Grower focus: Timothée Stroebel

Since his first harvest in 2005, Timothée has focused on champagne with great ripeness and depth, contrary to the trend of most traditional growers in the area. His approach and philosophy is the exception to the rule in a region where growers often consider yields and picking dates to be the number one priority. His vintage bottlings undergo long ageing in barrels and bear the name of the renowned Greek philosopher 'Héraclite', the French for Heraclitus, who once said, "No man ever steps in the same river twice, as the water flow is changing, but most importantly the man too." From this, the philosophical notion of "change is the only constant in life" was born.

Grower focus: Cidrerie du Vulcain

Jacques Perritaz was working as a biologist for the Swiss government when he decided to abandon the life of report writing in favour of a career that would bring him closer to nature. Jacques works with ancient rare Swiss apple varieties that yield too little fruit for commercial use. The trees are all untreated and some of them are up to 200 years old.

In recent years the movement of quality cidre production has evolved further thanks to Jacques' protegee Benni Oswald and his friend Markus Ruch who now celebrate in a similar vein the forgotten traditions of old apple, pear and quince orchards in the German speaking part of Switzerland called Thurgau.

Grape Focus: Grüner Veltliner

One vine in every three grown in Austria is Grüner Veltliner, and in Lower Austria this proportion rises to one in every two. You could say Grüner Veltliner is the business card of Austrian Wine and here at Newcomer Wines we like to think that we have tasted a fair share of this versatile terroir grape which demonstrates the country's diversity and individuality like no other. They appear in many guises; from growers searching for wines with concentration and depth, focusing on single site expressions, to experimental and distinctive skin fermented wines. From the sandy gravel, schist, and limestone soils of Burgenland, to historical appellations within the Kamptal Valley and the Unesco heritage region of Wachau.

Grower focus: Martin Muthenthaler

Martin Muthenthaler trained to become a mechanic and kept aligned indirectly to winemaking by working as a driver for Freie Weingärtner Wachau for 20 years. In the course of its restructuring and change of name to Domäne Wachau he was made redundant and had to start reorganising his life. Since 2006 Martin has been cultivating the three hectares of vines he inherited from his parents in the Spitzer Graben valley within the Wachau region - a tough climate and rocky terrain with minimal yields. Martin works the steep vineyards on his own, employing organic farming methods. He focuses on producing single vineyard bottlings, so that his wines can convey the distinctive character of each site.

Grower focus: Claus Preisinger

Claus Preisinger was one of the first Austrian winemakers to start experimenting with skin contact wines fermented in amphorae back in the mid 2000s. His interpretation of Grüner diverges from the classic style of white wines that typically emerge from this region and result in a unique expression of this classic Austrian variety.

Grape Focus: Riesling

...From the steep sandstone and volcanic conglomerate rock of the historical vineyards of Heiligenstein in the Kamptal, to the unique terroir of Hollenburg filled with calcareous and gravel conglomerate soils... To Mosel, with some of the most vertiginous vineyards of the Mullay-Hofberg, composed of weathered slate and quartzite soil, home to vines since the 12th century. Multi-layered & extremely mineral, sculpted and pure, this is the original king of German vineyards. Riesling has the ability to transmit personality of place through essence and distinctive aroma.

Grower focus: Lesehof Stagård

Urban and Dominique Stagård are now in their tenth year since taking over the reins from the long history of Urban's family estate. Early on, their focus shifted towards organic farming and elevating Riesling to the winery's most important terroir grape. Their obsession manifested itself by committing to an incredible amount of tiny single plots within the Kremstal appellations, proving the great diversity that every single vineyard achieves.

Grower focus: Nikolaihof

These are wines that show immense precision and elegance, across the different bottlings and vineyard sites. In some instances, longer élevage for some of the cuvées is an integral part of the process to find more stability and better energy in the wines. Whilst chatting to Niki and Katharina, you understand there is a real vision and passion for the winery. This vision is one rooted in tradition, but also looking to the future, and thinking long term. They are custodians of a property that many people look to as a bastion of Wachau production, and the respect and pride they have for this and the space is tangible.

'This place has been here for several thousands of years, during extremely tumultuous times - wars, poverty, disease, lots of hardship - and it has been the centre for the local community. Grape Focus: Furmint & Friends (Chenin Blanc)

From Furmint, the most important grape in Hungary, to Chenin Blanc, a grape that has been grown for centuries, perhaps even more than a millennium in the Loire Valley... From Rust, where you find three out of the ten hectares of Furmint planted in the whole of Austria (secretly brought across the iron curtain in the 1980s), to Chenin Blanc aged in an ancient troglodyte cave in second hand barrels from Haut Brion and Clos Rougeard... To a chance meeting of Furmint and Chenin growers along their path to winemaking. Similarities abound. Precision, focus, and complexity. Depth, richness, and longevity.

Schist

A hard, crystalline rock denser than slate, schist is made of layers of minerals that can flake off easily. It retains heat well and results in wines that are lifted, powerful and energetic and rich with minerality.

Sand, silt, clay & limestone

***Limestone** forms from the decomposed bodies of mollusks, fish, and other organic material that once lived in ancient seabeds and reefs. It tends to give long-lived wines with bright, linear acidity. **Sand** is any rock that has been pulverised into small particles and in the best areas they produce wines with delicacy and drinkability. **Clay**, a topsoil that some say imparts a profile to wines that is similar to the texture of clay itself — thick, round, and generous. **Silt / Loess** - While some silt soils can be too fertile for quality wine production, one good variety is loess, a type of wind-blown silt composed mainly of silica, producing wines that are creamier, richer, and more immediately fruity in youth.*

Volcanic Soil

Volcanic soils are formed from lava that cools and hardens to become igneous rock of various kinds, eventually breaking down to soil. It tends to be finely grained, drains well, retains and reflects heat, and holds water. They are full of minerals, and produce wines often rich in texture and flavour.

Alpine Influence

From the steep slopes of Styria through to the highest summit of the Alps, a continental, harsh and sometimes unforgiving climate is encountered. Soils are complex, from the famous “Opok” soil of Styria (clay/silt soils with limestone), to the calcareous schist slopes of the Valais. If the growers of Mythopia were to venture any higher on these Swiss slopes, it would be too cold to cultivate grapevines. Here, the culture of winemaking and grape growing can be traced back to Roman times, and today there is a collective movement towards minimal intervention in growing and winemaking.

Grower focus: Weingut Werlitsch - Ewald Tscheppe

‘Ex Vero’ means ‘from truth’ in Latin and captures Ewald Tscheppe’s primary concern - to make honest, authentic wines that capture a sense of place. Most of Ewald’s wines are blends of Sauvignon Blanc and Morillon (Traditional Styrian name for Chardonnay), and are aged for at least 18 to 22 months in large oak. The long ageing is an integral part of Ewald’s winemaking style and brings out the unique terroir-driven character of his wines.

Grower Focus: Damien Bastian Goddard - Ça boit libre

When we first tasted Damien's wines we were completely mesmerised by the energy in the bottle and so we set out to discover who its creator was. Eventually we found him, unearthing along the way that he worked with masters of their respective terroirs, Jean-François Ganevat and Dominique Lucas.

Damien's background is in Horticultural Agriculture, and he has many years' experience cultivating vegetables. "Ça boit libre" is a play on words; drinking freely (without additives), and Freedom for Savoie (Savoie LIBRE), is the name of his estate, created in 2017.

His estate encompasses two west-facing vineyards plots in Sciez, planted in 1985, in the appellation of Marignan. They are planted on glacial moraine, a mere 500m away from the breathtaking Lake Geneva.

Grower focus: Enderle & Moll

Even though they've only been going since 2007, Enderle & Moll have developed a reputation for flying in the face of just about every conventional estate in Baden. Even the venerable Jancis Robinson has called them "cult." Sven and Florian work with very old vines, some of the oldest Pinot Noir vines in Baden. Farming practices are organic & biodynamic. Everything is done by hand. Yields are kept low. Due to the striking difference to the "traditional" wines in the area, they bottle their wines as Deutscher Tafelwein (table wine). Pinot Noir is a grape that rewards attention - this is something both Sven and Florian can indulge their vines in.

Grape Focus: Blaufränkisch

Blaufränkisch originated within what was known as the Austro-Hungarian empire. The suffix -fränkisch dates to the early Middle Ages where it is thought that Blaufränkisch was first drunk and was considered one of the greatest in the world. -Fränkisch was used in countries where German was spoken to designate a family of wine grapes considered to be superior, put into law by Charlemagne, King of the Franks. Some of the finest Blaufränkisch is found in the state of Burgenland stretching from the Austrian-Slovakian border in the north to the Austrian-Slovenian border in the south via three sides of the Neusiedlersee Lake. From the minerality and finesse in the iron & slate on the Eisenberg in Südburgenland, to the beautifully perfumed and elegant wines around Lake Neusiedlersee, and across the border in Hungary with its century old traditions, the subtle nuances of origin & terroir expression make this a truly renowned grape.

Burgenland - The South

Grower focus: Christoph Wachter

In Südburgenland, the vines grow in primary rock, and the most prized terroir is the green schist of the Eisenberg hill, regarded as one of the finest sites for producing Blaufränkisch in Austria, producing wines of great finesse and focus. There are rolling hillsides, in a sense "small mountains" known as the pre-Alps, topped with forest; this regulates the temperature, another aspect of the microclimate of Südburgenland. The Wachter-Wiesler wines always have a characteristic silky texture, mineral core, floral aromatics and elegance: truly Blaufränkisch at its finest.

Hungary

Grower Focus: Franz Weninger

While Kékfrankos, the Hungarian equivalent of Blaufränkisch, originated in Hungary, it was still considered an underdog until 1997. The Weninger family's winemaking roots can be traced back to 1828, when the name first appeared in the records of Horitschon, a small town in Burgenland. In 2000, Franz Weninger decided to continue a project begun by his father who purchased 22 hectares of vineyards in the small village of Balf, Hungary, near the Austrian border. The Sopron wine region is situated on the northwestern border of Hungary, about 36 miles south of Vienna. Sopron has a similar climate to its neighboring region of Burgenland, where cold winters and hot, dry summers exemplify the Pannonian climate. The Sporn Steiner and Frettner vineyard sites farmed by Weninger are among the best in Hungary and have been cultivated for centuries. With its rare mineral soil composition of rich gneiss and mica schist, the single vineyard site of Sporn Steiner produces extraordinary Kékfrankos.
