### White

La Pegase, Sauvignon Blanc/Melon Bourgogne, Domaine de L'Epinay, Loire, France - £21/£5.25  
 Ripe peach and apricot, green apple and lime zest.

Seriously cool, Chenin Blanc, Waterkloof, Stellenbosch, South Africa - £23/£5.75  
 White flowers and stone fruit, hints of honey and soft acidity.

Primula, Sauvignon Blanc, Domaine de L'Epinay, Loire, France - £25  
 Fresh apple and elderflower, apricot and crisp pear.

Sex, Drugs+Rock'n'Roll, Reisling, Emile Bauer+Sohne, Pfalz, Germany - £30  
 Dry and crisp, lychee and peach, citrus fruit and crunchy apples.

Loveblock, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand - £36  
 Pineapple, elderflower and nettle, rock melon, physalis and a creamy mouthfeel.

Vinterloper, Pinot Gris, Adelaide Hills, Australia - £41  
 Poached pear and peach, stone fruits with cinnamon and vanilla pod.

Waterkloof, Sauvignon Blanc, Stellenbosch, South Africa - £42  
 Exceptional finesse, steely mineral, grassy, tropical and sharp.

### Red

La Pegase, Merlot/Cabernet Franc, Domaine de L'Epinay, Loire, France - £21/£5.25  
 Crunchy red fruits and ripe berries, plum and a hint of green sap.

Tutti I Giorni, Sangiovese/Ciliegiolo/Alicante, Tuscany, Italy (1L) - £34/£6  
 Gluggable juicy cherry and raspberry, caraway, thyme and a smooth finish.

St-Chinian 'Cuvee Donnadieu', Syrah/Mourvèdre/Grenache/Carignan,  
 Clos Bagatelle, Languedoc, France - £29/£7.25  
 Blackberries and cherries, prunes, herbs and sweet baking spices.

Seriously cool, Cinsault, Waterkloof, Stellenbosch, South Africa - £26  
 Fresh cherry and cranberry sharpness, ripe tannins and surprising length.

Loveblock, Pinot Noir, Central Otago, New Zealand - £41  
 Ripe black cherry, smoke and musky earth, victoria plum and a hint of violet.

Vinterloper, Touriga National, Adelaide, Australia - £42  
 Ripe plum, clove and lavender, red berries, liquorice and soft tannins.

### Rosé

Cape Corral, Mourvèdre, Circumstance, Stellenbosch, South Africa - £24/£6  
 Crisp and dry, fresh fruit and creamy dried apricot, fig and a stony minerality.

### Sparkling

La Dilletante Vouvray, Chenin Blanc, Loire, France - £36  
 White fleshed peaches and perry freshness, bright flowers and mellow honey.

Bergecrac, Sauvignon Blanc/Sauvignon Gris/Semillon+Chenin Blanc, Chateau Barouillet, Bergerac, France - £27/£6.75  
Fantastic blend, zesty and creamy, rich, floral and fruity with a hint of biscuit.

St-Chinian Blanc, Clos Bagatelle, Languedoc, France - £28  
Herbaceous and nutty, elegant and linear with great structure.

Scheu..Aber Geil, Scheurebe, Emile Bauer+Sohne Pflaz, Germany - £30/£7.50  
Peach, elderflower and passionfruit, crisp acidity and citrus zest.

Gsellman, Welsch-Reisling, Bergenland, Austria - £30  
Crisp with real fruit purity, bright apple and a hint of pepper.

Posca Bianca, Pignoletto/Alionza/Albana/Malvasia, Orsi Sn Vito, Emilia-Romagna - £38  
Complex mix of fruit and flowers, nutty salinity and an intriguing lengthy finish.

Fleuve Blanc, Macabeu/Carignan/Grenache Gris, La Bancale, Languedoc, France - £39  
Quince and white flowers, apricot, mint and a hint of geranium.

## Red

Les Marmots, Cinsault/Grenache/Syrah, Les Grange Saint Andre, Languedoc, France - £25/£6.25  
Juicy currant and bright blueberry, fine tannin and a touch of volatile funk.

Bergecrac Rouge, Malbec/Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot/Cabernet Franc, Chateau Barouillet, Bergerac, France - £27  
Plum and red berries, spicy, herbaceous and clean.

Litrozzo Rosso, Sangiovese/Montepulciano/Merlot, Le Coste, Lazio, Italy (1L) - £41  
Gentle spice and ripe cherry, raspberry and blackberry with neat tannins.

Posca Rossa, Barbera/Negreto/Sangiovese, Orsi San Vito, Emilia-Romagna, Italy - £38  
Bright fruit and great acidity, earthy savoury character and strong tannins.

Fleuve Rouge, Syrah/Carignan, La Bancale, Languedoc, France - £39  
Complex dark berries, blackcurrant, liquorice and violet.

Metamorphica, Red Sumoll, Costador, Tarragona, Spain - £48  
Elegant and refined, fresh redcurrant and berries, hints of minerality and clay.

Hunky Dory, Garnatxa, Vinyes Tortuga, Catalonia, Spain - £41  
Easy drinking, tiny hint of effervescence matched with ripe tannins and depth.

## Rosé

Litrozzo Rosato, Procanco/Aleatico/Sangiovese, Le Coste, Lazio, Italy (1L) - £42  
Pale pink, funky fragile berries, tart green apples and an incredible refreshing finish.

Podere Santa Maria, Brunello, Tuscany, Italy - £40  
Vivid pink, sour cherries and redcurrant, crashing freshness and great acidity.

## Orange

Baglio Bianco, Cattarato, Sicily, Italy - £29/£7.25  
Bright and fresh, pink grapefruit and red apple, soft almond and approachable tannins.

Podere Santa Maria, Ansonica, Tuscany, Italy - £41  
Big hitting citrus and rounded stone fruit, firm tannins and a salty finish.

Metamorphica, Sumall Blanc, Costador, Tarragona, Spain - £47  
Funky and fruity peach and apricot, orange zest and creamy vanilla.

Cle a Molette, Molette, Domaine L'Octavin, Jura, France - £59  
Delicate hints of ripe citrus, white flowers and a clean salty finish.

Leaning back in time, Pinot Gris, Anders Frederik Steen, Alsace, France - £61  
Earthy with natural funk and salty juicy pineapples, long grass, fresh watermelon and peaches.

Charme, Chenin Blanc, Jean-Pierre Robinot, Loire, France - £69  
Fresh peaches, elderflower and greengage, mineral and light with dancing acidity.

## Red

Jean-Pierre Rietsch, Pinot Noir, Alsace, France - £56  
Blindingly brilliant, fresh and fruity, clean and wonderfully structured

Grenabar, Domaine L'Octavin, Grenache/Carignan, Jura, France - £59  
Rhubarb, strawberries and pear, fennel, thyme and rosemary.

## Orange

Peaches, Manon, Pinot Gris/Sauvignon Blanc/Savagnin/Chardonnay, Adelaide Hills, Australia - £62  
Beautiful peach, stone fruits and spice, pink grapefruit and white strawberries.

The Orange, Eschenhoffer Holzer, Roter Veltliner, Wagram, Austria - £71  
Rich colour and satisfying piquancy, elegant body and texture.

## All the Sparkling

Despina, Malvasia, Quarticello, Emilia-Romagna, Italy - £35/£5.5  
Crisp green apple and peach, honey and slight salty biscuit edge.

Splash, Semillon, Chateau Barouillet, Bergerac, France - £41  
Fresh and tart Pet-Nat, zingy citrus, white tea, lychee and pear.

Atardecer, Tinto Velasco, Vinos Patios, La Mancha, Spain - £40  
Raspberry and cranberry sorbet, red currant, strawberry and light toasty notes.

Neromaestri, Lambrusco, Quarticello, Emilia-Romagna, Italy - £34  
Rustic and bone dry, restrained red fruit, earthy and salty.
