




### WINE OF ORIGIN

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Grapes for wine making are grown in approximately 100 official appellations covering over 94 545 ha, stretching from the Northern Cape to the Klein Karoo in the east. Since the introduction of The Wine of Origin system in 1973, wine making areas have been divided into regions, districts and wards. The smallest category of the Wine of Origin (WO) is Estate, which means single farms of which there are about 203 (SAWIS June 2016). Some producers choose not to register as an estate. There are 3029 primary grape producers and 546 wine cellars crushing grapes. Single vineyard designation is the next level to be recognized. This is still to be approved by authorities, although you will see many wine labels alluding to single vineyard source. Our wine list indicates the origin of the grapes used to produce this specific wine. Where a region rather than the district is mentioned, this may indicate that grapes are sourced from various districts within that region. Likewise, were grapes are sourced from different regions in the Western Cape, then the origin will be given as Western Cape. The map below shows some of the important regions, districts and wards of the Western Cape. (Data-SAWIS 2017)

The wine shows an attractive lemony yellow-green colour with a complex nose of citrus, white peach, pineapple, spice, citrus blossoms, apricot and buttered toast aromas.

It is vibrant and spicy, with alluring creamy notes. An assertive mineral acidity beautifully balances a compelling intensity of fruit.

The medium-bodied wine has pear, apricot, peach and floral notes developing into lemon cream with touches of toasted almonds on the stone fruit focused palate.

Light yellow with a tinge of green and vanilla and lime with pistachio. A hint of oak and fresh acidity with a long lingering finish.

A powerful expression of Chardonnay, brimming with fruit flavour and elegance. A buttery toastiness from the oak rounds off the complex hazelnut and citrus flavours.

222 Thelema 2020 Stellenbosch \*\*\*\*

Fermented and matured in French oak barrels, this Medium-bodied Chardonnay presents aromas of citrus and hints of peach on the nose with nuttiness on the mid-palate.

Full bodied, with lots of citrus and vanilla flavours. Wooded and fermented in American oak barrels.

Made from delicious fruit grown in the beautiful Tradouw Valley. Elegant and feminine with fynbos floral. Hints of toasted almonds, honey and vanilla.

The flavours are vivacious with supple layers of crème caramel, pineapple and white peach extending towards a textured aftertaste.

This wine holds no secrets. Full and complex with concentrated fruit of Granny Smith apple and yellow citrus that ends with a lively well-balanced acidity.

The most versatile of all grape varietals, making up 18% of all grapes grown in South Africa. No matter the style, a certain floral and honeyed character are the sensory trademarks of a well-made Chenin.

Refreshingly crisp, mineral palate brimming with green apple, juicy pear, granadilla and fresh herbs, ending with a zesty lemon sherbet finish.

131 Groote Post 2023 Darling

This wine shows abundance of white pear and guava flavours on the nose. It offers an explosion of fruit salad flavours on the palate finishing with a long crisp granny smith apple acidity.

Tropical and stone fruit flavours supported by a burst of citrus on the palate.

The palate has fresh crunchy flavours of green apple, grapefruit and pear with balanced acidity and an appetisingly tangy, fresh finish.

232 Opstal Carl Everson 2022 Slanghoek R935

38 year old vines and old French barrels created an exceptional well-rounded wine with typically white and yellow peach aromas. This vintage has a lot of finesse and elegance, with long finish.

133 Tierhoek 2022 Piekenierskloof \*\*\* R230 R690

The sweetness is balanced by a fresh natural fruit acidity leaving a clean finish on the palate.

218 AA Badenhorst Secateurs 2023 Swartland \*\*\*\* R350

Flavours of ripe apples and honey and a creamy texture give the wine richness and weight whilst retaining the thrillingly zippy tang of Chenin's acid backbone.

208 Mulderbosch Steen op Hout 2023 Western Cape ★★★★ R115 R345

Ripe and accessible with a firm, pithy texture central to the wine's character, with unmistakable citrus top notes, ripe apricot, pear and pineapple flavours, with subtle oak spice.

209 Fleur du Cap 2023 Western Cape ★★★ R110 R330

The wine is brilliantly clear with specs of green. The nose is fresh with aromas of tropical fruit opening up into lime notes with a touch of oak spice.

### **VIOGNIER**

Usually wooded, this varietal has a distinctive fruit character as well as a typical deep golden hue.

Ripe and full-bodied with a dry finish.

Pale in colour, clear and bright with a pronounced greenish hue. The nose has restrained aromatics of citrus, jasmine and sea breeze, but remains elegant and perfumed.

A bold white wine from Paarl. Citrus, pineapple and peach notes lead to a creamy palate with hints of oak and grapefruit.

228 Fairview 2022 Paarl \*\*\*\* R500

The wine is a bright gold colour with papaya, tropical fruit and pear blossom aromas balanced by subtle spicy oak notes.

### OTHER WHITE VARIETALS

227 Constantia Uitsig Semillon 2022 Cape Town \*\*\*\*

A finely focused, complex, and well-balanced wine that shows white peaches, ripe summer fruit and hints of almond on the nose.

315 Hartenberg Riesling 2022 Stellenbosch

Jasmine-scented. Juicy apricot flavours fill the mouth with a delicious tang.

229 Terra Del Capo Pinot Grigio 2023 Western Cape

Lime, peach and nectarine provides a brightness on entry, that continues on the palate with succulent nectarine, white peach and quince flavours. The light, vivacious palate is completed by refreshing balancing acidity.

Vibrant citrus fruits, underlined by a firm acidity, with an abundance of white peach, litchi and red berry fruits fill the palate.

Floral and aromatic, the wine extends to form an impression of pineapple flesh, syrupy green figs and quince.

### SEMI-SWEET / OFF-DRY

134 Cederberg Bukettraube 2023 Cederberg ★★★★ R127 R380

White flowers, honeysuckle, pineapple and stone fruit fill the delicate sweet palate, with additional subtle flavours of white peach and pear dancing in the background.

308 **Simonsig Jamala Gewürztraminer 2023**Intense flavours of litchi, rose petal and citrus are layered and mouthfilling on the gently sweet palate, beautifully balanced by fresh acidity and a lingering honeyed spice finish.

# ROSÉ

Expect beautiful, light and fruity flavours of strawberries, raspberries and cherries with a floral aroma that, on occasion, might have a small hint of spice.

An intensity of vibrant sweet candyfloss, raspberry and subtle spice and fynbos on the palate, with black and red berries intertwined with cinnamon and an alluring mineral note that binds it all together.

319 Builtenverwachting 2023 Cape Town ★★★ R28

This 'Bordeaux Blend' offers a combination of fresh strawberry, and other red berry, giving it a refreshing crisp fruity finish, and a great summer wine to be served nicely chilled.

230 **De Grendel 2023 Cape Town** ★★★★ R89 R265

The palate is dry, with medium acidity, packed with pomegranate, crushed raspberries and ruby grapefruit zest, to deliver a slightly fuller mouthfeel.

### **OFF-DRY**

231 Landskroon Blanc de Noir 2023 Western Cape \*\*\* R89 R265

A fresh and fruity off-dry white wine made from Pinotage grapes. Pale coral colour with lovely floral and fruity flavours.


### **SEMI-SWEET**
