



## THE BLACK BULL

*Welcome to the Black Bulls wine list. We have broken the wine list into different sections hopefully to help guide its navigation. Firstly, is our concise wine list which presents an eclectic mix of organic, biodynamic, some might call 'natural' and conventional wine to suit all. Beyond that we have the cellar list, the rest of the wines we have on site, which is perfect for the wine geek to find something special. Bottles we've been resting, featuring well known classics, and some little-known hidden gems.*

*The wine list reflects Nina Matsunaga's philosophy when it comes to food, focusing often on smaller producers who care about their craft. Sometimes we forget that producing wine is another form of farming and those methods of farming are crucial to the final product. When selecting wines this has been a focus, but also a challenge as sustainability is such a complex subject and further marrying that with guest expectations is never going to be easy. Having said that, flavour, like anything we serve, is at the forefront when selecting.*

*Looking at the list you might not see the usual suspects but within the list's pages there's something for everyone. If you don't see what you recognise, I'm sure there's something within the list along the same lines. We also embrace wines from outside the main regions and countries, from places who have been producing wine for centuries and produce some of the best on the list. Some may be cloudy, have a slight fizz that will settle but these are a natural trait of some of these wines only adding to their flavour and complexity. There are however also many that don't, so if you swayed either way just ask, and someone will help.*

*The world of 'natural' wines is a fascinating one. Many of the techniques and practices are not new ones, but old ones before the industrialisation of wine making began. Orange wine is certainly not a new concept, a fad of young drinkers, it's thousands of years old and would have been much more common than white wine. Their primary focus is to produce a wine as true and honest as they can, with minimum intervention. It's this 'minimum intervention' that really interests, wines that are left to sing for themselves not tuned with added sugars, sulphites, colours, and other flavours to mask its identity. You still must acknowledge the importance of more conventional wines though. Those that still practice good farming methods and produce good wine. I think if you understand both sides of the wine world then you can achieve a well-balanced wine list, which we hope we do at the Black Bull Inn.*

*Black chalk, Classic Brut 2021, Hampshire, England* £12.50 £69  
*Fresh, full of orchard fruits - green apple and pear with floral notes & a biscuit-y bite. The use of oak barrels and 28 months on lees provide it with depth and complexity.*

*Black chalk, Wild Rosé 2021, Hampshire, England* £12.90 £75  
*Delicate wild-rose pink, classy & complex. Wild Rosé walks the fine line between freshness & bright fruit. Red fruits, soft creamy texture, from partial malolactic fermentation, leading to a deliciously long finish.*

*Cottonworth, Classic Cuvée, Hampshire, England* £65  
*Refined, creamy sparkling wine that offers a brilliant balance between chalky, fruity, floral, and yeasty, bready notes. Impressive richness, this is one of England's most complete traditional method wines.*

*Hundred Hills, Hillside #3 2019, Hampshire, England* £69

Late harvested 'third pass' pick of Pinot Noirs & Chardonnays from right across south-facing vineyard parcels. Soft, creamy texture with lemon curd, mandarin, cherry & delicate pineapple.

Gusbourne, Blanc de Blancs, Kent, England

Green apple, citrus & mineral, buttered toast & Tarte Tatin. Crisp, elegant, and precise, lemon sherbet, pink grapefruit and white stone fruit dominate.

Nutty & creamy, full of orchard fruit and soft baking spices and a lovely salinity.

*Startling champagne, complex, distinct & richly fragrant with savoury, umami notes of green tea and wild herbs, it also has an incredible depth of energetic and expressive fruit. Super rare.*

### **Vallée de la Marne**

*Marie Copinet, Nos Pas Dans La Craie Chardonnay, Champagne, France* £85 *Clean & balanced, with a subtle creaminess, which combines a mineral linearity with a soft, textured persistence on the palate. Think lemon tart with the perfect balance of zing and buttery softness.*

### **Côtes de Blancs**

*Aurélien Suenen, Oiry Grand Cru, Champagne, France* £99  
*Fine Blanc de Blancs, a delicious expression of stone fruits & stewed Sicilian lemons, notable length & structure.*

### **Aube**

*Pierre Gerbais, Grains de Celles Rosé, Champagne, France* £79  
*Red fruit tingle the palate with light tannins and a savoury undertone. Bold notes of cranberry, blood orange and lime flirt with the long, refreshing finish, flush with delicious sapidity.*

*Vouette et Sorbée, Textures 2019, Champagne, France* £169  
*100% Pinot Blanc, juicy, perfectly balanced, and beautifully vinous cuvée with a very fine mousse and subtle intensity. Firm and stimulatingly salty on the complex finish, with ripe apple and lemon/lime flavours in the aftertaste.*

*Doña Branca/Verdello/Treixadura Fresh and easy-going, it has low alcohol & good acidity. Well-made tasty juice.*

*Aromas of citrus fruits such as lemon, lime, sudachi & apple, nuance of toasted bread derived from Sur Lie method appears with fresh acidity.*

*Casa de Mouraz, Vinho Verde Branco 2021, Dão, Portugal* £46  
*Dry, tense yet beautifully textural, with notes of lime & stone fruits & a long mineral finish.*

*Folias de Bacos, Uivo Alvarinho Branco 2022, Duoro, Portugal* £47  
*Green fruit, green apple, lime zest & sea breeze freshness.*

*Fragrant, bursting with stone fruit & delicate florals, plus mineral salinity on the finish.*

*Alessandro Viola, Note di Bianco Grillo 2022, Sicily, Italy* £52  
*Heaps of Mediterranean herb and saline pleasure overlaying some lovely citrus and stone fruit here. Very tasty! Everything here is geared toward preserving freshness. Picked a bit early, fermented in stainless.*

*Valfaccenda, Roero Arneis 2023, Piemonte, Italy* £10 £20 £54  
*It is a wine of real balance, fruit and flowers tempered by pleasant acidity and that textbook salty finish.*

*A Thousand Gods, Sauvignon Blanc 2021, Marlborough, New Zealand* £55  
*Classically refined with big mineral energy, cracking acidity & crystalline fruit-purity this wine brings ripe Marlborough Sauvignon opulence restrained by a Jura-esque tension, length and salinity.*

*L'Equinox, To Maike and the Rest Chenin Blanc 2022, Swartland, South Africa* £10 £20 £56  
*Orchard fruits, savoury herbs, top chenin from an exciting new producer.*

*Strekov 1075/ Sröner & Sütö, Richard Chardonnay 2021, Strekov, Slovakia* £10.50 £21 £58  
*Stunning elegance, well refined fruit & masterfully integrated oak. An outstanding example of the variety that well overdelivers its weight & will put a smile on many Burgundy fan's faces.*

*Weingut Roterfaden, Riesling 2022, Württemberg, Germany* £10.50 £21 £58  
*A bright wine with straightforward acidity, a herbal touch & a hint of lemon.*

*Domaine Jean-Marc Brocard, Chablis St Claire, 2023, Burgundy, France* £10.50 £21 £58  
*Great example from the region, strong, precise, fresh with lemon and yellow fruits.*

*Michael Gindl, Buteo Grüner Veltliner 2020, Weinviertel, Austria* £62  
*A cracking version of Grüner Veltliner. Freshness, yellow apple & lime notes. You can detect a hint of caramel & some oxidative vibes. It is also smoky, nice present acidity & a long beautiful finish.*

*Szóló, Fold Furmint/ Hárslevelü 2020, Tokaj, Hungary* £11 £22 £62  
*White-fleshed peach & pears with heaps of smoky minerality & earthiness. A persistent finish offers notes of roasted nut & creamy texture. Vibrant acidity reminiscences of a winter walk in a forest valley*

*Viñas del Cámbrico, Granito Rufete Blanca 2017, Castilla y León, Spain* £62  
*Minerally, bouquet of white flowers, aniseed & fennel, tastes stone fruits & minerals with beautifully integrated oak.*

*Vincent Gaudry, Sancerre Mélodie de Vieilles Vignes 2022, Loire, France* £72 Horse-  
*ploughed, hand-picked, complex, deeply textured with a very intense mineral backbone. A stunning example of this classic wine.*

*Nin Ortiz Planetes Priorat 2020, Catalonia, Spain* £74  
 Complex, deeply coloured with heady aromas of apple, citrus, yellow plums & peach. Full, balanced, with the fruit supplemented by notes of minerals, hay, spice, and subtle oak. Acidity vibrant, wonderful mouth feel, leading to a crisp, saline tinged finish. Almost forgotten variety that produces a remarkable wine.

*Domaine Drouhin, Roserock Chardonnay 2020, Oregon, USA* £75  
 Apple, honeydew, white flowers, shortcake, & a touch of nuttiness. Round, with flavours of citrus tart, white peach, almonds, & spice with a delicious combination of minerality and richness. The finish is long.

*Les Granges Paquenesses, Les Trouillots Savagnin, 2020, Jura, France* £14.25 £28.50 £82  
 Stewed lemons, menthol, spice, salinity & attractive bitters, stunningly complex & characterful.

*Frederic Cossard, Saint-Romain Combe Bazin 2021, Burgundy, France* £99  
 This is the Domaine's most iconic wine, and it is easy to see why. From a cooler vintage, this is Chardonnay of real tension and verve, full of citrus and chalky minerals.

*Entre Vinyes, Oniric Rosat 2023, Penedes, Catalonia, Spain* £6.50 £13 £36  
 A pale & zesty rose, with lots of red summer fruits & a touch of fresh herbs. Expect strawberry, raspberry, & redcurrant on the palate.

*Tomaresca, Calafuria Negromaro 2023, Puglia, Italy* £9 £18 £49  
 Pink grapefruit, peaches & violets. The flavour is fresh and balanced with savoury notes & excellent aromatic persistence.

*Christina, Rosé Zweigelt 2022, Carnuntum, Austria* £42  
 A dark & layered rose from an organic winery helmed by a female vigneron, Christina Netzl, with solid structure & ripe fruit. Fragrant aromatics & big cherry notes, but still restrained and elegant.

*Minuty, M De Minuty, Cotes De Provence, 2023, France* £8.50 £17 £45  
 What the locals really drink in Provence, delicate, refreshing rosé wine with pure fruit flavours including grapefruit & white peach.

*Black chalk, 'Dancer in Pink' Pinot Noir blend 2023, Hampshire, England* £52  
 Dry rosé, with bright aromas of ripe strawberry & cherry blossom. A beautiful abundance of red fruits and a rounded creaminess from full malolactic fermentation. Laid back yet intensely moreish.

*Chateau Val D'Arenc, Bandol Rosé, 2020 Provence, France* £52  
 A rounded, spicy rosé, this is rich in warm red fruits. Its perfumed character is balanced by flavors of the wild herbs around the vineyard.

*Domaine Chanterêves, Marsannay Rosé 2021, Burgundy, France* £75  
 Unfiltered Rosé, sparkling acidity, strawberry, sour cherry & grapefruit.

**Chilled Red Wines** **125ml** **250ml** **Bottle**  
*Jutta Ambrositsch, Rakete Field Blend 2022, Vienna, Austria* £10 £20 £57  
 A crunchy light ruby wine, full of bright cranberry and cherry. There's unripe green gooseberry tartness, & a little earthiness that cuts through the fruit. Elegant, clean, balanced, & refreshing.

*Cantina Giardino, Tu vino Rosato Aglianico blend 2019, Campania, Italy* £49  
 There is a beautiful brightness to the fruit here, with red cherry, smoke & minerals offering refreshment in spades. Really tasty example of a chilled red.

Andi Mann, Rötlich 2021 Portugieser/ Dornfelder blend 2022, Rheinhessen, Germany £49  
Plenty of a fruity & herbaceous flavor, similar to fruit punch, & there's a light and barely noticeable tannin structure & low acidity. The aromas are intense & filled with notes of red berries, roses, & minerals.

Mine de Vin, Le Mansois Fer Servadou 2021, Aveyron, France £9 £18 £48  
Heady notes of black cherry and wildflowers, before a cascade of bitter herbs. Fermented on the skins for three weeks, before being pressed off to concrete vats for six months.

Oliver Cohen, Déferlante Merlot, Carignan & Ugni Blanc 2020, Languedoc, France £52  
Co-fermented whole cluster for 5 days and aged in fiberglass tanks, then bottled unfiltered with no sulphur added. Juicy wild berries & lush dark plums with a silky lip-smacking finish.

Fresh tangerine & pineapple with underripe plum, cherry stones, dusty acidity with herbaceous earthiness. Crazy but approachable!

Chateau Mercian, Fuefuki Koshu Gris de Gris 2021, Yamanashi, Japan £9 £18.00 £48  
White peaches, citrus, & hints of floral notes. This is light-bodied in nature with crisp acidity, & well-balanced flavour. An easy-going orange wine.

Strekov 1075, Porta #7 (Aurelius, Devin, Welschrizling), Strekov, Slovakia £12.50 £25 £72  
Aromatic floral notes paired with dried apricot & a sherry-like edge in a perfect balance.

Aci Urbajs, Organic Anarchy Sivi Pinot Gris 2017, Stajerska, Slovenia £75  
Layers of honey, peach, camomile & pine nuts wonderfully balanced & vibrant, complex & refined.

Milan Nesterac, Umani Traminer 2019, Moravia, Czech Republic £79  
An extremely aromatic dry white, this is savoury, elegant, & with a touch of structure. full-bodied, intense & a rich profile, imbued with notes of honey, citrus peel, and spices. Perfect with Asian food.

Domaine Kalathas, 10+12 Vieilles Vignes Aspro Potamisi, Cyclades, Greece £95  
Almonds & tropical fruit, the flavours are exotic. Dry as a bone, nicely fresh, but ripe at the same time. Hints of bitterness are deliberately left to enhance the experience. Unique!
