## Cambridge, Dry Gin

Cambridge, England | 42% abv

Walks with Darcy, the distillery dog, through the meadows surrounding their distillery, inspired William and Lucy Lowe to capture the taste of the English seasons. Using botanicals grown in and around their own home they created a recipe including juniper, fresh basil, rosemary, angelica, lemon verbena, blackcurrant leaf and rose petals, each individually distilled and expertly blended into this outstanding gin.

This gin offers that totally straight, pure gin experience you've been looking for - London if you like - where the bitter, unfussy juniper takes the lead over all else without twittering about with too many botanicals, allowing such frivolities to sink to the rear. Almost makes you want to just freeze and drink it neat, or mix it with the straightest of tonics and pretend you're hanging out at the bar with Bowie in Berlin circa 1970s.
