NV **Larmandier-Bernier** 1er Cru 'Longitude Blanc de Blanc' © ‡ 65

*Larmandier has farmed their Premier and Grand Cru sites biodynamically for over 20 years, crafting Champagne that reflects pure terroir. Their Blanc de Blancs 'Longitude' is powerful and structured, with aromas of sweet orchard fruits, citrus zest, white flowers, fresh bread, and pastry. Fleshy and enveloping, it boasts a ripe profile with a saline finish.*

### SPARKLING

2021 **Daosa** 'Rosé' Piccadilly Valley, SA 25

*Very light salmon-pink hue; pot-pourri, quince-paste, nutty and just-ripe strawberry aromas, very appealing and the oak factor is quite subtle. Full and rich in the mouth, with a pleasingly dry but soft-textured finish.*

NV **Charles Heidsieck** 'Brut Reserve' Champagne, France © 34

*One of the great champagne houses! The Brut Reserve blend of equal parts Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Meunier with extended aging is rarely matched by its peers. Boasting a deep golden hue, delicate bubbles from slow maturing in chalk cellars and a voluptuous nose of Mirabelle plum, pistachio, and almond. Creamy pastry, praline, and vanilla dance in step with a precise, dry finish.*

### PREMIUM ROSÉ

2022 **Clos Cibonne** 'Tradition' Côtes de Provence Cru Classé, France © ‡ 41 103

*This stunning Rosé wine comes from the most southerly of the 18 Cru Classe growers in the Cotes de Provence AOP. The Tibouren grape variety accounts for 90% of these vintages, along with 10% of Grenache. They are the vineyard's historical cuvees which have existed since 1930. The wines are impeccably balanced, and the 'Tradition' Rosé is the calling card of the estate. Orange peel, white cherry, dried herbs, cinnamon and lemon pith. A crunchy, salivating finish. Wonderful stuff.*

### ROSÉ

2023 **Jilly Wine** 'White Wolf of Cumbria' Orange/Central Ranges NSW ‡ 15 38

*Cabernet Sauvignon and Sangiovese harvested in the cool of the night and left on skins for 4 hours to obtain a slight pink colour. They were then pressed into stainless steel tanks for fermentation using native yeast and left on lees for a further 10 months to build texture. Textural and vibrant Rosé, hint of strawberries and cream, bright and lively. Very easy drinking!*

### ORANGE

2022 **Somos** 'Los Melones Dinámicos' McLaren Vale, SA ‡ 17 43

*An orange wine from 100% Biodynamically farmed Viognier. Lots of ginger spice, fresh Apricot, Peach, Honeydew and Canteloupe, Mandarin peel, stewed stonefruits, and hints of dried apricots and white pepper on the nose, with a compelling full palate, textural and soft with apricot silkiness, honedew crunch, rockmelon headiness and soft brioche and white pepper spice notes.*

### PREMIUM WHITE

2020 Bourgogne Blanc, **JanotsBos**, Burgundy, France © 47 118

*The Bourgogne Blanc comes from 'Les Pellans' (Meursault) and 'Champ Perrier' (Puligny-Montrachet). Aged on wood for 8–9 months without new barrels, it offers a powerful nose of apple, lime, orange, and white pepper. The palate is pure and full, with bright acidity, a mineral undertone, and abundant fruit.*

### WHITE

2024 Riesling, **Ravensthorch** 'Regional' Murrumbateman, NSW ‡ 17 43

*Fermented in ceramic and concrete eggs and left on lees for ten months. The nose is a combination of lemon balm aromatics with some white blossom, gardenia florals. On the palate the mouthfeel has a grapefruit pithiness supported by a fine and taut acid line contributing tension and energy, wrapping up with a saline finish.*

2022 Sauvignon Blanc, **Michael Hall**, Adelaide Hills, SA 18 43

*Light-mid yellow appearance; reserved, somewhat shy nose, with some nutty suggestions of barrel work, the mouth full of fruit and plenty of appeal, finishing clean and dry with a trace of grip adding length and finish. Straw/dried-herb and nutty barrel flavours abound. A very tasty savoury style of Sauvignon Blanc.*

2022 Melon, **Ménard-Gaborit** 'Accostage' Muscadet, Loire Valley, France ‡ 20 50

*Organic Muscadet from the Ménard family, who are up to the 6th generation working their farm and cellar. A clear, pale yellow colour with light green reflections. An ultra-fresh nose with aromas of iodine and white flowers. A beautiful attack on the palate with aromas of white fruits, citrus fruits and green apple with a touch of minerality.*

2024 Aligoté, **Sentio**, King Valley, Vic 21 53

*This Aligoté from Darling Estate Vineyard in the Upper King Valley offers bright aromas of yellow flowers and green pear, with a fresh, waxy texture and lively vitality. Once underappreciated, Aligoté is now enjoying a well-deserved resurgence, and this bottle captures its charm with effortless elegance.*

2023 Chardonnay, **Nocturne** 'Yallingup-SR', Margaret River, WA 20 50

*Part of their Sub-Regional range, this Chardonnay comes from small vineyards in Treeton, northeast of Margaret River. Julian Langworthy crafts a scintillating expression—tight, citrusy, and linear at first, then unfolding with stone fruit, creamy lees, and nutty notes. Savoury, moreish, and refined, with mouth-watering acidity and exceptional length.*

2023 Roussanne/Grenache Blanc, **Thisledown** McLaren Vale, SA 28 70

*A beautiful example of a Rhône inspired white wine. Richly textured with creamy, aromatic and exotic notes from Roussanne and more vibrant, green apple from Grenache Blanc. The end result is a wine so versatile, complex yet so moreish.*

There is spicy red and black fruit on the nose and a creamy mid-palate, leading into an iodine-laced finish. This is a seriously good expression of Marsannay.</i>

	<i>Fruit is sourced from the estate vineyards of Clarence House Winery, where Max's Day job is. Beautifully positioned and protected in the valley's East of Hobart, this wine offers up lovely dense cherry fruit, framed nicely by five spice, amaro character and refreshing acid. Volcanic soils add a whiff of smokey mineral which rounds out this impressive Pinot.</i>		
NV	Zweigelt, <b>Matthias Warnung</b> 'Basis' Kamptal, Austria ‡	28	70
	<i>This wine is a blend of three different younger vineyards. Ruby-red in colour with purple highlights. The bouquet has an attractive, spicy aroma with notes of red fruits, wild berries, tobacco and cinnamon. The palate is soft, balanced and fresh. Vibrant berry notes in a pleasant, velvety finish are complemented by hints of herbs and wild cherries.</i>		
2024	Cinsault/Mourvèdre, <b>Adlib</b> 'Drinky' Barossa Valley, SA ‡ (Chilled)	17	43
	<i>This wine shines with a vivid watermelon hue and bursts with wild strawberry aromas. Crisp and textural, it offers hints of rose water and a lingering sea breeze finish—perfect for warm days and light fare!</i>		
2023	Cabernet Sauvignon, <b>Fleet</b> 'Chirside' Yarra Valley, VIC ‡	21	53
	<i>A classic style, coming from a long cool ripening season to help produce a wine of vibrancy and elegance. Deep blue/purple colour, vibrant lifted aromatics on the nose, cassis, heady spices, anise, wild fennel, tobacco leaf. Fleshy, juicy blackcurrant and blueberries that glide like velvet. Tannins interweave to a long finish.</i>		
2021	Grenache/Mataro, <b>Brash Higgins</b> , McLaren Vale, SA ‡	17	43
	<i>Pretty nose, floral and sweet fruited. Notes of tar, orange peel and spice from the Mataro co-mingles nicely with the lively, bright red fruited Grenache. Medium bodied the wine enters soft but pulls back subtly with with silky tannins from the thicker-skinned Mataro. The 20 GR/M strikes a nice counterbalance between the openly fruity nature of Grenache and the darker, more brooding nature of Mataro.</i>		
2022	Syrah, <b>Ben Haines</b> 'Colour Block' Grampians, Vic	20	50
	<i>Medium bodied, highly perfumed Syrah rippling with supple fruit and mineral accents. Fragrant herbs, blue flowers, bramble and graphite – all signatures of the region, and Miners Ridge vineyard more singularly. Fresh and savoury in structure, promising youthful vitality now, or longevity in the cellar for some time to come.</i>
