich clay. After hand harvesting, the grapes received a skin maceration of 12 days. No filtration and no added sulphites. Soundtrack of the taste: *Strawberry Fields Forever*.....840

### MV J.M DREYER "TRI-AUX" 18/19/20

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ALSACE | BIO/DEMETER

Three vintages Auxerrois (2018/19/20) that have had to be macerated separately for different lengths depending on how each vintage behaved. As always when it comes to Jean-Marc's wines, harvesting by hand, old oak barrels that are not topped up, and of course no filtration and no added SO<sub>2</sub> .....850

### 2019 SONS OF WINE "VIN DE MESS"

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ALSACE | BIO (NOT CERT.)

No less than 16 different grapes in this wine, including Riesling, Gewürztraminer, Pinot Gris, Auxerrois, Sylvaner, Chardonnay, Muscat and Verdejo. It really sounds like a mess, but the wine is super tasty and fresh with hints of flowers and a lot of fruit. Farid Yahimi aka Sons of Wine is an organic négociant, based in Beblenheim, Alsace, which has a very distinctive, young and rebellious style of winemaking.....690

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### 2020 REYNALD HEAULE "O" MACÉRATION PINOT GRIS

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LOIRE | BIODYNAMIC (NOT CERT.)

The hand-harvested grapes are destemmed and then left to lie with skin contact for 10 days. Fermentation with natural yeast in fiberglass tanks. The wine is allowed to ripen 6 months in older used oak barrels of 600 liters. When the wine is ready, it is bottled unfiltered and without added sulphites. Since this is a Pinot Gris, the wine after the skin contact gets a beautiful bright red color that rather resembles a rosé wine with notes of red summer berries .....810

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## GERMANY

### 2020 ENDERLE & MOLL "MUSCHELKALK" WEISSBURGUNDER

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BADEN | EKO/BIO (EJ CERT.)

There is a lot of talk in the wine world about Enderle & Moll and their natural wines with a fantastic structure and freshness. Here is a Weissburgunder (Pinot Blanc) that was Skin-macerated for just over a week. Wonderful tones of tropical fruit, rooibos tea, salty freshness and a finely tuned tannin structure. Minimal addition of sulphites added .....735

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### 2019 2NATURKINDER "WEINSCHWÄRMER" PINOT GRIS

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FRANKEN | BIODYNAMIC (NOT CERT.)

*Weinschwärmer* is the German name for a moth that the local bats in 2Naturkinder's vineyards like to munch on. Blend of 75% Grauburgunder (Pinot Gris), which after 5 days of skin maceration contributes with nice bright red color and notes of wild strawberries, and 25% directly pressed Riesling which contributes acidity and freshness. No clarification, filtration and no added sulphur .....800

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## CZECHIA

### 2017 MILAN NESTAREC "UMAMI"

MORAVIA | BIO (NOT CERT.)

The young but experienced winemaker Milan Nestarec has a thing for Asian food, and to that end he has created this cuvée. Blend of Traminer, Riesling, Müller Thurgau and Palava. Loess, ranks 6-15 years. The grapes were given 3-5 days of maceration (deseeded) in open vats, which gave structure but no tannins to speak of. 2 years on oak and acacia barrels. Natural yeast, no filtration or clearing. No added sulfur.....860

### 2017 MILAN NESTAREC "GINTONIC" SAUVIGNON BLANC

MORAVIA | BIO (NOT CERT.)

"Feeling supersonic, Sauvignon Blanc is my Gin Tonic", the young wayward wine maker Milan Nestarec sings. An odd but super tasty sauvignon blanc – light orange with one week skin contact for 1/3 of the grapes. Unfiltered no added sulfur. Fresh hints of grapefruit, passion fruit and oranges.....940

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## SPAIN

### 2020 COSTADOR "METAMORPHIKA" MUSCAT BRISAT

CATALONIA | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

Muscat from old bush vines in the Mediterranean hills of Conca de Barberà. Brisat is the old Catalan word for skin-macerated wines. The grapes lay with shell contact for six weeks in amphora followed by 8 weeks on old French oak. Flowers, rooibos tea, dried fruits, Mediterranean herbs and fine tannins. The wine comes in a ceramic bottle made from clay from the vineyard. No added SO<sub>2</sub>.....750

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## ITALY

### 2019 COLLECAPRETTA "TERRA DI PRETI"

UMBRIA | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

The Trebbiano Spoletino grape, not to be confused with Trebbiano Toscana (Ugni Blanc), is very rare. Spontaneous fermentation with one week of skin maceration of whole grape bunches, then soft pressing and four months of storage in stainless steel tank. No clearing or filtering. Complex taste with hints of flowers and stone fruits.....780

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## FRANCE

### 2017 MARIE & OLIVIER HORIOT ROSÉ DES RICEYS "EN BARMONT"

CHAMPAGNE | CORBIERS | BIODYVIN

Rosé de Riceys is a historic wine style in Champagne that produces serious age worthy wines that are somewhere between rosé and red. 100% Pinot Noir fermented with natural yeast and given seven days of maceration "semi-carbonique" (10% foot-trampled grapes, the rest whole bunches). Ten months of ageing in used Burgundy barrels. Bottled 19-07-16 without prior clarification or filtration.....960

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### 2021 ROMAIN LE BARS TAVEL ROSÉ

RHÔNE | SOUTHERN RHÔNE | TAVEL | BIODYNAMIC (NOT CERT.)

Romain Le Bars consists of the young progressive winemakers Valentin Valles, Sébastien Chatillon, Gregory Guillaume and Charles Soulier who in a short time put the southern Rhône on the natural wine map. Here a blend of 60% Grenache and 40% Syrah grown in clay and limestone. Direct pressing followed by spontaneous carbonation fermentation in small old oak barrels. No additives and no clarification or filtration. A serious Tavel rosé that offers flowers, red berries and fine freshness and texture.....790

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## FRANCE

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### 2017 DOMAINE MARQUIS D'ANGERVILLE VOLNAY 1ER CRU "CHAMPANS"

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BOURGOGNE | CÔTE DE BEAUNE | VOLNAY | ORGANIC/BIO

The vines grow in limestone soil on slopes to the southeast. Extremely elegant silky wine with balanced aromas built up by cherries, cranberries, mushrooms, roses, dried spices such as cinnamon and bay leaves. Long grand finish .....2100

### 2019 DOMAINE GÉNOT-BOULANGER VOLNAY 1ER CRU "LES RONCERETS"

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BOURGOGNE | CÔTE DE BEAUNE | VOLNAY | ORGANIC

Domaine Génot-Boulangier belongs to the small group of producers in Burgundy who succeed in the feat of making wines that are good to drink young, but can also be aged for decades. Grapes from vines planted in 1958 from 0.40 hectares in 1er Cru Le Ronceret. Fermentation takes place in a steel tank for 20-25 days (with 30% full-class fermentation) and then storage in oak barrels for 12 months (20% new) and then another 6 months on steel .....1500

### 2019 DOMAINE GÉNOT-BOULANGER CHAMBOLLE-MUSIGNY

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BOURGOGNE | CÔTE DE NUITS | CHAMBOLLE-MUSIGNY | ORGANIC

Génot-Boulangier was founded in 1974 and has been run since 2008 by Guillaume and Aude Lavollée, fourth generation winemakers. Grapes from vines from two different lieux-dits (a total of 0.76 hectares) in the southern part of the village: Les Nazoires and Les Mombies. Fermentation takes place in a steel tank for 20-25 days (with 30% full-class fermentation) and then storage in oak barrels for 12 months (20% new) and then another 6 months on steel .....1300

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### 2018 JEAN FOILLARD CÔTE DU PY MORGON

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BOURGOGNE | BEAUJOLAIS | CÔTE DU PY | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

Jean Foillard certainly shows that Gamay is in no way subordinate to Pinot Noir. Floral with ripe strawberries and cranberries, sandalwood and minerals. Soft well-integrated tannins. Grapes from old vines, some around 100 years. Bottled with filtration and minimal dose of sulphites added .....860

### 2016 JEAN FOILLARD "CUVÉE 3.14"

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BOURGOGNE | BEAUJOLAIS | CÔTE DU PY | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

This wine is not made every year. It is mostly a barrel selection of the Côte du Py, where it is the oldest vines and the main locations, and then only from the best years. Jean lets it lie a little longer on the barrel, and in the bottle, and releases it a year after his usual Côte du Py. Bottled with filtration and minimal dose of sulphites added. And what about the strange name? 3.14=PI≈Py as in Côte du Py :) .....1200

### 2020/2021 JAN VAN ROEKEL "SO WHAT GAMAY"

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BEAUJOLAIS | VIN DE FRANCE | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

The Dutchman Jan van Roekel runs a wine bar with his own imports in Amsterdam. His great interest in wine has driven him to make wines himself. He buys the grape material from his good friend Romain des Grottes in Beaujolais. The vintage gets to decide how the grapes are treated, but the recipe is always about minimal intervention and no additives. Here a blend of the 2020 and 2021 vintages that really gives us the definition of an easy-drinking party wine, while having gastronomic saltiness and structure .....770

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### 2020 LES PIEDS SUR TERRE "LES TROUILLOTS" TROUSSEAU

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JURA | CÔTES DU JURA | ECOCERT

100% Trousseau from vines that are over 35 years old, planted on soils from the Triassic era which consist of calcareous marl. The vineyard is south-facing and all the grapes are harvested by hand when it has reached full maturity. After harvesting, maceration with whole bunches takes place in stainless steel tanks for 12 days. The wine is then aged in stainless steel vessels until the following spring when it is bottled unfiltered. Raspberry juice with a good splash of lemon and a little spiciness .....950

### 2020 HUGHES BÉGUET ARBOIS "SILK BLUE"

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JURA | ARBOIS | BIO

Father-light biodynamic blend of 75% Poulsard, 15% Trousseau and 5% Savagnin. The inspired move to have Savagnin replace Pinot Noir in the otherwise classic trio from Jura provides freshness and spice. Careful handling in the wine cellar, natural yeast, no filtration or clearing, no added sulphur .....980

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**2020 PATRICE BÉGUET – NÉGOCE "FRESH IMPRESSION RED"**

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JURA/RHÔNE/LOIRE | VIN DE FRANCE | ORGANIC

Strictly speaking, not a Jura wine but a multi-address négociant wine vinified by Patrice at Domaine Béguet in the Jura. The wine consists of 60% Grenache Noir from Claude Ughetto (Provence), 30% Gamay from Domaine Lindron Chartier (Loire-Atlantique) and 10% Poulsard from Patrice's own vineyards. 80% of the grape material was pressed directly and the remaining 20% are allowed to macerate with the skin. Start by admiring the color before emptying the glass! The bright seductive ruby red hues tell us what's to come – it's lively and at the same time graceful, red berries and cherry aromas mixed with smoky tones and fine minerality. Fresh impression, indeed!..... 750

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**2019 REYNALD HÉAULÉ "A CONTRE COURANT" ROUGE**

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LOIRE | VIN DE FRANCE | ORGANIC

Reynald often works with unusual field blends. Gamay, Pinot Meunier, Pinot Noir and Cabernet Franc coexist in the bottle and give a complex slightly unusual taste palette where you can probably still say that the characteristic spiciness of Cabernet Franc is most noticeable. Spontaneous fermentation with natural yeast. The wine is allowed to mature in older used oak barrels 225 liters for 18 months. When the wine is ready, it is bottled unfiltered and without added sulphites throughout the process ..... 735

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**2020 FRANÇOIS LE SAINT SANCERRE ROUGE PINOT NOIR**

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LOIRE | SANCERRE | ECOCERT/BODYVIN

Grapes from calcareous soils that are harvested by hand and undergo a thorough sorting before being destemmed and cold macerated for a little over a week. The wine ferments with natural yeast for 3-5 weeks depending on the vintage. The malolactic fermentation takes place in barrels for 12 months. A really serious affordable Pinot Noir that easily competes with its relatives in Burgundy ..... 830

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**2021 LE CASOT DES MAILLOLES "COMAX ETHYLIX XXI"**

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LANGUEDOC-ROUSSILLON | ROUSSILLON | TARERACH | VIN DE FRANCE | ECOCERT

Blend on Syrah (80%) and Marsanne (20%) from logs of 20-25 years of age growing in terraces at an altitude of 550-600 meters with granite soils. By directly squeezing half of the destemmed grapes, Alain Castex has produced a wine that ticks off all the flavor boxes for the powerful grape Syrah, but at the same time retains a resilient food-friendly freshness. No additives of course..... 750

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**2019 LES CAVE DES NOMADES "CAMINO ROJO"**

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LANGUEDOC-ROUSSILLON | BANYULS | VIN DE FRANCE | BIO

Blend with traditionally vinified Grenache and directly pressed Syrah. The grapes are tended to using biodynamic methods. Natural yeast and no clearing or filtration. Super fresh yet with pronounced dark fruits filled with natural energy. On the back of the bottle you can read "*Contient de l'amour et des sulfites naturels issus de la fermentation*" – "contains love and natural sulphites from fermentation" ..... 820

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**GERMANY****2011 BERNHARD HUBER "SCHLOSSBERG" SPÄTBURGUNDER GROSSES GEWÄCHS**

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BADEN | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

Bernhard Huber. a.k.a *The Wizard of German Pinot Noir*, sadly passed away in 2014. This vintage is thus one of Bernhard's last. In Schlossberg, wine has been grown since 1492. The steep slope requires manual work and the skeletal soil with bright yellow limestone is geologically rare at the foot of the Black Forest. The wine has great inner warmth and depth, fantastic structure, pronounced minerality and dense fruit ..... 1790

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**2018 ENDERLE & MOLL "LIAISON" PINOT NOIR**

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BADEN | ORGANIC/BIO (NOT CERT.)

Enderle & Moll have earned themselves a cult following in the wine world, with their natural wines with great structure and freshness. Here we are offered floral, mineral rich elegance with tart cherries, cranberries, dried herbs and mushrooms..... 750

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**2018 ENDERLE & MOLL "BUNTSANDSTEIN" PINOT NOIR**

BADEN | ORGANIC/BIO (NOT CERT.)

Hand-picked grapes from vines growing in red sandstone. Like all Spätburgunder from Enderle & Moll, the wine is about elegance rather than power, although Buntsandstein exhibits slightly more of the latter than their other cru Muschelkalk does.....910

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**2018 ENDERLE & MOLL "MUSCHELKALK" PINOT NOIR**

BADEN | ORGANIC/BIO (NOT CERT.)

Hand-harvested grapes from 70+ years old vines grown in limestone soil (one of the oldest vineyard locations in all of Germany). The grapes are pressed in a small basket press after 4-6 weeks of maceration. 90-100% whole cluster, spontaneous fermentation natural yeasts and finished in a large 1500L barrel. The wine is then aged in used oak barrels from Domaine Dujac. No fining or filtration, minimal addition of SO<sub>2</sub>. To call this among the best and most Burgundian reds that can be found outside of France is no cliché.....910

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**2017 WASENHAUS "VULKAN" SPÄTBURGUNDER**

BADEN

One third of the grape material with whole bunches, gentle extraction and powerful natural fermentation for ten days. Pressing 14 days after harvest after which it was raised in old French oak barrels for one year followed by six months on stainless barrels before bottling. Fresh and elegant with hints of raspberry and crow's berries, silky tannins and a slight spiciness .....900

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**2018 WÖRNER DURBACHER "KOCHBERG" SPÄTBURGUNDER**

BADEN | EKO/BIO (EJ CERT.)

Durbach is located on the edge of the Black Forest. Here Matthias Wörner grows 5 hectares on steep slopes that extend 400m. The soil is granite and gneiss. He strives to create wines that reflect this unique landscape, and he therefore works with minimal intervention in the vineyard and cellar. The wine radiates elegance with acidity, red berries combined with minerality, soft tannins and spice from small oak barrels .....770

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**SWITZERLAND**

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**2017 DOMAINE JULIEN GUILLON "CUVÉE MATEO" PINOT NOIR**

VALAIS | BIO

Wine from Switzerland is not a common sight on Swedish wine lists, which is simply due to the fact that the Swiss drink up most of it themselves. Julien Guillon is rising star in Switzerland. His vineyards are located at 900 meters altitude in the slopes of the Alps, which means cool climate and wines with a distinct natural freshness. The natural theme is followed up in the wine cellar = no added sulphur and unfiltered .....1100

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**2019 VALENTINA ANDREI GAMAY**

VALAIS | SAILLON | BIO

The vines grow on barren granite soil (just like in the gamay "home region" Beaujolais in France), in terraced vineyards in the villages of Fully and Martigny. The vines are between 39 and 61 years. Fermentation on steel tank. Maceration with pigeage done by hand. Aging takes place on old barriques (small French oak barrels). Scent with an abundance of forest berries and forest floor, silky tannins and fine texture .....800

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**AUSTRIA**

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**2021 CLAUS PREISINGER "PUSZTA LIBRE!"**

BURGENLAND | BIO (NOT CERT.)

Claus Preisinger is perhaps the most well known natural wine maker in Austria. Biodynamically cultivated field blend on mostly Zweigelt backed up by a dose of Sankt Laurent for some extra spiciness. Carbonic maceration, unfiltered and no added sulphur .....640

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**HUNGARY**

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**2019 BENCZE BIRTOK PINOT NOIR**

BALATON | ORGANIC/BIO

Very vibrant, fresh and fruity unfiltered biodynamic Pinot Noir from Hungary. The vines were planted in 1999. Ten days of fermentation in open tanks without stems. The wine lay and rested with the lees in stainless steel tanks for 5 months before being bottled without filtration or clearing. Only 10 mg/l added sulphur..770

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## SERBIA

### 2017 OSZKÁR MAURER "KADARKA 1880"

SUBOTICA-HORGOŠKE PEŠČARE | DÉL-CSONGRÁD | ORGANIC

The vineyard Nosza Högyek is home to the oldest vines of Kadarka in the world, and Oszkár cares tenderly with biodynamic methods. It is only at particularly favorable vintages that he bottles the wine as "1880". Kadarka is often described as the Pinot Noir of Eastern Europe. In Kadarka wines you will often find notes of lingonberries where Pinot Noir pulls more towards sour cherries .....840

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## GREECE

### 2018 THYMIPOULOS "NAOUSSA ALTA"

MACEDONIA | XINOMAVRO | ORGANIC

In Naoussa, the Thymiopoulos family has been growing the Nebbiolo-like Xinomavro grape for many generations. The vineyard is cared for with organic and biodynamic methods. The soil consist of limestone and volcanic rocks. 18 days maceration and fermentation with natural yeast for 1-3 months in old French oak barrels. Unfiltered and with minimal sulfur added. We are treated to strawberries, rose hips, bay leaves, cinnamon and elegant tannins in this affordable Greek response to Italy's pride Barolo .....690

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## NEW ZEELAND

### 2017 SATO "PISA TERRACE" PINOT NOIR

SOUTH ISLAND | CENTRAL OTAGO | EKO

The enthusiasts Yoshiaki and Kyoko Sato want to show the world that so-called natural wines are not at all about taste (volatile acids and funkiness) but pure wines without additives. Blend on three separate fermentations from the same location – two with completely stalked grapes and one with whole bunches. All three have fermented spontaneously. Careful manual pressing once a day, then pressing in vertical basket press. A total of three weeks of maceration. 19 months on French oak, of which 13 percent new barrels. 5 mg/l sulphur added for racking and 10 mg/l when bottling. No clearing or filtering.....840
