## KOREAN TRADITIONAL ALCOHOL

Traditionally, Korean rice brews fall under the categories of chungju, takju, and soju. All three are derived from the same brewing process: Rice is fermented with nuruk, a wheat cake fermentation starter that lends traditional brews their characteristic funk.

Named after a phrase of a poem written by a famous scholar from Joseon Dynasty, Nong-Am Lee Hyun Bo, this historical chungju has inherited his legacy brewed by his family for centuries. The subtle rice notes with fruity flavours and sweetness are well balanced by acidity.

The makgeolli from I-Dong, Pocheon. 1 of most popular regions producing Makgeoli. Brewed through double fermentation to select great quality yeast. Named after famous lake on top of mountain. Sanjeonghosu display pleasantly balanced Makgeoli with minerality, fruit note with its velvety texture.

The takju brewed in traditional way of fermenting hundred days in the pottery, "Chu" (Autumn) displays floral aroma with unique notes from the balance of bitterness and sweetness.

A gluten-free makgeolli made with a proprietary in-house produced rice yeast. This product is the essence of the research center that gave birth to many of recent owner brewers. With tropical fruit aromas, this delicate makgeolli reveals the depth and complexity of rice wine.
