BRAT POUR

Our monthly focus on a single producer's wine.

Cultivated since Roman times, Ribeira Sacra's steep terraced vineyards are some of the most picturesque and treacherous to work. Winegrowing here is not for the faint of heart, it takes determination, optimism, a sense of tradition. All of these qualities are embodied by the young Pedro Rodríguez of Guímaro.

Finca Meixemán is from a single 1.2 ha plot -facing south-east- of 70 year old Mencía vines planted on schist at 400-450 meters. This is the original family-owned vineyard that helped the Rodríguez's create their winery. The cuvee gets a unique vinification with foot-treading, partial whole cluster fermentation in open top barrels, long maceration on the skins and aging for 12-14 months in old 225 liter French oak. With a core of kirsch-like red fruit, spices, and minerals, this is a serious wine to pair with wild game and roasted or grilled meats.

SHERRY

While sherry is often ignored by the larger wine-drinking populace, even an entry-level fino from a great producer shows an astoundingly nuanced and complex character. In today's market where many of the world's finest wines have become prohibitively expensive, sherry still represents one of the wine world's great bargains, as well as being one of the most versatile wines when it comes to food.

UNDER THE FLOR

Flor is the mysterious layer of yeast that lies on top of some sherry wine while they age in barrel. Fino and Manzanilla spend their entire maturation under flor, whereas Amontillado and Palo Cortado begin their lives under flor, being exposed to oxygen once it breaks. These differences make for a diverse and delicious range of sherry styles. The flavours imparted are unlike anything else in the wine world, saline in character with notes of sea spray, almonds, and mediterranean herbs.

OXIDATIVE

Sherries that are aged with gentle and controlled exposure to oxygen in the absence of flor are typically richer in texture, displaying flavours of walnuts, leather, bitter chocolate, and exotic spices.
