
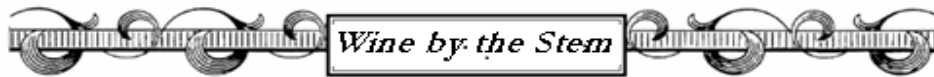

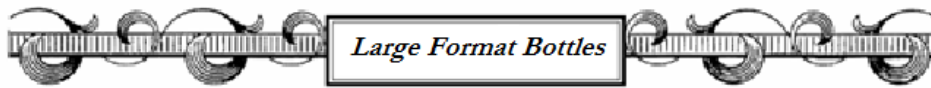

Gusbourne winemaker notes: Bright gold in color, this blend highlights red fruit aromas of cherry and strawberry, which then develop into attractive fresh pastry notes with a touch of cinnamon and spice. With a bright streak of citrus fruit, the palate is clean and fresh whilst giving tones of soft stone fruit and a long, refreshing finish.

Ruinart, Blanc de Blancs: A very appealing and satisfying style that fully captures the elegance and poise of chardonnay. The aromas here are all based around lemons, grapefruit, honey, fresh floral notes, stone fruits and toasty autolysis – which is somewhat of a signature for this Champagne. The palate delivers a ripe, flavorsome impression of peach custard and lemon crème brûlée. The acidity is nicely placed and the the finish upbeat with vibrant fruit expression.

The rosés listed are on the dry side of the sweetness chart. All fruit forward with good acidity and great for pairing many of our appetizers, especially our steak tartare.

The sauvignon blanc grape is produced in a variety of styles ranging from the dry, crisp, and racy- to the juicy, rich (with the addition of Semillon). Most of these selections see no oak in the winemaking process. Some fruits that shine through are lemon, apple, grapefruit, and kiwi.

Captûre winemaker notes:

The Tradition Sauvignon Blanc elevates the purity of the variety through stainless steel fermentation and ten months of sur lie aging. The result is an expression of bright citrus such as lime peel, white stonefruit, and green apple fragrances. Our vineyards highlight the ideal characteristics of Sauvignon Blanc with mineral texture, brilliant acidity, and a fresh finish.

From a sharp and crisp Kabinett to the luxurious richness of an eiswein, Rieslings truly run the gamut of flavors. German Style tend to be off-dry, with low alcohol.

Albariño is a high acid grape that produces lighter body wines. Often brimming with coastal flavors of minerality and sea salt, albariño is a natural match for oysters on the half shell. Those produced in the US are more rare and exhibit fuller body and greater richness.

Chablis is amazing. Few wines around the world elicit the visceral reaction that the word "Chablis" creates. There is a purity of fruit and laser-like acidity that runs through these wines. Chablis always has loads of structure and in many cases, they can age for years. Their salinity and zestiness make for a marvelous palate cleanser or can act as the perfect complement to a plate of briny oysters.

Grand Cru Burgundies are often considered to be the finest Chardonnay wines in the world. Exhibiting a dazzling combination of acidity, minerality, and complexity, these wines are cherished by the most savvy of wine collectors all around the world. Production on these prized bottlings is incredibly limited.

The light to medium-bodied palate is delicately styled but well-concentrated with earth- and floral-tinged fruits and bursts of bright freshness on the long, layered finish. A very classic Anderson Valley expression.



Wines produced from the sangiovese grape tend to be medium in body and fresh with higher acids to balance the fruit. The acidity in the wine make it lively and super food friendly especially to cut through with the rich sauces.

The original “Super Tuscan” wine was Sassicaia. In 1970, the Marchesi Incisa della Rocchetta went against tradition and added cabernet sauvignon to sangiovese. This was illegal at the time as the Italian government strictly regulated all wine production. Because this wine didn't fit into their strict laws, it was deemed a vino di tavola, or Table Wine. Decades later, these “Super Tuscan” wines are among the most prized in Italy.

Native to Greece, Xinomavro is widely regarded the finest red wine of the country. Its name literally means “acid black”, and attains fullest potential in the country's northwest region of Naoussa. These single varietal bottlings of Xinomavro (blending is not allowed here) are often compared to the fine Barolos of Italy for their structure, finesse and age-worthiness.

Brunello di Montalcino—translated as “little brown one” from Montalcino—wines are made from a localized clone of Sangiovese and aged for three plus years in oak and in bottle before release. These are hearty and bold wines—think Chianti Classico with much more depth, concentration, and complexity. Brunello is considered to be one of the most age worthy wines from Italy.

The vineyards of Côte-Rôtie are unique because of their vertical slopes and their stone walls. Côte-Rôtie can be rendered in English as "the roasted slope" and refers to the long hours of sunlight that these steep slopes receive.

Petite Sirah was discovered in the 1880s by Dr. Francois Durif, a French nurseryman, who named the grape after himself. 
