Primal water is sourced from an artesian spring which occurs when natural pressure underground forces water to the surface.

Lofoten Arctic Water is sourced from nature’s paradise, the Lofoten Islands in the north of Norway, located north of the Arctic Circle between the 68th and 69th parallels.

Lofoten Arctic Water is a unique product of its landscape, with no need for filtering or distillation. The water is sourced in the majestic mountains, and the source is renewed by glacial snowmelt throughout the year, and replenished by rains during the summer.

Lofoten is soft water with crisp notes and pairs exceptionally well with sushi.

FINE WATER	Water from a natural source, with terroir and a story to tell. Designed for the epicurean table.
TDS	TDS stands for Total Dissolved Solids and represents the total concentration of dissolved substances in water.
WATER MENU	A variety of water sources and taste profiles, enhance dining experiences.
MINERALITY	The higher the mineral content, the more distinct a water's taste can be.
MOUTHFEEL	How food or drink feels in one's mouth.
CUVÉE	A type, blend, or batch of water or wine, champagne-like.
ARTESIAN SPRING	Occurs when groundwater, under natural pressure, finds its way to the land surface.
NATURAL WATER	Natural water means bottled spring, mineral, artesian, or well water that is derived from an underground formation and is not derived from a municipal system or public water supply. Natural waters can also be glacial, rain, naturally carbonated springs, air waters, and more.
TAP WATER	Derived from a municipal system or public water supply. Highly processed.

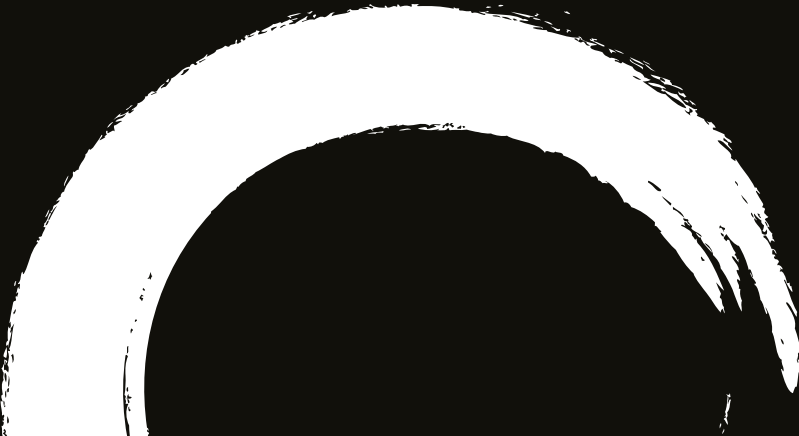

KIUCHI BREWERY

The Kiuchi Brewery was established in 1823 by Kiuchi Gihei, the headman of Kounosu village in northeast Japan. His family collected rice from farmers as land taxes and he began his brewery with the idea of using remaining rice stocks in the warehouse for sake. In autumn 1996 the sake brewery began making beer with a unique owl character logo under the name Hitachino Nest. Over the years the beer has gained worldwide acclaim by winning awards at numerous beer competitions.

Hitachino Nest was the first Japanese craft beer to be exported overseas and has a cult following in Tokyo and New York.

HITACHINO NEST RED RICE ALE / 330ml 215

Complex sake like flavours with malt sweet notes. Hints of strawberries in the nose and palate. An intriguing mix of sake, malt and bitter notes in the finish.

HITACHINO NEST SAISON DU JAPON / 330ml 195

Saison du Japon is brewed with a local wheat and koji (malted rice) which is a vital ingredient to create sake. This beer has a uniquely sweet flavor of rice koji and a natural pleasing acidity caused by the fermentation.

HITACHINO NEST YUZU LAGER / 350ml 195

A classic lager with a Japanese citrus twist. This yuzu citrus lager combines the Japanese citrus fruit, similar in flavour to a grapefruit and mandarin orange, with a traditional lager to make for a delicate yet deep flavour. Enjoy the refreshing acidity from the yuzu and the crispness of a lager.

HITACHINO NEST WHITE ALE / 330ml 215

A refreshing mildly hopped Belgian styled beer with a complex flavor of coriander, orange peel, nutmeg. White Ale has won gold medals at several beer competitions in U.K. and U.S. This is one of Hitachino's top-selling beers both in Japan and the United States.

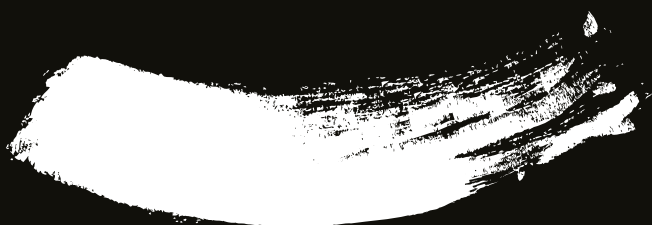

OPUS ONE

Opus One is the realized dream of two men: Baron Philippe de Rothschild of Château Mouton Rothschild in Bordeaux and Napa Valley vintner Robert Mondavi. Napa Valley, California.

Opus One 2018 / 18000

Selective harvesting (the majority at night) produced a vintage recalling the generous 2001, with aromas of cassis, nutmeg, raspberries, cola, fresh oats, dark chocolate and forest floor. Polished, supple and harmoniously precise, the 2007 fuses a seamless mid-palate with soft yet sinewy tannins. The wine will age effortlessly for decades. Cabernet Sauvignon 79%, Merlot 8%, Cabernet Franc 6%, Petit Verdot 6% and Malbec 1%.

Opus One 2014 / 15000

The 2014 Opus One exudes subtle aromas of fragrant florals, fresh garden herbs and forest floor that give way to a concentrated blend of red cherry, blackberry and black currant. Fine-grained tannins offer a velvety texture and complex structure that builds to a long, vibrantly fresh finish with a touch of mocha. Enjoyable now, the wine will delight for years to come. Cabernet Sauvignon 80%, Petit Verdot 7%, Cabernet Franc 6%, Merlot 5% and Malbec 2%.

CHÂTEAU PALMER

Château Palmer is a winery in the Margaux appellation d'origine contrôlée of the Bordeaux region of France. The wine produced here was classified as one of fourteen Troisièmes Crus (Third Growths) in the historic Bordeaux Wine Official Classification of 1855. The wines from the original estates were served at the court of Versailles under Louis XV.

Château Palmer, 1987 / 16000

Pleasure above all. A desire for delight guided a vintage created in difficult conditions. A harsh winter followed by a late blossoming, a cold July and a wet harvest, resulting in a draconian selection. The result, a supple, fruity wine. In a word: pleasurable.

Château Palmer, 2001 / 15000

A benchmark Bordeaux and signature wine. Good weather conditions allowed the Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot to mature perfectly. The grapes were extremely rich in juice and expressed the specificity of the terroir, thanks to blending that brought out all their freshness. Pure Palmer.

Château Palmer Alter Ego, 2013 / 6000 2017 / 6500

The Merlot, so important to the identity of our wines, were picked in time and showed a level of phenolic and aromatic maturity that surpassed expectations. During winemaking, the must was handled with care to avoid the extraction of any potentially rustic tannins. Merlot 46%, Cabernet Sauvignon 46% & Petit Verdot 8%.

CHÂTEAU LA TOUR

Château Latour is a French wine estate, rated as a First Growth under the 1855 Bordeaux Classification, owned by Groupe Artemis. Latour has been occupied since at least 1331 when Tor à Saint-Lambert was built by Gaucelme de Castillon, and the estate dating to at least 1378.

Les Forts de la Tour, 2014 / 15000

The colour is dark with a beautiful intensity. The nose is fruity, refined, ripe and extremely expressive. On the palate, the wine is rounded and smooth, spicy and very aromatic.

CHÂTEAU MUSAR GASTON HOCHAR, 2013 Lebanon / 22000

Chateau Msar is the name of a Lebanese winery in Ghazir, Lebanon, north of the capital Beirut. Musar grapes grow in the Beqaa Valley, a fertile sunny valley at an elevation of 1,000 metres east of Beirut.

A dense deep red with their characteristic sweet/savoury/spicy blend of Cinsault, Carignan and Cabernet Sauvignon. It reveals an elegance and roundness with a spice-dominant palate - liquorice, clove and cinnamon with a warm coulis of red fruits. "Marvellously warm Mediterranean fruits on the nose, almost the essence of Lebanon in the glass with rich spice and cooling breezes".

HOGAN DIVERGENT, 2019 Stellenbosch / R990

Meet Jocelyn Hogan Wilson, winemaker at Hogan Wines situated in Banhoek, Stellenbosch. In 2014, at the SA Swartland Revolution tasting, Jocelyn sat through a tasting with esteemed Lebanese winemaker Serge Hochar from Chateau Musar. Completely in awe of his winemaking style and vibrant personality, Jocelyn said, "Part of my journey was all about hearing him. The result Hogan Divergent was Awarded 5 stars in Platter's Guide 2022. A sensational wine inspired by Serge's classic blend of Carignan, Cinsault and Cabernet Sauvignon.
