"A perfumed Trepas, violets and roses, super aromatic. Forrest floor notes and moreish blueberries on the palate."

“Smooth, ripe cherries & meaty notes all wrapped up in a warm breeze of southern Italian herbs.”

“This is project from two sommeliers from Paris who team up with a different winemaker for each cuvee. This is a pairing with Champs de Barbiere from Languedoc. Food-friendly dark fruits with silky tannins and a nice structure.”

**Les Beraudies 2011** Malbec/Merlot - Cahors, France 60

“From the home of Malbec, this structured & grippy Malbec brims with complexity & character, notes of figs, prunes and a hint of chocolate. It’s simply begging for something meaty.”

**Lyrakakis, Dafni 2019** Dafni - Crete, Greece 42.5  
“Highly aromatic ancient varietal from Crete, slightly floral with notes of bay leaf and eucalyptus.”

**Suerte del Marquez, Trenzado 2018**, Listan Blanco - Tenerife, Spain 67  
“This captivating white takes its name from the trellis system unique to the Canary Islands: “el cordon trenzado” (the braided cord), with a number of the vine’s branches plaited together. Wild, distinctive, and thirst-quenching with beautiful texture, this is bound to intrigue anyone who tries it.”

**Puro Rofe, Blanco 2018** Diago/Malvasia - Lanzarote, Canary Islands 69.5  
“A fresh with a reductive, flinty personality. Lively, with generous body and a salty finish.”

**Domaine Abbatucci, Faustine 2017** Vermentino - Corsica, France 77

**Vin de Potes x Jason Ligas, Greek Connection 2018** Assyrtiko/Moscat - Samos Island, Greece 73  
“This is a project ran by two sommeliers from Paris, with each cuvee they team up with a different winemaker to produce a new wine. Here they have paired with Jason Ligas from Samos Island in Greece. Expect rich, dried fruit And incredible texture. Stunning.”

### Red //

**Alessandro Viola, Il Moretto 2015** Nerello Mascalese/Berricone/Syrah - Etna, Italy 40  
“Spicy, savoury number from Etna. Notes of black pepper with a good structure. Classic.”

**4Kilos, 12 Volts, 2019** Merlot, Calle, Cabernet - Mallorca, Spain 64  
“Made from a blend of local varieties (Callet and Fogoneu) along with Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Merlot, sourced from vineyards in the north and south of the island. Intensely drinkable and vibrant, this is a wine that provides a figurative, as well as literal, jolt of energy.”

**Gabrio Bini, Serragghia Fanino 2018** Cataratto/Pignatello - Pantelleria, Italy 126  
“From Gabrio, the King of cool made in Italy. This is a blend of white and red grapes, somewhere between a light red and an orange. Notes of Sicilian blood orange, cherries jam, dried herbs and citrus peel on the palate.”
