

No time for a wine vacation? Maybe you want to broaden your wine horizons or just stop getting confused every time you stare at the store shelf trying to pick the perfect bottle of wine. We have gathered a few, well-priced gems to give you some insight of what other countries are doing.

M. Chapoutier, Belleruche Côtes-du-Rhône, Rhône Valley, France 450 Grenache, Svrah

Deep red garnet color, this Cotes du Rhone Belleruche shows intense aromas of blackcurrant and raspberry complemented by notes of white pepper. In the mouth, this wine is juicy, powerful and fruity with red fruits and lovely roasted notes. The mouthfeel is accompanied by silky and delicate tannins.

Kia Ora, Marlborough, New Zealand

Sauvignon Blanc

The region's specialty, Sauvignon Blanc, is beloved for its pungent, aromatic character with notes of exotic tropical fruit, freshly cut grass, and green bell pepper along with a refreshing streak of stony minerality. A fuller style with lots of gooseberries, guava, passion fruit and minerals. Yeasty notes and good depth and length.

Widely speaking, there are two styles of Sauvignon blanc - the greener, grassier style with aromas of asparagus and green pepper, and a tropical-fruit style with hints of guava and granadilla.

CHARDONNAY

Chardonnay is the most popular white wine on earth and, more recently, it has also become the most divisive. Travel to any wine region in the world, and you'll find at least one vineyard growing Chardonnay. It's a wine that can be simple or regal, aged for many years or consumed immediately. The Chardonnays from South Africa range from steely wines with a clean, citrusy focus to heavily oaked ones with a rich, buttery consistency.

A characteristic pale green and gold glow of a classic Chardonnay, a pleasingly approachable, medium-bodied wine with expressive tropical fruit aromas intermingle with rich buttery notes and undertones of vanilla.

WOODED

Stellenzicht, Thunderstone, Stellenbosch

Vibrant aromas of fresh citrus, apricots and finishes with some lovely white floral notes. The extended lees contact creates layers of texture and nuance in the wine, while the older oak component contributes to the hints of biscuits on the finish of the pallet.

Haute Cabrière, Reserve, Franschhoek

The orange blossoms and lime on the palate compliment the well-integrated oak structure, showing light toasty and yellow fruit flavours.

Oak Valley, Groenlandberg, Elgin

Made from parcels of fruit found high on the Groenlandberg mountain, this Chardonnay reflects our cool climate with understated elegance. Flint, oatmeal, lemon peel and honeysuckle.

Remhoogte, Honeybunch Reserve, Stellenbosch

This wine has incredible complexity showing rich, honeyed fruit with a bright acidity leading into a delicious savoury finish.

OTHER WHITE VARIETALS

There are too many different varietals to even list. Here is our collection of the best of unique varietals made by passion across the wine producing areas of South Africa. Each wine is truly different from what you know.

Idiom, Stellenbosch

Pinot Grigio

Light straw in colour with citrus zest, acacia flowers and hints of flinty minerality on the nose. Elegant mouthfeel with flavours of white pear and green apple.

Lanzerac, Bergpad, Stellenbosch

Pinot Blanc

The dominant flavour of Pinot Blanc on the nose is preserved quince, violets, lavender and pears which follows through to the palate where creaminess and softness enters at the mid-palate and lingers on the extended finish. Jonkershoek Valley of Stellenbosch.

Delheim, Stellenbosch

Gewürztraminer - Off-Dry

This delightful off-dry wine is typical of the varietal: vibrant aromas of litchi, Turkish delight and white pear follow onto the palate and finish with a zesty acidity.

Jordan, Stellenbosch

Assyrtiko

Pure and aromatic, minerally rather than floral. Citrus peel with green, crunchy stone fruit and steely acidity which drives the wine.

WHITE BLENDS

South African wineries are the most innovative when it comes to white blends. It is also where our vineyards are earning the highest international acclaim. These wines have a high average rating of perceived quality, they have the ability to age and often show the terroir. Winemakers can create distinctive blends using the diversity of the viticulture of the Western Cape. Expect Bordeaux-style blends of Sauvignon blanc and Sémillon or Mediterranean-style blends with Viognier, white Grenache, Rousanne, Marsanne and very old Chenin vines.

Haute Cabrière, Franschhoek

Chardonnay, Pinot Noir

Vibrant citrus fruits, underlined by a firm acidity, with an abundance of white peach, litchi and red berry fruits fill the palate.

Spier, Creative Block 2, Stellenbosch

Sauvignon Blanc, Sémillon

Beautifully clear with a distinctive green tinge. Hints of gooseberries, crushed nettle and grapefruit with lively acidity. The finish suggests asparagus and slight savoury characters mixing in distinct minerality.

Springfield, Miss Lucy, Robertson

Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon,Pinot Gris

This unique blend of Pinot Gris, Sauvignon Blanc, Semilon and Sauvignon Gris bursts with citrus pamplemouse flavours and and ample mouth feel, yet remarkably moderate in alcohol.

ROSÉ

This wine with its pink hue is not only appealing on the eye, but is normally quite light and very refreshing. The pink colour comes from the limited amount of skin contact in the wine making process, dry Rosé pairs with Carpaccio, whereas the off-dry, sweeter wines pair well with lightly-spiced dishes.

South African Cabernet Sauvignon shows classical characteristics of blackcurrant, lead pencil and firm tannins, flavours that blend well to make for a full bodied wine. For a wonderful combination, pair a Cabernet Sauvignon with red meat.

Alvi's Drift, Signature, Western Cape

Beautiful deep ruby colour. Intense aromas of blackberry with hints of spice. A well-balanced palate with fruit following through to the finish.

Nederburg, The Winemasters, Western Cape

Red and dark fruit aromas with subtle hints of spice and well integrated oak and flavours of cocoa and black cherry.

Warwick, The First Lady, Western Cape

A smooth and textured palate with tropical fruits, fresh herbs and green melon, creating an expressive character with a fresh finish.

Vondeling, Barrel Selection, Voor Paardeberg

Cinnamon, red cherries, cigar box and sultry vanilla. Succulent and silky palate, plenty of red fruit, with toasted almond richness. Fine, textured tannins on finish.

Boschendal, Stellenbosch

Aromas of ripe black cherry and cassis, pencil shavings, cigar box accents and spice make an enticing entry and linger onto the palate, where chalky tannins and a rich, textured mouthfeel also become noticeable. A well-structured and powerful wine that offers a new discovery at every sip.

Le Riche, Stellenbosch

A Supple, elegant and rich with layers of fruit and a true expression of the quintessential Stellenbosch Cabernet Sauvignon with a firm structure and juicy, lingering finish.

MERLOT

A soft fruit with gentle tannins creates a very popular varietal. Once barrel fermented or aged, a Merlot can become a more serious wine with vanilla and spice flavours. Merlot pairs well with the Springbok Carpaccio or Rack of Lamb.

L'Avenir, Provenance, Stellenbosch

Flavours of crushed pomegranate, juicy plums are complimented by a sweet spiciness and smooth lingering finish.

Fat Bastard, Robertson

A medium-bodied Merlot delivers a delightfully well-rounded, palate-pleasing profile. Upfront, ripe fruit aromas swiftly greet the nose which sets a vibrant tone for the unfolding flavours of the palate.

Muratie, Alberta Annemarie, Stellenbosch

This luscious and opulent wine, with balanced sweetness and full-bodied richness on the palate is soft and approachable with dark cherries, coco, cinnamon and a hint of hazelnut.

Remhoogte, Aspect, Stellenbosch

This wine is classic in style showing juicy dark fruit on the entry with a broad chalky tannin and fresh acidity bringing balance and length.

Overgaauw, Reserve, Stellenbosch

It is a well-structured, medium-bodied wine with a rich combination of sumptuous black cherry fruit, hints of cocoa powder and elegant spicy oak notes. The fine but firm tannins are complemented by a mouth-filling fruity and lingering complexity.

SHIRAZ / SYRAH

Shiraz or Syrah with its inherent spiciness and combinations of smokiness and red summer berries make for a well-rounded, very enjoyable red wine. Hints of leather and fynbos linger in the glass. Enjoy this wine with oxtail or Caraffa's famous fillet gorgonzola.

Jordan, Chameleon, Stellenbosch

This syrah displays generous aromatics and flavours of ripe, spiced plum and mulberry.

Neil Ellis, Groenekloof

A full bodied Syrah, with a vibrant colour, which shows balance, elegance and great structure. The nose has bright dark fruit with contributing spicy perfumed aromas from the Cinsaut.

Boschendal, 1685, Coastal Region

Deep black fruit with riper vintage fruit expression with pepper spice. Richness and juiciness with round integrated fruit core and silky ripe tannins. Shows elegant freshness and length with a lingering fruit on the finish.

Groote Post, Darling

True to the Darling wine region, the wine is filled with pepper and spice flavours.

Old Road Co., 12 Mile, Swartland

This restrained, delicate treatment resulted in a great example of the new elegant style of South African Syrah. It is spicy, rich with textured layers and ripe, fresh berry fruit. There is an inviting blackcurrant on the nose with aromatic notes of white pepper and coriander. On the palate, soft, velvety tannins combine with lingering mulberry fruit and great structure for a memorable taste encounter.

PINOT NOIR

This grape varietal is known as one of the most volatile grapes, A Pinot Noir is a light 'gentle' red wine that is complex and intense. Always a good pairing with porcini and carbonara pasta.

Paul Clüver, Villages, Elgin

Delicious, elegant and silky with poached ripe plums, cherry and redcurrants, mingling with roasted spices and cured meat flavours.

Iona, Mr P, Elgin

Shannon, Rockview Ridge, Elgin

Black cherry and farmyard aromas classical of true Pinot Noir from the Elgin Valley. It has a dense mouthful of fruit with assertive tannins and tight acidity, powerful yet balanced with fine wood fruit combinations - A fine wine.

PINOTAGE

Dr Perold of Stellenbosch created a hybrid seed of Pinot Noir and Cinsault, to create the uniquely South African Pinotage. Pinotage pairs perfectly with Caraffa's pepper fillet, as well as thelamb rump or Osso Buco when available.

Durbanville Hills, Cape Town

A medium bodied wine with succulent strawberry flavours with hints of dark cherries and oriental spice.

Lanzerac, Stellenbosch

The longest bottled Pinotage, full bodied, complex that boasts an excellent deep colour, ripe berries and plums on the nose and pallet with a good mouth-feel and lingering aftertaste.

De Grendel, Amandelboord, Western Cape

Luxurious and full palate of blackberry, cherry, sweet clove and vanilla oak with a sprinkling of almond and trimmed cigar.

Cape blends have also become a firm favourite amongst local wine connoisseurs. The other blends are often more adventurous and inspired by the Spanish, Australian and Italian blends. They showcase the wines produced by the more daring and bold winemakers and deliver some real gems."

Alvi's Drift, 221, Special Cuvée, Western Cape

Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvianon, Pinotage, Petit Verdot, Grenache, Viognier, Durif

This aromatic, medium-bodied wine is a beautifully crafted, Shiraz-led blend of eight superb varietals. Fruit driven and well balanced with silky-smooth tannins, it is an intensely aromatic wine with hints of tobacco.

Hartenberg, The Doorkeeper, Stellenbosch

Merlot, Malbec

Captivating aromas of rose petals, dark chocolate and Turkish delight, intertwined with ripe cherries and plums. On the palate, it reveals vibrant flavours of blackberries and cherries, accentuated by a subtle smokiness, all wrapped in uber-fine tannins.

Fryer's Cove, Cape West Coast

Grenache, Cinsault

This medium-bodied wine is bright and exuberant in colour with light violet hues. It is packed with aromas of wild raspberry and a hint of clove spice. It boasts smooth tannins with a balanced acidity, giving it a seductive round finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot

On the nose striking cassis underlined with cedar and a fresh ripe fruit character. On the palate the freshness carries through with a long-lasting aftertaste.

Notes of fresh plum, blackforest cake and cedar spice. The wine shows a delicate mid-palate with a soft, rounded tannin that complements a well-balanced acidity.

Syrah, Petit Verdot, Mouvèdre, Nebbiolo, Cabernet Sauvignon, Viognier Cool Climate peppery spice, grippy tannins, with layers of bramble and black cherry fruit.
