We often see stickers on wine bottles which look decorative but never give much in terms of meaning, we will therefore give a brief explanation to some of them - browse through.

PLATTER'S WINE GUIDE

The Platter Guide was conceived in 1978 by John and Erica Platter (once known as The John Platter). This is a comprehensive, up to date and authoritative guide to who is who and what is what in the cape wine lands. It features countless producers, negotiates and brands. This is a reference guide which also serves to 'advise' on the quality of the wine. The rating ranges from half star (Very Ordinary) to 5 stars (Superlative - a South African Classic) to this end most of the wines we list fall between 3.5 stars (Very good / Promising) to 5 stars.

THE MICHELANGELO INTERNATIONAL WINE AWARDS

The need to have South African wines adjudicated by international experts was the compelling factor in the formation of these awards, only the internationally accredited wine judges serve on the judging panels. The aim is to identify wines which will fare well in world markets. The Michelangelo uses the 100-point judging system which is very accurate as it allows each entry to be judged according to the varietal's characteristics based on sight, smell, and taste.

VERITAS AWARDS

This award gives recognition to wines of exceptional quality. The distinctive VERITAS symbol of excellence serves as an authoritative quality guideline for wine connoisseurs. The judging panel includes winemakers, researchers, academics, and merchants who are all required to have a wine judging certificate from the University of Stellenbosch, a Cape Wine Masters or similar accreditation.

INVESTEC TROPHY WINE SHOW

This is South Africa's premier wine competition that recognizes top local wines and winemakers, it honours the excellence in the winemaking industry. The medals range from bronze - 85 to 89 points (good to very good), Silver - 90 to 94 points (excellent, wine of distinction) and Gold - 95 points and above (superlative, world class). The gold medal wines in each class go through to the Trophy judging where all the panellists re-assess them from freshly opened bottles.

NATIONAL WINE CHALLENGE - TOP 100 SA WINES

This is a premium brand based around many of South Africa's finest wines and vineyards. This is very objective, independent, and professional rating of South Africa's entered fine wines. It aids vineyards to position their winning wines with clarity, vigour, and integrity. It helps the consumers to buy better wine and get best value.

ABSA TOP 10 - PINOTAGE

This has become the means of benchmarking the best wines made from South Africa's Signature Grape, Pinotage and has seen the sales of Pinotage increase by 10% while doubling the exports of Pinotage.

Glossary

Aquifer: An aquifer is a body of rock and/or sediment that holds a body of water.
 Artesian: The upward movement of water under hydrostatic pressure in rocks or unconsolidated material beneath the earth's surface.
 Cuvee: A type, blend, or batch of wine or water, blended to form champagne-like bubbles.
 TDS: Total Dissolved Solids – a measurement of the amount of solid material found in water.

This collection embodies our “**Celebrate Life**” mantra, bringing together fine dining and elegant winemaking. Each blend has been thoughtfully designed to complement the intricate flavours and rich experiences offered at Signature’s tables.

SIGNATURE RESERVE RED BLEND 2020

The Signature Reserve Red Blend 2020, crafted from carefully selected varietals suited to the warm Swartland climate, features a Syrah-based blend enhanced by Grenache for ripe cherry notes, Mourvedre for depth of colour and flavour, and Carignan for structural tannins. Matured separately in 5000-litre foudres, concrete tanks, and 500-litre French oak barrels for 11 months before blending, this wine presents itself as accessible yet profound, perfectly matching with rich dishes like curried lamb shank and chimichurri ribeye.

Wine of origin: Swartland

Nose: Fresh black berries with mulberry and black currants being prominent. Some plum and prunes also shine. Well integrated sweet spice aromas.

Palate: Soft elegant mouthfeel with well-integrated tannins. Delicious sour cherry and beautiful black berry notes on the palate. Slight gamey, leather note adding to the complexity. Bright acidity.

Grapes: 51% Syrah, 18% Grenache, 18% Mourvedre, 13% Carignan

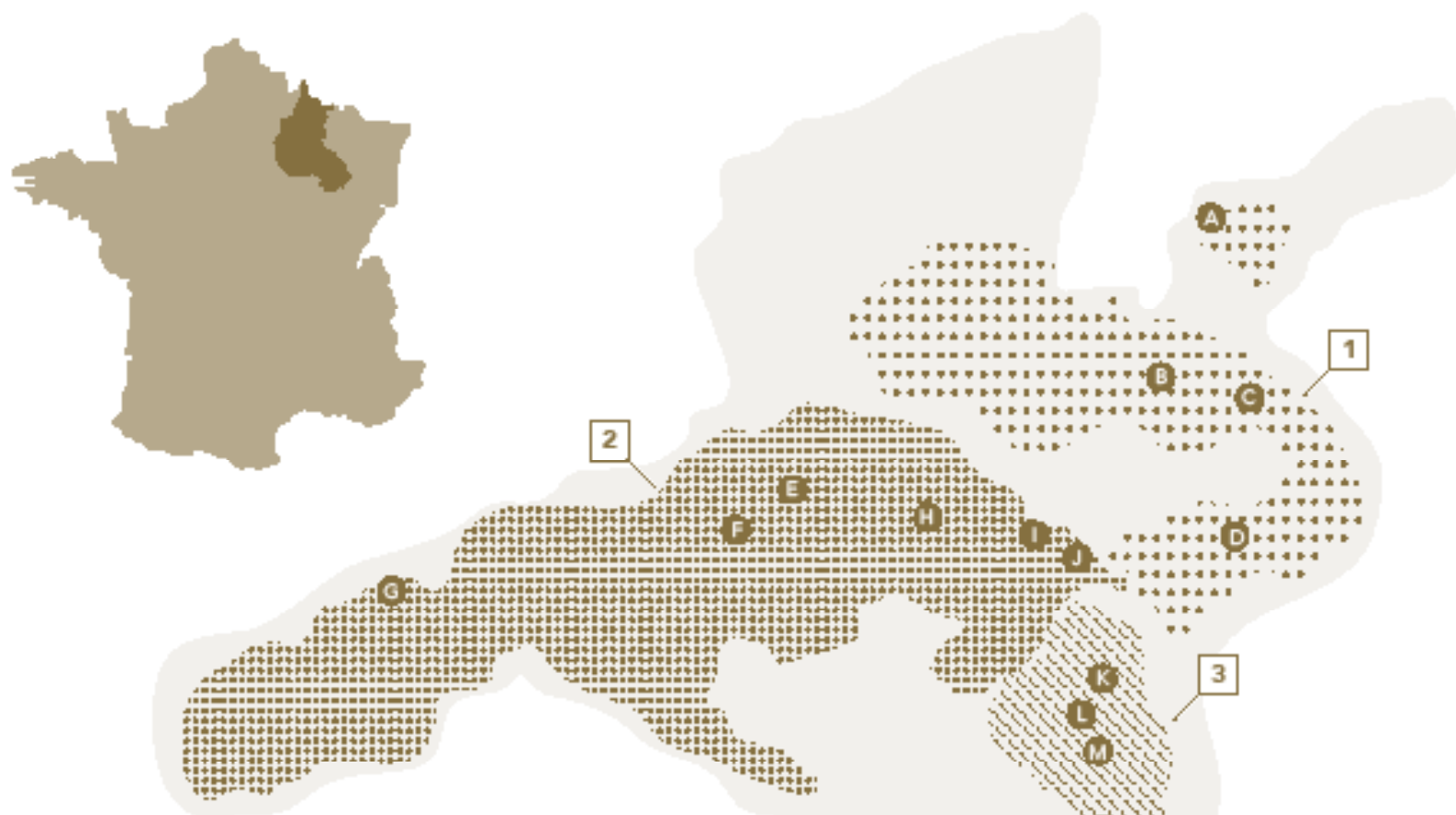
Predominantly a Chenin blend, incorporates grapes from Heritage Old Vines, renowned for their low-yield but high-quality fruit-forward juice. Marsanne introduces the necessary acidity for longevity, Viognier brings a touch of floral elegance, and Harslevelü adds a layer of charm and sweetness. This wine is versatile, ideally pairing with the spiciness of Asian cuisine, the umami of sushi, and the subtlety of delicate poultry dishes.

Wine of Origin: Voor-Paardeberg

Nose: Peach, nectarine, zest of lemon and lime with beautiful floral notes. Flinty undertones with hints of brioche.

Palate: Elegant yet bursting with flavours of peach, quince, Granny Smith apple. Flinty sweet spice and complexity. Zippy acidity.

Grapes: 61% Chenin blanc, 19% Marsanne, 10% Viognier, 10% Harslevelü

- Baron Albert Preference Demi-sec NV* Charly-sur-Marne **1750**
 Winemakers: Claire, Lise & Aline Baron
 A lovely fresh, delicate and seductive Champagne in demi-sec style, 100% female management through three sisters, crafting Pinot Meunier led blend in elegance and finesse.
- Besserat de Bellefon Blanc de blancs NV* Ay **3500**
 Winemaker: Cedric Thiebault
 This cuvee is the fruit of a unique and a very specific method of Champagne making that has been perpetuated by Besserat de Bellefon consisting of adding the "liquer de tirage". It has lovely citrus notes, accentuated by minerality and salinity. Delicate with soft whiffs of wet stones.
- Ruinart blanc de blanc NV* Reims **3950**

 Chardonnay is the very soul of Ruinart. Fresh with very ripe citrus fruits on the nose and a supple, harmonious attack on the palate, very rounded. Vinosity that is not excessive, supported by excellent freshness.

 Winemaker: Florent Nys
 A blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier and Pinot Noir vinified as red wine. A delicate bouquet of fine red fruit notes and a citrus zest. Elegant on the palate followed by a fresh raspberry finish.

 Exceptionally elegant with a superbly rich and complex nose. It opens with the nose of ripe fruits and strawberries, a touch of vanilla and violets. The palate is concentrated, well structured and rich, rounding off with silky mineral notes.

 Winemaker : Damien Cambres
 Seductive, lovely yellow gold colour with creamy bubbles. The nose is forward and elegant with notes of dried fruits , fresh cut flowers and spicy vanilla. Soft and balanced in the mouth with hints of spice, fruit and caramel.

Louis Roederer Brut Collection 244 Reims **3500**

The wine is both delectably rich, with a slightly roasted character, and super fresh thanks to a salivating finish. The smokey notes then take over to underpin a very flavoursome finish. Collection 244 marks the return of the texture of the Meunier from the Marne and Montage adding richness.

Louis Roederer Cristal Brut 2015 Reims **17500**

Winemaker: *Jean-Baptiste Lecaillon*

A savoury explosion of ripe fruit on the attack so typical of Cristal. Silky, concentrated texture, leaning on intense, powerful and vinous structure, but maintaining refinement. On the palate a delicious sensation of well-blended harmony and flavours.

Armand de Brignac Brut NV Reims **22500**

Winemaker: *Emilien Boutillat*

Dubbed the 'Golden Cuvee,' this Champagne is the sparkling's most enigmatic and rare bubbly, extraordinarily delicate and pure with a bright entry and long exquisite finish. It abounds with charming aromas of vanilla, citrus fruits and dried apricots.

PROSECCO

Centum Prosecco DOC Extra Dry NV Treviso **850**

Winemaker : *Ermes Busetto*

Lively perlage, intense and fresh flavour with hints of golden apple and citrus fruit as well as good intensity. Fresh pleasant and harmonious.

Masottina Prosecco Superiore DOCG Extra Dry NV Conegliano-Valdobbiadene **975**

Winemaker: *Adriano dal Bianco*

Floral scents of jasmine, acacia blossom and wisteria dominate on the nose with an elegant and fresh acidity on the palate demonstrate flavours of peach, green apple and balsamic sweetness- a Prosecco Superiore to rival most bubbles.

Bottega Gold Prosecco Moscato Dolce NV Lombardy **1500**

Winemaker : *Sandro Bottega*

Bottega gold is a classic Prosecco made from Glera grape in Valdobbiadene. A superb aperitif fizz with apple, pear, acacia and lilly notes. A perfect marriage with Rissoto and asian dumplings.

Winemaker: Takuan von Arnim

Cuvee Belle Nectar Rose has the faintest tinge of salmon pink, a lively presentation of Pinot Noir flavours, a pleasingly fine mousse and an elegant sweet finish.

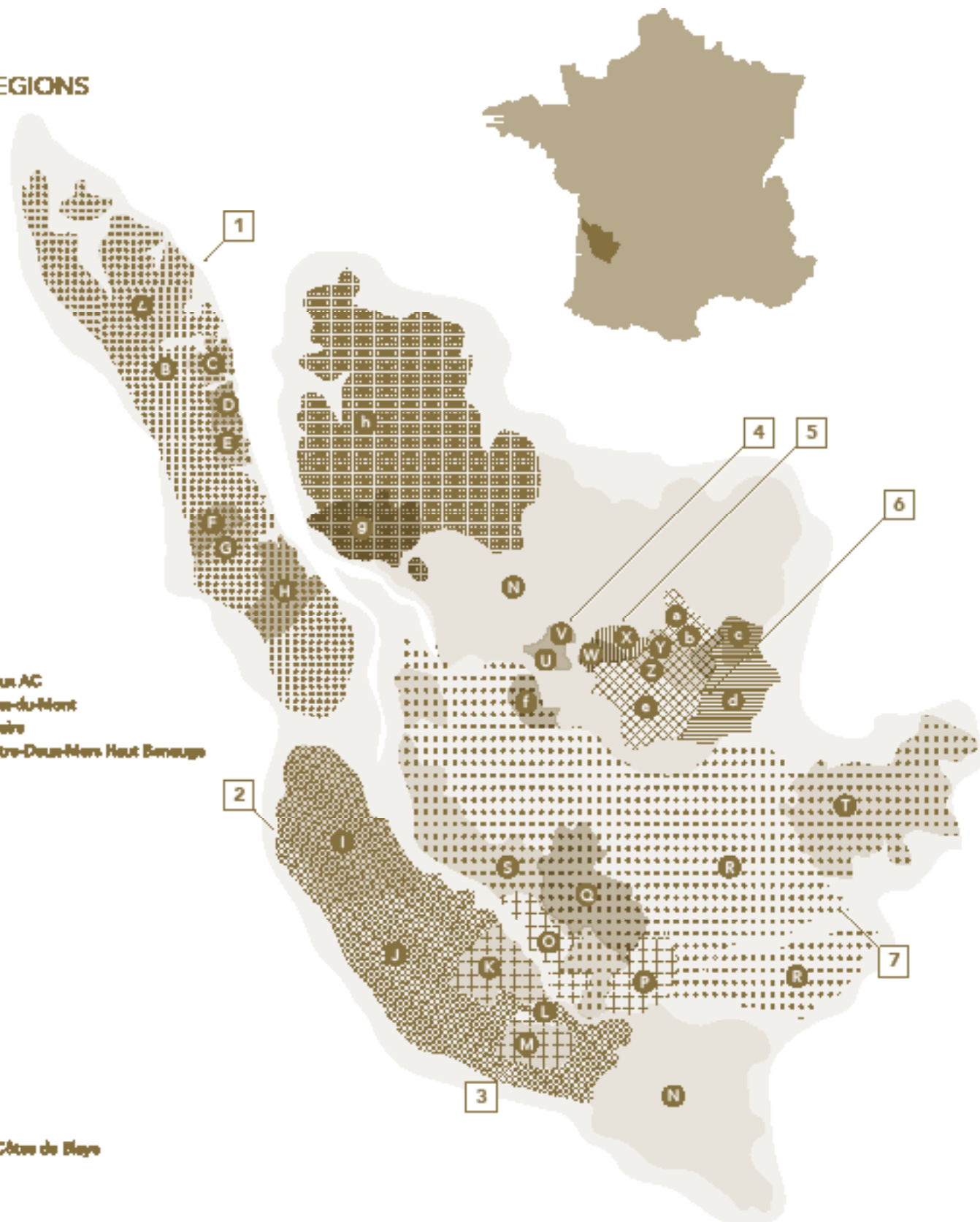

 Rich, creamy, yeasty nose with a full ripe toasty flavour on the middle of the palate developing finesse and complexity on the aftertaste.

 Having spent 23 months on the lees prior to disgorgement, this harmonious blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir offers refinement and elegance. It is a Cap Classique for those who prefer their brut minerally and dry. Try it with salmon dishes.
- Pieter Ferreira Blanc de blancs* 2017 Robertson **1200**
 Winemaker : Pieter Ferreira
 This is a bubbly of power but also focus and detail. The nose shows apple, peach, citrus, a touch of flinty reduction, some light biscuit character and spice while the palate has dense fruit matched by a great line of acidity, the mousse creamy, an umami-rich quality to the finish.
