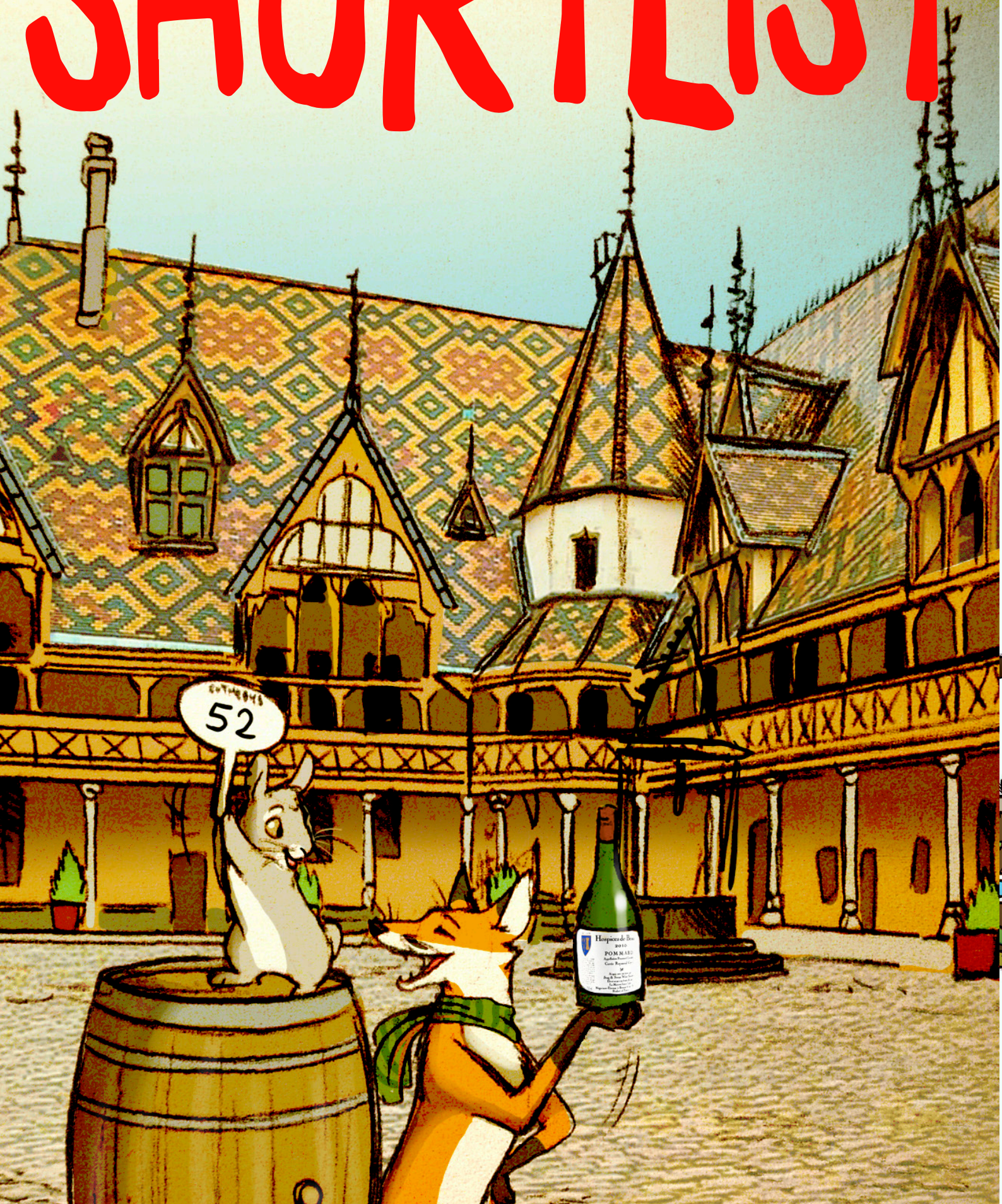

Dear Readers,

hot days characterize the summer and nature is in full bloom. In the vineyards, small buds formed into shoots, flowers, leaves and clusters. The vine stretches its leaves towards the warmth and soaks up the sun's rays with all its might. Through the miracle of photosynthesis, it turns light into sugar. After the *véraison* in July, the grapes are on the home stretch. In this process, the grapes change color and become soft and sweet. In addition, the aromatic substances accumulate in the grape skins and the berries turn into aromatic juice balls.

Because this process is fast, the winegrowers are already sharpening their scissors for the harvest in autumn. The harvest time must be right, because cut grapes cannot be reattached to the vine and you usually only really know months later whether you have hit the right time. Once in the cellar, red wine berries are mashed and macerated on the skins for several weeks to extract colouring, aroma and tannin. Only after the maceration period does the mash enter the press to separate the juice from the berry skin and stems. White wine grapes, on the other hand, are usually pressed in the press. From there, the must runs into the winemaker's container: for example, stainless steel tanks, barriques or concrete eggs. In the cellar, the must ferments and turns into wine after a few days, weeks or months. It is not until the end of the year that it will be quiet again for the winegrowers.

However, it can now be much quieter for you, while you can enjoy the fruits of the hard work of the winemakers. I currently like to drink the following wines. The **2012 Bruno Paillard Assemblage Champagne** is extremely delicate, fine and fresh, making it ideal for starting the evening. For me, one of the best Pinot Gris in the world is the **2016 Salwey Pinot Gris Henkenberg Grosses Gewächs Kaiserstuhl** – an excellent wine from the south of Baden.

The **2021 Hospices de Beaune Monthélie Les Duresses Cuvée Lebelin Burgundy** has just arrived. We bought the wine exclusively for the Brenners Park-Hotel when it was still in the barrel. The story can be read on page 15.

711, A pure Chardonnay with a particularly impressive fresh and fruity note. 100 Robert Parker

Louis Roederer & Bollinger

Louis Roederer

Louis Roederer is one of the best houses in Champagne. The company was originally founded under the name Dubois Père & Fils. When Louis Roederer took over his uncle's inheritance in 1832, he promptly renamed it and focused on growth and quality. Because of this strategy, Louis Roederer is still one of the largest owners of vineyards in Champagne today, producing some of the region's most sought-after wines.

Bollinger

The history of Bollinger began in 1829 with Athanase de Villermont. He joined forces with the German emigrant Joseph Bollinger and the wine-loving Paul Renaudin and they founded the champagne house Renaudin-Bollinger & Cie, which became Bollinger over the decades. The family-run house does not stand still, but is constantly working on new projects, from sustainable viticulture to perfecting the development of the base wines in barriques.

Sparkling and Semi-sparkling Wine

Carbon dioxide makes sparkling wines what they are. Simply a by-product of breathing to some, these molecules breathe new life into wines, exhilarate us and make life that much more fun. Nowadays, excellent sparkling and semi-sparkling wines can be found all over the world. Here, we have put together a collection from Germany, France and Italy. The difference between sparkling and semi-sparkling wines is mainly due to the pressure in the bottle. Semi-sparkling wines have less than 2.5 bar of pressure while sparkling wines must have over 3 bar.

Rosé Champagne

Did you know that two of the three grape varieties used for champagne are red? For most champagnes, the red varieties Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier are vinified white resulting in a light coloured champagne. And it is not only the colour that differentiates rosé champagne. The wines have a strawberry and raspberry scent and are richer and more abundant.

801, Volker Raumland has totally committed himself to sparkling wine and produces some of Germany's best. 90 Robert Parker

2020 Griesel Riesling Tradition Brut Hessische Bergstrasse 59

808, the German sparkling wine miracle has produced several top producers in recent years. Griesel is one of those sparkling wine experts who are redefining sparkling wine in Germany.

Reichsrat von Buhl Riesling Sekt Brut Pfalz 59

812, A fresh, thin-pearled Riesling sparkling wine that ferments on the full yeast for 30 months.

Schloss Neuweier Blanc de Noirs Sekt brut nature 59

806, This 100% Pinot Noir Blanc de Noirs from the 2019 & 2020 vintages was on the lees for over 24 months.

2014 Stigler Pinot Rosé Sekt Brut Kaiserstuhl 79

809, The grapes come from vineyards planted especially for this sparkling wine on the Ihringer Winklerberg. It is aged on the yeast for almost 7 years. More than twice as long as would be prescribed for a champagne.

Cavaliere Lambrusco Grasparossa Emilia-Romagna Italy 39

722, Lambrusco is back! This Grasparossa is dry, bottle fermented and has no added sulphur.

Bouvet Ladubay Trésor Rosé Sélection Saumur Brut Loire France 59

712, This rosé cuvée made from Cabernet Franc and Grolleau grapes is a classic from the Loire region bringing with it exceptional quality for this price.

Nyetimber Classic Cuvée British Sparkling Wine England 109

720, The signature wine of Nyetimber is a classic blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and Pinot Meunier and is a perfect balance of elegance and intensity.

Riesling

No other grape stands for German wine quite like this one. Treasured by wine drinkers on every continent, it even produced the most expensive wine in the world 100 years ago. Today, it still ranks among the white grape varieties of the highest quality even though it trails behind the wines from Bordeaux and Burgundy somewhat in price. I have tasted Rieslings throughout the world but nowhere does this grape feel more at home than in Germany.

Grauburgunder (Pinot Gris)

Are you a Grauburgunder fan? Hardly any other grape variety is currently more in fashion than the Grauburgunder and there are a number of good reasons for this. Our selection below covers many of these reasons. With its aroma and strength, Grauburgunder can produce great wines, particularly here in Baden.

- 2022 Weinhaus Heger Sonett Kaiserstuhl** 10/ 39
407, A lively and fruity Grauburgunder from Weinhaus Heger.
- 2020 Stigler Ihringer Winklerberg Pagode Grosses Gewächs Kaiserstuhl** 85
309, The juice for this wine comes from the grapes of the Vordere Winklerberg vineyard and brings the pure Grauburgunder taste to the glass
- 2020 Dr. Heger Achkarren Schlossberg Grosses Gewächs Kaiserstuhl** 79
354, West of the Winklerberg is the Achkarrener Schlossberg. It is partly very steep and is one of the warmest locations in Germany.
- 2016 Salwey Henkenberg Grosses Gewächs Kaiserstuhl** 89
412, The wines of the Salwey estate combine freshness with concentration like no other.
- 2019 Hanspeter Ziereisen Jaspis Würmlin Old Vines Markgräflerland** 159
379, The vines from which the grapes for the intense Würmlin originate are indeed old. For over 60 years, these gnarled plants have been digging into the calcareous loess soil and producing a rich wine that is second to none.
- 2016 Albert Mann Pinot Gris Hengst Grand Cru Alsace France** 99
346, A highly aromatic Pinot Gris with balanced acidity that elegantly balances the fine residual sweetness of the wine.

Weißburgunder (Pinot Blanc)

Weißburgunder, also known as Pinot Blanc, is Grauburgunder's sibling. While Grauburgunder has coloured skin, the Weißburgunder grape is very light. Getting the best out of the grape has proven difficult for many. Not for the following winemakers, however.

Chardonnay

If there's one grape variety that can outstrip Riesling of its 'king of the white wines' title then it's Chardonnay. In Burgundy, some of the most complex wines ever produced have been pressed from Chardonnay. Chardonnay is also being planted more and more frequently in Germany. And for many years now, great wines have been pressed from this grape variety in the New World – from America to Australia.

Domaine Leflaive


This small winery in Burgundy enjoys a history that dates back to 1717. In the 20th century, the family-run estate worked its way to the wine world's top tier and the Chardonnays from Domaine Leflaive rank among France's most coveted wines. Following environmentally friendly working practices wherever possible has been important to the family for some time, hence the Leflaive's being credited as being pioneers of biodynamic viticulture in Burgundy.


The most famous of the Domaine Leflaive vineyards are to be found in the Côte de Beaune surrounding the Le Montrachet appellation. All neighbouring plots also have the name 'Montrachet' in their designation. One could almost say that this part of Burgundy represents the hub of the Chardonnay world as no other area produces such superb, high-quality wines from this grape variety as here.

371, A great Pouilly-Fuissé made from old vines grown on Jurassic shell limestone. 2021 There were only low yields, therefore a very limited vintage

2019 Leflaive Pouilly-Fuissé  249
331, A great Pouilly-Fuissé made from old vines grown on Jurassic shell limestone. The wine is aged for over 12 months in oak barrels.

2010 Leflaive Puligny-Montrachet Les Folatières Premier Cru Burgundy France  999
902, 2010 was a very good vintage for Domaine Leflaive and also from the location Les Folatières come great wines. 93 Robert Parker

2011 Leflaive Chevalier Montrachet Grand Cru Burgundy France  1.199
370, Chevalier Montrachet is considered to be one of the best Grand Cru vineyards for Chardonnay in Burgundy. The barren soil forces the vines to fight for water which in turn produces highly concentrated grapes. 95 Vinous

2010 Leflaive Puligny-Montrachet Les Pucelles Premier Cru Burgundy France  1.499
903, The location Les Pucelles is classified as a Premier Cru, but produces qualities that could fit into the Grand Cru category. 95+ Robert Parker

2008 Leflaive Puligny-Montrachet Burgundy France Magnum  1.599
904, It matures better in large bottles and this rich Chardonnay has now fully arrived in its drinking window. It smells of citrus aromas and roasted notes.

Sauvignon Blanc

Sauvignon Blanc is 'joie de vivre' in a glass. This grape variety has an extremely intense bouquet of ripe fruits along with grass and spices. In New Zealand, even cat's pee is among the identified aromas in one or two examples. How delightful! Sauvignon Blanc can stimulate the taste buds in its own unique way and it combines extremely well with food.

Hospice de Beaune

The bells are ringing. Excited voices from all corners. Wine merchants, journalists and wine enthusiasts sit close together in the “Halles de Beaune” and wait for hundreds of barrels of wine to go under the hammer. Beforehand, there was eager tasting and discussion about the quality of the vintage and the evaluation of the different wines. We also felt the tension in the room, because our team from the Brenners Park-Hotel did not want to return empty-handed from Burgundy. That’s why we had studied the auction catalogue carefully and had the auction sign ready.

In the heart of Burgundy, an auction has been held for over 160 years that is second to none. On 61 hectares, the Hospices de Beaune produces more than 50 wines from the best vineyards. The highlight: The Hospices de Beaune is actually not a winery, but a former hospital. It owes the impressive variety of vineyards to charitable donors and the proceeds of the annual auction go to charity.

The history of the Hôtel-Dieu began in 1443. The Hundred Years’ War was coming to an end and the population was suffering from the hardships of recent decades. Nicolas Rolin, the chancellor of Burgundy, founded a hospice to help the poorest and most needy. However, the magnificent Gothic building with colorful roof tiles was not an ordinary hospice. The well-heeled chancellor spared no effort to build a palace for the poor and needy. The bourgeoisie donated works of art and land to the hospice, and winegrowers thanked with vineyard plots. In 1795 the time had come: the first auction for the auction of the prized wine barrels took place.

Back to the 161st auction, where the team from the Brenners Park-Hotel was allowed to sit in the audience. The mood was exuberant and the general highlight was certainly the auction of the Pièce des Présidents, which went under the hammer for a good cause for 800,000 euros. We were also successful and so today we can win the 2021 Monthélie Les Duresses Cuvée Lebelin present to you for the first time. The wine is named after Etienne Lebelin, the first hospital chaplain of the Hospice de la Charité. The wine comes from a cooler location and, according to Burgundy expert Jasper Morris MW, produced an aromatic wine with a fine and elegant finish in 2021.

Orange Wine

The aromas and tannins contained in the grape skins change the wine into something totally new. This technique has been practiced in some regions for hundreds of years but is currently being well received in the mainstream wine world, enriching it with an additional style.

California Dreamin'

“All the leaves are brown, and the sky is grey...” sang the Mamas and the Papas in their 1965 folk rock classic. California has long been a dream destination for many. But when this song was first played, no one suspected that the Golden State would one day become one of the most important and exciting wine-growing regions in the world. California’s wine history is relatively short. Nevertheless, the region’s Pacific-influenced wines are among the best in the world. And they continue to improve as winemakers get to know their vineyards. In the course of this year’s California Wine Weeks, we want to focus on this region.

Domaine de la Romanée-Conti

If the wine world had to agree on a winery that represents the pinnacle of quality, it might be the Domaine de la Romanée-Conti. Among connoisseurs, the winery is simply abbreviated as DRC, and these three letters carry a lot of weight. The Domaine is located in the sleepy village of Vosne-Romanée, close to some of Burgundy's best locations. DRC's eight Grand Cru vineyards are cultivated organically and with great attention to detail. On my last visit, I was even able to observe how the vineyards are worked with horses to protect the soil.

Great Pinot Noirs are hard to beat when it comes to intensity, complexity and longevity. Burgundy is viewed as the birthplace of Pinot Noir but nowadays Germany too produces some of this grape variety's best wines.

515, The Salwey winery specializes in producing clear and straightforward wines from the Burgundy varieties. The Eichberg is clear and straightforward, but at the same time shows great depth and complexity.

504, This Pinot Noir smells of cherries and blackberries and is rich and intense on the palate.

Germany is a red wine country. At least we produce more red wine here than you might think. Two thirds of the vineyards are planted with Dornfelder, Lemberger and Cabernet Sauvignon, among others. German Pinot Noir have now made it to a certain celebrity but the many other red grape varieties are not yet in all mouths. Here we make the beginning and present some exciting red drops, which we foresee a good future in Germany.

And that's good news because Spain has a wealth of exciting grape varieties and wine styles to offer that are not often encountered in the rest of the wine world. Here we've compiled an excellent choice for you.

2021 José Pariente Verdejo Rueda Spain 39

339, Verdejo is a white grape variety that appeals to wine drinkers with its intensive aroma and freshness. At José Pariente, they've learnt how to get the maximum out of the grape. Impressive from the very first sip.

2019 Sierra Cantabria Crianza Rioja Spain 12 / 45

602, This pure Tempranillo is aged in used barriques and bottled without being filtered. Its aroma is of ripe cherries and smoke. On the palate it's rich and juicy.

606, This Rioja smells of ripe cherries and cigar box and is smooth and rich on the palate

2011 López de Heredia Viña Tondonia Reserva Rioja Spain 119
