# ALPINE

There are very few regions that are as synonymous with the natural wine movement as Jura and Savoie. Often compared to nearby Burgundy, both areas are known for their eclectic wines as well as wine makers, due to the varying terroir and strong local identity. Pioneering methods, small plots, extreme altitudes and unusual grape varieties make these some of the most exciting wines available today.

# LES VIGNES DE PARADIS, DOMINIQUE LUCAS - SAVOIE, FRANCE

Overlooking Lake Geneva, Lucas' 10ha of organic and biodynamic vines are separated by soil type into 27 different plots. Each of these is vinified separately, utilising a variety of barrels, amphore, concrete eggs and even pyramids. Though his thoughtful methods and expressive wines might be a far cry from the traditions and rules of his native Burgundy, they easily rival them in terms of precision, finesse and quality.

## **Vin des Allobroges 'Un P'tit Coin de Paradis' 2018 - Chasselas** 60

Aged in a combination of concrete eggs and demi-muid barrels. Mineral and bourgogne-esque with oxidative notes.

## **Vin des Allobroges Chardonnay 2019** 65

Mineral and precise, you'd never guess these vines were only 6 years old.

## **'Amphore' 2019 - Chasselas** 69

Aged for 12 months in 200lt and 300lt clay Amphore. A super example showing off all the attributes of this rare grape.

## **Vin des Allobroges 'Kheops' 2019 - Chardonnay** 75

Aged in a 1:100 scale replica of the Kheops pyramid made from clay and sand taken from the vineyard. Incredible.

# ARIANNA OCCHIPINTI - VITTORIA, SICILY

The wines of Arianna Occhipinti are the benchmark of the type of winemaking we love. Terroir driven, she uses only local varieties and native airborne yeasts for her fermentations, bottled without filtering and with little to no sulfur. The results are pure and expressive, elegant yet assertive, and all memorable in their own way.

**Vino di Contarada 'Santa Margherita' 2019 - Grillo** 99

This is the first year Occhipinti has released a white wine. Four parcels of varying soil and vine training result in a wine with citrus, floral and grassy notes, balanced by good acidity and a mineral backbone.

**Vino di Contarada 'Fossa di Lupo' 2019 - Frappatto** 96

The lightest of 3 Frappattos from the same vineyard. Strawberry, redcurrant and rose with cedar and some spice. Sandy soil.

**Vino di Contarada 'Pettineo' 2019 - Frappatto** 96

Fuller bodied than the FL with more fruit and spice notes. Mix of sand and limestone soil.

**Vino di Contarada 'Bombolieri' 2019 - Frappatto** 96

Heaviest of the 3 Frappattos, dark fruits and earthy notes with the unmistakable minerality from this site. Limestone soil.

**Cerasuolo di Vittoria 'Grotte Alte' 2016 - Frappatto, Nero d'Avola** 99

Occhipinti's top wine. 3-4 years in barrel give serious depth and complexity.
