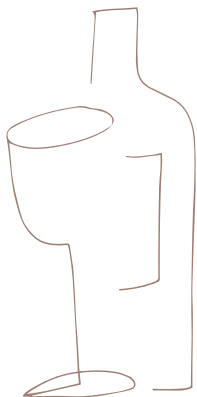
### Champagne Philipponnat

The Philipponnat family have been cultivating vines around the town of Mareuil-Sur-Aÿ since 1522, and six centuries later the house is presided over by Charles Philipponnat.

### Clos des Goisses

Philipponnat has owned an exceptional walled vineyard, the Clos des Goisses, for nearly a century. In the old Champagne dialect the name of this 5.5 hectare plot means a very steep slope. It is also the warmest terroir of the region: facing due south, this pure chalk slope receives no shade from sunrise to sunset. It is considered the most consistently great single vineyard wine in all of Champagne.

### Valley of the Loire Hillside to Shoreline

White chalk soils are the signature of central France and the vineyards of Sancerre are some of the most famous planted on these calcified fossil remains. As France's longest river turns west at Orléans the Loire continues its lazy 629 mile journey to the Atlantic, passing the tuffeau chalk caves of Vouvray, until granite soils take over at the sea swept coast of Muscadet.

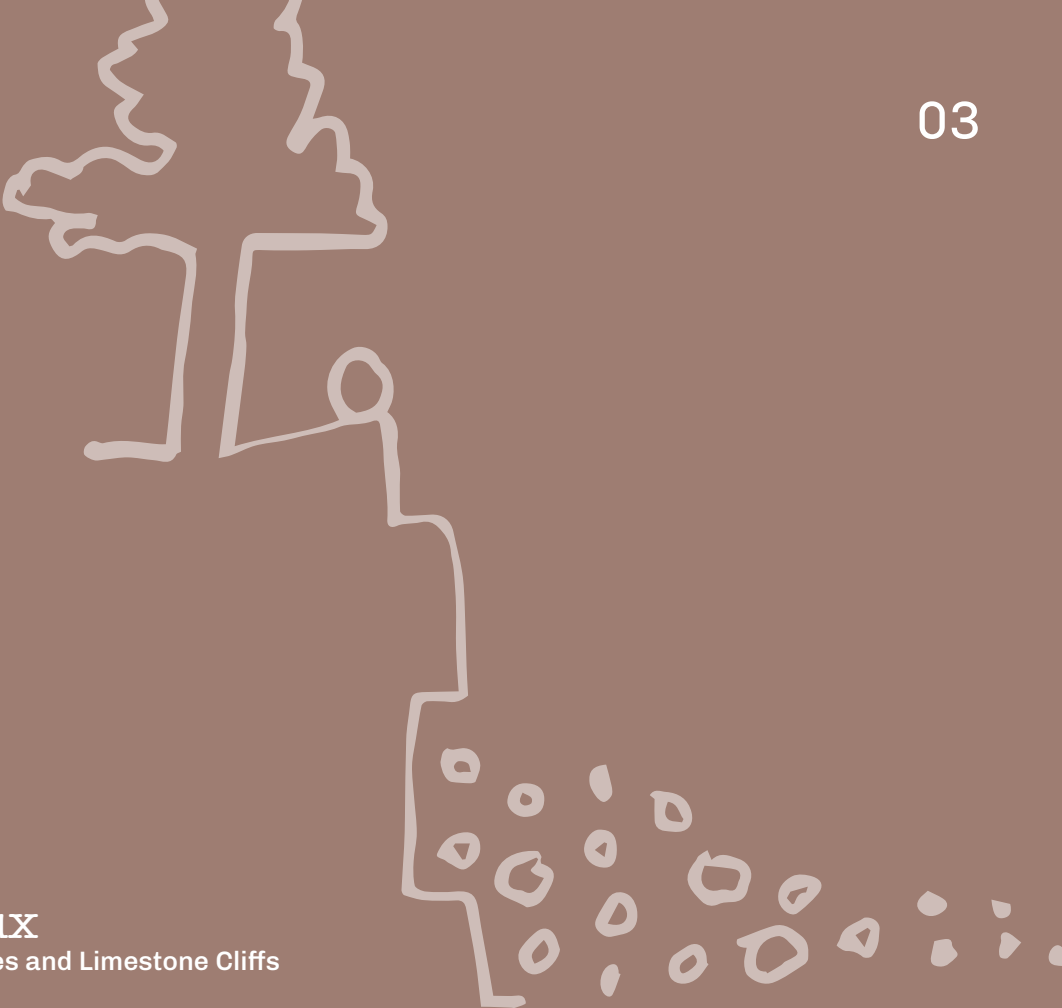

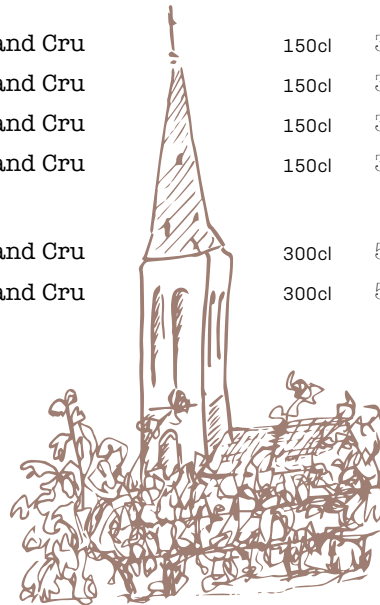

### Clos Dubreuil, St Emilion Grand Cru Classé

A rising star of Saint Emilion that cemented its cult status when it was promoted to grand cru classé status. Clos Dubreuil started as a single 1.5 hectare in 1998 with a goal to become one of the top producers in the region. The property has been gradually enlarged to 8.8 hectares under the watchful eye of the Eads family who have a long, rich history with French wines. Composed of 70% Merlot, 25% Cabernet Franc and 5% Cabernet Sauvignon, the wine is fermented under the expert eye of a Alain Reynaud, one of the region's most sought after winemakers, and is aged in new French Oak.

## 04 Voyage to the New World The Americas, South Africa & the Antipodes

Around the middle of the nineteenth century French winemakers started to notice that their vineyards were dying. The cause was soon identified as the phylloxera aphid which had been imported by accident along with a consignment of American vine cuttings. The destroyer, as it became known, had a devastating impact that was felt all over Europe, forcing bankrupt families to flee to other parts of the world. Although vines may be grafted to allow them to continue producing grapes, phylloxera remains a global problem with no cure, and this section of the list pays homage to those who pioneered winemaking in the new world.

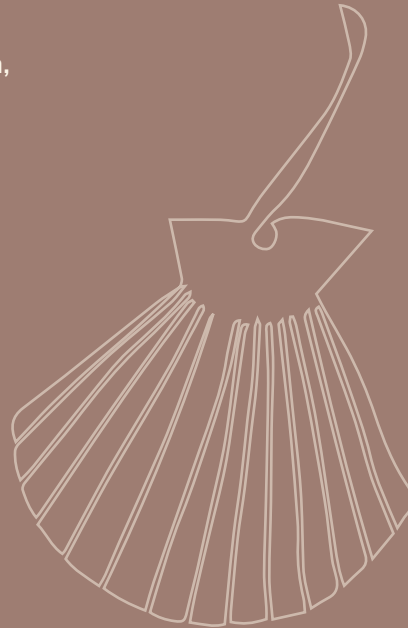

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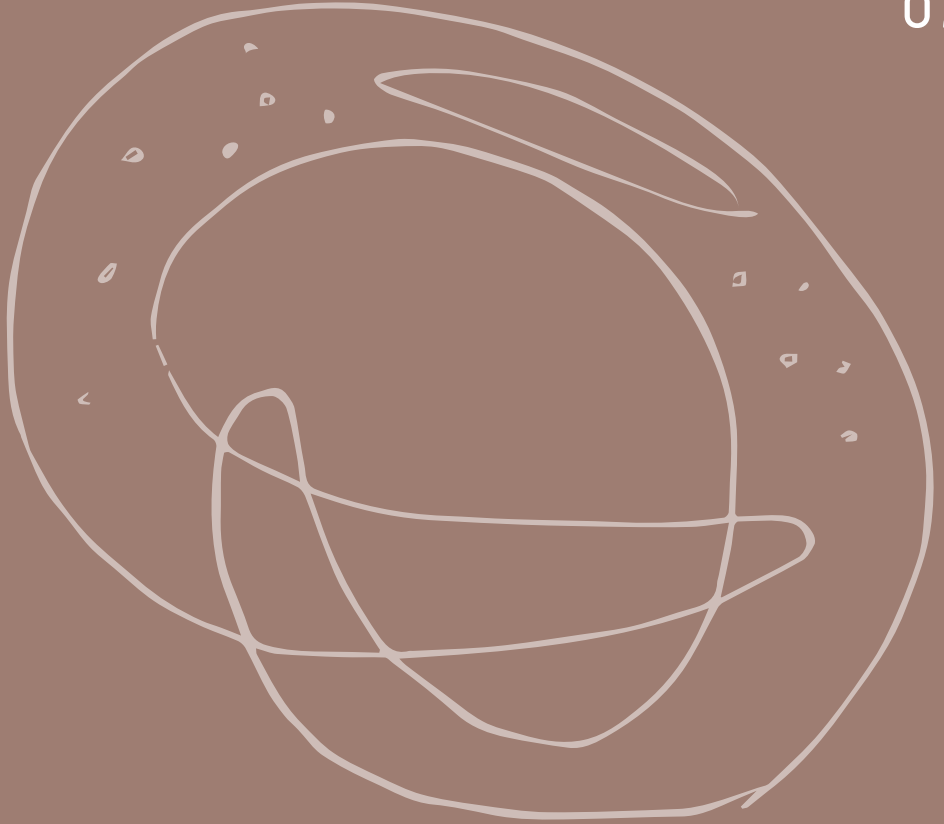

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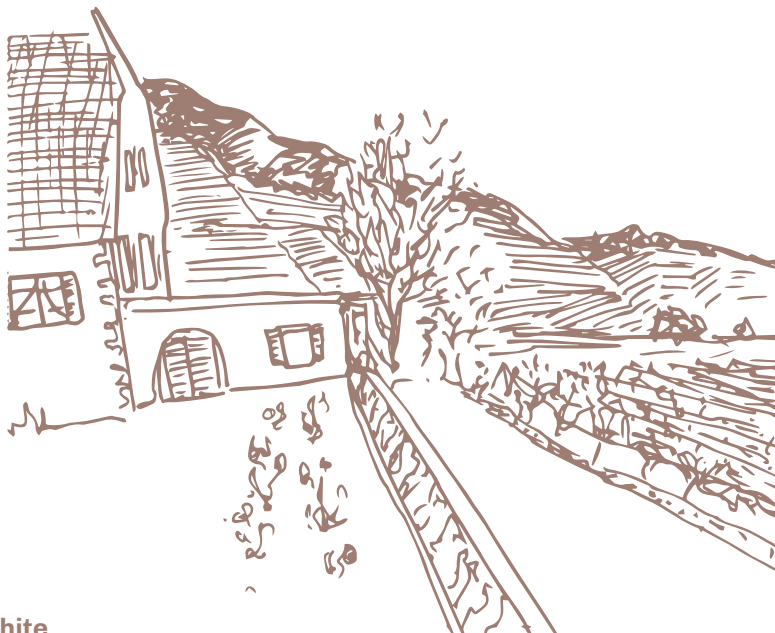

A patchwork of vineyards in the rain shadow of the gentle Vosges mountains, Alsace is exceptionally sunny, and is home to an impressive collection of grape varieties, soil types, and truly gastronomic wines.

Across the border featherlight Rieslings come from vines perched on the vertiginous slate slopes of the gently flowing Mosel. On the banks of the mighty Rhine the wines take on a mineral power, while in the warmer heartlands of Rheinhessen and Pfalz fuller bodied reds and whites resemble their Alsatian cousins.

With vines inside and outside Clos des Perrières one has the rare treat of being able to compare two terroirs within Meursault's finest premier cru appellation side by side. Close to the old cellar you will find the Clos des Murgers, another walled vineyard, which includes a not be missed Bourgogne from declassified Meursault vines.

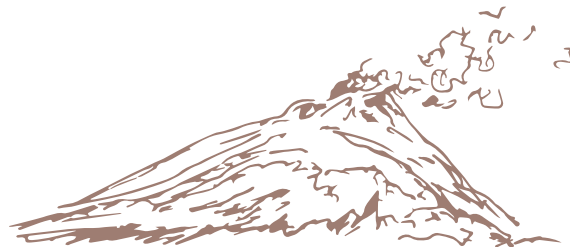

### Southern Rhône Papal Relics

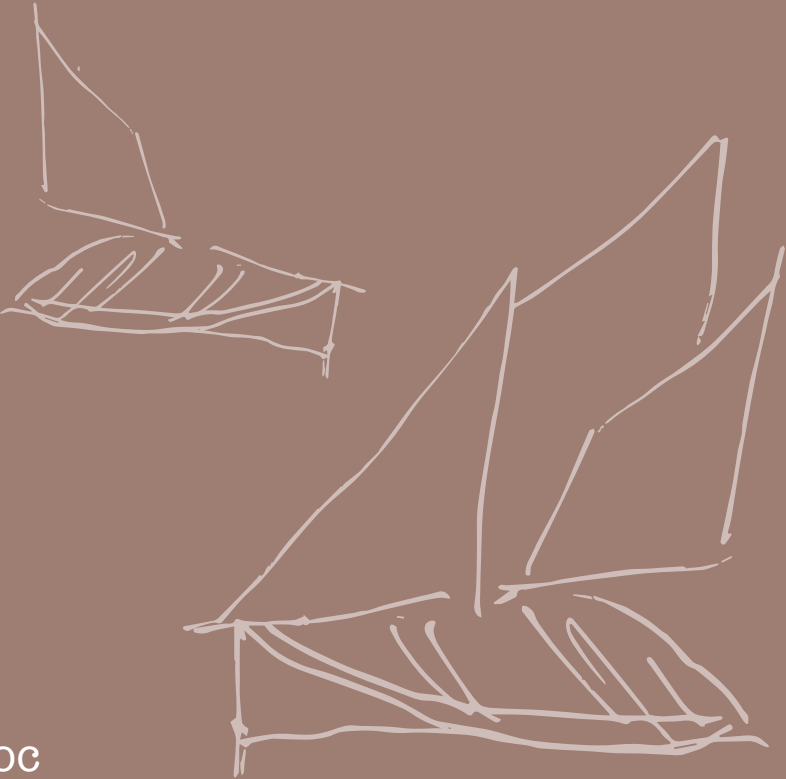

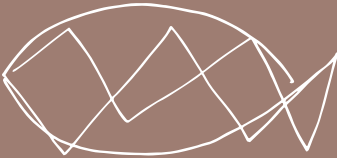
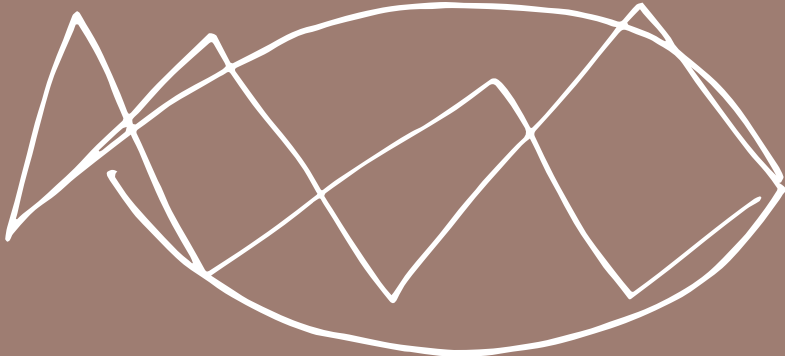
### Bandol

Perched on terraces among the pines above a former fishing village, Bandol is a survivor on a coastline devoted to holiday luxuries. At one time it seemed that it would be swallowed up by the developers' zeal to populate every inch of land with villas and hotels, such is the demand for property on Provence's Côte d'Azur. It is thanks to the efforts of families like the Peyrauds of iconic Domaine Tempier that we have the opportunity to enjoy so many rich expressions of one of France's most profound and ageworthy wines. Composed primarily of Mourvèdre, a grape that captures so memorably the wild herbs and scorching heat of the land, the wines carry the salty tang of the Mediterranean winds, lifting the dense, earthy flavours to a radiant high.

#### Vermilion Coast

Where the Pyrenees sweep down to the Mediterranean the charming port towns of Collioure and Banyuls-sur-Mer are the jewels of a rugged coastline dotted with vineyards of old vines eking out meagre yields in dry schist soils. 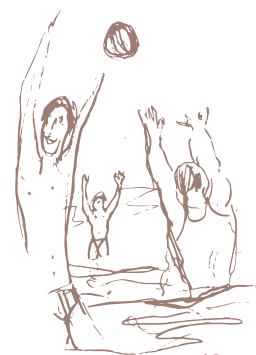
