CHAMPAGNE

2014 LOUIS ROEDERER 'CRISTAL' BRUT

FRANCE | CHAMPAGNE | SUSTAINABLE

Legendary producer with a legendary champagne first made especially for the Russian Tsar Alexander II in 1876. 60% pinot noir and 40% chardonnay. No malolactic transformation. The second fermentation took place according to traditional bottled method. Dosage 8 grams/liter. The wine was aged a full seven years on the lees.....3790

NV DHONDT-GRELLET 'DANS UN PREMIER TEMPS' EXTRA BRUT

FRANCE | CHAMPAGNE | ORGANIC/BIO (NOT CERT.)

50% Chardonnay, 30% Pinot Noir, 20% Pinot Meunier from various plots across Sezanne, Cuis, Avenay Val d'or. 70% comes from 2016 and the rest is from a solera that was started in 1986. Manual harvest, whole bunches pressed and fermented with natural yeast in steel tank and barrique. No chaptalization, clarification or filtration, malolactic fermentation started naturally, around 4-5g/l dosage1000

NV DHONDT-GRELLET CHAMPAGNE 'CRAMANT' GRAND CRU EXTRA BRUT

FRANCE | CHAMPAGNE | CÔTE DES BLANCS | CRAMANT | ORGANIC/BIO (NOT CERT.)

100% Chardonnay from old vines (about 55 years old) from the two *lieu-dit* (individual vineyard locations) La Garennes and Les Longues Verges in the Côte des Blancs. 70% of the wine is from 2018 and the rest is reserve wine accumulated since 1986. Fermentation in old small oak barrels with full malolactic transformation. 24 months sur lattes and disgorgement in May 2021. Dosage 2g/l. A large powerful wine with elegant minerality1500

NV LAHERTE FRÈRES BLANC DE NOIRS BRUT NATURE

FRANKRIE | CHAMPAGNE | BIO (EJ CERT.)

50% Pinot Noir from Le Breuil and 50% Pinot Meunier from Côteaux Sud d'Epernay from the harvests of 2019 and 2020. Spontaneous fermentation and six months of ageing on the lees in older Burgundy barrels (3-10 years old) and larger oak barrels (*foudres*) with regular stirring (*batonnage*) and malolactic transformation. Disgorged by hand in April 2022 without dosage. 25 mg/l SO₂ when pressed. Organic yeast and cane sugar for second fermentation in bottle990

2019 LAHERTE FRÈRES 'NATURE DE CRAIE R19' 1ER CRU BRUT NATURE

FRANCE | CHAMPAGNE | BIO (NOT CERT.)

100% Chardonnay. Spontaneous fermentation and seven months of aging on the lees in older barriques (3-10 years old) with regular batonnage. Full malolactic transformation. 15 months sur lattes. Disgorged by hand in May 2021 without dosage. No addition of SO₂. Organic yeast and organic cane sugar for other fermentation. Surprisingly open to its small age with a seductive fruitiness and minerality1200

NV LAHERTE FRÈRES BLANC DE BLANCS BRUT NATURE

FRANCE | CHAMPAGNE | BIO (NOT CERT.)

100% Chardonnay from vines with an average age of 35 years. Organic/biodynamic farming without certification. Spontaneous fermentation in older burgundy barrels and foudres. Six months of aging with regular stirring. Partial malolactic conversion (20%). Base year 2018 with 50% reserve wine from 2016 and 2017. 15-24 months sur lattes. Degorged by hand in January 2021 without dosage.....930

2015 EMILIE FENEUIL 'CUVÉE TOTUM' BRUT NATURE

FRANCE | CHAMPAGNE | ORGANIC

Pinot Meunier, Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and a gable Petit Meslier, from 40-year-old vines. The proportions are approximately 60/30/8/2. The different grape varieties and parcels are pressed and fermented together. Spontaneous fermentation in old 228-liter and 400-liter barrels. 30 mg/l SO₂ added when pressing. Organic yeast and cane sugar. Bottled September 2016. Degorgerad June 2019 without dosage. Complex taste where flowers and tropical fruits are combined with umami. 1100 bottles in total.....1800

OTHER SPARKLING WINES

2018 DOMAINE DU PÉLICAN SAVAGNIN ARBOIS BRUT 'S° ZERO'

FRANCE | JURA | VIN DE FRANCE | BIO (NOT CERT.)

Not many people make sparkling wine at Savagnin and Domaine du Pelican (owned by the legendary Domaine d'Anerville in Burgundy) is of course not like everyone else. Since it is 100% Savagnin and the rules only allow 30% it must not be sold as Crémant du Jura. The wine was stored for 12 months before the second fermentation was started with 10% must from the previous year. Disgorging was done after 13 months. Taste-wise, it's all about yellow plums, pears, aromatic herbs, nuts and salty minerality890

2020 FLORIAN BECK-HARTWEG "CUVÉE EDEN" GRAND CRU FRANKSTEIN

ALSACE | FRANKSTEIN | ECOCERT/AB-CERT

A funky, salty natural wine that is a blend of Riesling, Pinot Gris and directly pressed Pinot Noir. Grapes grown in granite-rich sandy soil with southern exposure. Slow gentle pressing of whole grapes in pneumatic press to preserve the purity of aromas. 10% macerated in the oak barrels. Natural fermentation for 8-10 months in old oak barrels. No clarification, filtration or added sulfite850

2020 LÉO DIRRINGER FRANKSTEIN GRAND CRU

ALSACE | FRANKSTEIN | ECOCERT

Direct pressing of whole bunches of grapes of equal parts Riesling and Pinot Gris grown in lean granite mades. Fermentation starts with natural yeast. The wine rested for 18 months on the lees in old oak barrels (*foudre*) before being bottled without clarification, filtration or addition of sulphur. Intense aromas of ripe apples, stone fruit and citrus fruits with both power and length780

2019 DOMAINE RIETSCH SYLVANER VIEILLE VIGNE

ALSACE | ECOCERT

The Rietsch family has a long history of farming in Alsace – their estate in the foothills of the Vosges has been passed down for seven generations. Grapes from old vines partly from Grand Cru Zotzenberg (50%) and two other locations in Mittelbergheim (Alsace AOP) where all locations have a soil of calcareous clay and marl. Spontaneous fermentation in tank with full malolactic transformation. 31 months on the lees in older oak ledgers (*foudre*). Light filtration through cellulose. Bottled in April 2022 without any additives. A gastronomic wine with salty minerality and citrus such as tangerine, grapefruit and lemon815

2019 LINDENLAUB 'ORIGINE L' RIESLING

ALSACE | ORGANIC/AB-CERT

The Lindenlaub family has been growing wine in Dorlisheim since 1759. Christophe, who now manages the vineyards, switched to organic in 2009. Cuvée on grapes from a high south facing position in Mutzig with clay and limestone on top of sandstone. Yields were kept low for a concentrated age-worthy style. Direct press, natural yeast and 2 years on steel tank. A complex wine with remarkable texture. No added sulfite910

2016 KUENTZ-BAS GEISBERG GRAND CRU RIESLING

ALSACE | BIO/VIN BIOLOGIQUE

The Geisberg ("Goat Mountain") is one of Alsace's foremost crus, known for producing long-lived Rieslings. Only three wine farmers grow wine on this complex terroir of limestone, marl and sandstone. Manual harvest, careful pressing for 10-12 hours, natural yeast, Ten months on the lees in steel tanks. Residual sweetness 8.8g/l. Quince, pineapple, peach, grilled lemon, some ripening tones, razor sharp acidity and salty minerality880

2019 DOMAINE ELENI ET EDOUARD VOCORET CHABLIS 'LES BUTTEAUX' 1ER CRU

BOURGOGNE | CHABLIS | BUTTEAUX

Eleni and Edouard Vocoret have in a short time gathered a cult following and have been praised for their wines that show tremendous precision. The grapes come from the upper part of Butteaux in the lower part of Montmains, where they grow in lime-rich white clay soils. Nice, detailed and very mineral with a lovely tense structure and mouthfeel. Fine tones of herbs, lemon and grapefruit1100

2018 CHÂTEAU DE BÉRU CHABLIS 'CÔTE AUX PRÊTRES'

BOURGOGNE | CHABLIS | ECOCERT

Lieu-dit (individual vineyard location) Côte aux Prêtres, Béru (the village declined to be included in the classification in 1938, so all locations are Chablis AOP). High altitude, wind-swept west facing just southeast of Béru. Lean mineral-rich soil of weathered limestone from marine fossils (Kimmeridge). Hand harvesting and direct pressing of whole bunches. Spontaneous fermentation with malolactic transformation, 18 months of aging on the lees in old medium-sized oak barrels and steel tank, in roughly equal parts. No clearing or filtering. 20 mg/l added sulphite. Intense fresh fruity taste with fine acidity and salty minerality910

2020 AMI SAINT-ROMAIN 'COMBE BAZIN' BLANC

BOURGOGNE | CÔTE DE BEAUNE | ORGANIC

AMI is a relatively new project based in Maranges, right around the crest at Montrachet. The friends have a background in well-known domains such as de Montille, Hauvette, Derain and Cossard. Combe Bazin is 100% Chardonnay from 3 vineyards where the soil is made up of calcareous clay. Direct press of whole bunches, spontaneous fermentation in steel tank followed by 12 months of ageing in old Burgundy barrels. 30mg/l sulfur added. Here we find mainly mineral and white flowers and a very nice structure1100

2017 DOMAINE PIGNIER 'SAUVEGEON' SAVAGNIN

JURA | CÔTES DU JURA | BIO/DEMETER

Sauvegeon is the old local name of the grape Savagnin, suggesting that the grape has historically been wild-growing. The grape material comes from farms mentioned back in the 13th century. In 1794, the Pignier family took over the farms from monks. This cuvée has been raised for 12 months on topped egg-shaped barrels, providing minimal oxidation. Here we talk elegance, purity and salty aromatic energy 950

2018 DOMAINE DU PÉLICAN 'GRAND CUROULET' SAVAGNIN OUILLÉ

JURA | ARBOIS | ORGANIC

Domaine du Pélican is owned by legendary Burgundy producer Marquis de Angerville. Grand Curoulet is a lean vineyard location in Arbois where the conditions are ideal for Savagnin, which here gives late maturity and very energetic mineral wines with enormous precision and length. Topped up barrels with 1/3 of the wine had skin contact. Amazing concentration of exotic fruit, roasted hazelnut and peppery spiciness 1100

2020 HUGHES BEGUET 'OH YEAH' SAVAGNIN

JURA | ARBOIS | BIO/DEMETER

The domain today consists of 4 hectares around the village of Mesnay and Pupillin. Hand harvesting and natural fermentation in topped up barrels to prevent oxidation (of which the name Oh Yeah, which sounds like *ouillé*, the local name for topped up barrels). Bottling without added sulphur or filtration. Wonderful fresh grape-typical taste with a length that leaves you in awe 950

2020 CORENTIN HOUILLON 'MONTÉE FURIEUSE' JACQUÈRE

SAVOIE | SERRIÈRES-EN-CHAUTAGNE | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

Corentin has learned from the best – that is, from his cousins and Houillon the Elder in Pupillin, Arbois. He has also worked for Dominique Derain in Burgundy and Stéphane Tissot in Jura. South-west facing on a steep slope at Mount Gros Foug. Soil of sandstone and quartz sand. Spontaneous fermentation in equal parts in temperature controlled tanks as well as 350-liter barrels, 14 months on the lees. No clarification, filtration and no additives. Fresh like an alpine stream with only 10.5% ABV 820

2020 CORENTIN HOUILLON 'FORCE OF NATURE' ALTESSE

SAVOIE | SERRIÈRES-EN-CHAUTAGNE | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

South-west facing on a steep slope at Mount Gros Foug. Soil of sandstone called molasses formed during the Ice Age, and one fifth quartz sand. Spontaneous fermentation and fourteen months of ageing on the lees in used barrels. No clarification or filtration and no additives. Fresh and full of energy, notes of citrus and salty minerals, only 11.5% alcohol 820

2018 LES VIGNES HERBEL 'L'ENCHANTEUR' ANJOU BLANC

LOIRE | ANJOU-SAUMUR | ANJOU | ORGANIC

Nadège Hergel's winemaking philosophy is simple: to succeed in making good wine, good grapes are required! The relatively small yield allows her to find a perfect ripeness of the grapes with sufficient sweetness and acidity that creates balance in the wine, then no additives are needed in the winemaking. Here a Chenin Blanc of the fuller kind with classic notes of green apples, citrus, chamomile and mouth-watering minerality. Add to that incipient maturity tones that bring even more joy to the glass 840

2018 PIERRE MÉNARD 'PLUTON' ANJOU BLANC

LOIRE | ANJOU-SAUMUR | ANJOU | BIO (NOT CERT.)

Pierre Ménard's flagship made from specially selected grape material from logs growing in phthanite (a blue shimmering stone that is the pre-stage to schist). The result is Chenin Blanc extra everything! 7.1 g/l residual sweetness balanced perfectly against 4.04 g/l acid. Only 497 bottles of this vintage 1250

2018 THIBAUD BOUDIGNON 'LA VIGNE CENDRÉE' SAVENNIÈRES

LOIRE | ANJOU-SAUMUR | SAVENNIÈRES

A truly phenomenal Chenin Blanc with a nice creaminess in Burgundian style. Grapes from 0.5ha in a lieu-dit La Vigne Cendrée in Savennières, with southern exposure and clay soil. Fermentation takes place in steel tank and then the wine is stored for 12 months on 226 l old Burgundian oak barrels and foudres 1300

2020 CÔME ISAMBERT SAUVIGNON BLANC PINEAU D'AUNIS

LOIRE | TOURAINE | SAUMUR | ORGANIC

Côme Isambert Wines is a winemaking project that started in 2013 in Saumur. Grapes are purchased from organic farms and used in various more or less experimental cuvées. When Côme is not a wine maker, he is a teacher organic farming at the oenology institute in Saumur. Here we have 80% Sauvignon Blanc that has undergone carbonation fermentation for 10 days to bring out the fruity notes. 20% direct pressed Pineau d'Aunis has then been added. Unfiltered, no clearing and no addition of sulphites. Fresh, fresh with magnificent burst of tropical fruits 790

2020 PETER LAUER AYLER RIESLING 'FASS 6 SENIOR' TROCKEN FEINHERB

MOSEL | SAAR | ORGANIC WITHOUT COPPER SULFATE (NOT CERT.)

Classic Mosel with wet stones, green apples and white flowers. Young but already fully drinkable. Because of Germany's somewhat messy rules, it is classified as Ortswein but the grapes origin is really Ayler Kupp, that is Grand Cru. Some of the vines are 120 years old and ungrafted..... 740

2017 PETER LAUER SAARFEILSER 'FASS 13' GROSSES GEWÄCHS RIESLING

MOSEL | SAAR | ORGANIC WITHOUT COPPER SULFATE (NOT CERT.)

Saarfeilser gives the most generous of the GG wines, due to the fact that it is Lauer's warmest vineyard. It is situated across the river from Kupp, with deeper gravelly soils over the typical slate. Green apples, lime, wet pebbles, herbs, flowers and a creaminess from 8 months on the lees with battonage (stirring)..... 1200

2019 ANSGAR CLÜSSERATH TRITTENHEIMER 'APOTHEKE' RIESLING SPÄTLESE

GERMANY | MOSEL | ORGANIC WITH MED BIODYNAMIC METHODS (NOT CERT.)

Eva Clüsserath runs this vineyard which has been a family estate since 1670. Piesporter Goldtröpfchen is known for producing fantastic sweet wines. Here is instead a semi-dry (feinherb). Aged with the lees for more than six months in 1000 litres fuder..... 740

2018 WAGNER-STEMPEL GUTSWEIN SCHEUREBE TROCKEN

RHEINHESSEN | ORGANIC

Scheurebe is a crossroads at Riesling and Bouquetsaube that Dr. Georg Scheu developed in 1916 in an attempt to produce a more frost-resistant grape than Riesling and Silvaner. Most often it is used for sweet wines because it is extremely difficult to make dry wines without losing balance. Wagner-Stempel is the exception. The taste is reminiscent of a fresh Riesling with large doses of grapefruit, rhubarb and juicy peach that blooms out in green herbaceous tones..... 620

2018 WEINGUT KELLER RIESLING RR RESERVE

RHEINHESSEN

Klaus-Peter Keller's wines can be found in Buckingham Palace's wine cellar, among other places. He is known for his meticulous handling of the entire process from grape to bottle that produces powerful wines with tremendous precision. An aromatic powerhouse, very fresh taste of yellow apples, peach, lemongrass, honey, herbal spiciness and lime. The grapes come mainly from Kirchspiel, which is Grosse Lage..... 1150

2017 WITTMANN 'KIRCHSPIEL' GROSSES GEWÄCHS RIESLING

RHEINHESSEN | RESPEKT-BIODYN

Starts off racy and elegant before unraveling, with a richly spiced frame and a core of fruity flavors of red peach, Meyer lemon and persimmon. A very seductive and refined version, offering a bit of creaminess offset by crystalline acidity. The powerful finish is full of ripe, spicy flavors and creamy notes..... 1400

2018 WITTMANN 'MORSTEIN' GROSSES GEWÄCHS RIESLING

RHEINHESSEN | RESPEKT-BIODYN

Morstein was mentioned in writings back in 1282. Here are optimal conditions on the limestone slope. Intense herbal on the nose and an overwhelming elegance and concentration of yellow fruits, spices and minerals followed by a crystal clear crunchy finish. It does not get much better than this..... 1400

2016 KÜHLING-GILLOT 'PETTENTHAL' GROSSES GEWÄCHS RIESLING

RHEINHESSEN | ORGANIC WITH BIODYNAMIC METHODS

From the steepest slopes in Rheinhessen, with unusually rocky soil forcing the roots of the vines to find their way deep into the ground for water and nutrition. The location and soil produce fantastically lively and spicy wines that are nothing like the tighter wines of the more famous Morstein and Kirchspiel..... 1300

2016 DÖNNHOFF 'DELLCHEN' GROSSES GEWÄCHS RIESLING

NAHE | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

The vines are 15-30 years old and grow on a steep slope with roots in slate and porphyry soil. A very refined bouquet of peach, rosehip and wild berries in the nose. Amazing concentration, elegance and finesse. The finish is so long and mineral-rich that you almost lose your breath..... 1200

2018 J.B. BECKER WALLUFER 'OBERBERG' RIESLING KABINETT HALBTROCKEN

RHEINGAU | ORGANIC

Seckinger's rieslings always undergo malolactic fermentation, which gives a nice creaminess without losing freshness. The grapes fermented spontaneously in old oak barrels, no filtration or clearing. Only 5 mg/l sulphur added1200

2017 SECKINGER 'ÖLBERG' RIESLING

PFALZ | ORGANIC

Lower than Kieselberg, which gives a fatter almost Burgundy style with less spice than Kieselberg but the same nice electric dry freshness. The grapes spontaneously fermented in old oak barrels, no filtration or clearing. Only 5 mg/l sulphur added.....1050

2020 WEINGUT LASSAK RIESLING

WÜRTTEMBERG | ORGANIC WITH BIODYNAMIC METHODS

2021 CASCINA CORTE LANGHE AMPHORAE 'CECILIA' NASCETTA

PIEMONTE | LANGHE | LANGHE DOC | ORGANIC/ICEA

The couple Sandro Barosi and Amaglia Battaglia are housed in a farm from the 1600s where they have 5.5 hectares of wine (some pre-phyloxera) and 4.5 hectares of pasture as well as vegetable gardens. The result is a fresh generous wine with a tremendous minerality that keeps everything in place 920

SLOVAKIA

2019 STREKOV 1075 'VELTLÍN' GRÜNER VELTLINER

SLOVAKIEN | JUŽNOSLOVENSKÁ | BIO (NOT CERT.)

Grüner Veltliner with its austere white pepperiness is one of our favorite grapes for our food. Here an umami aromatically healthy Grüner from Slovakia's most natural wine pioneer Zsolt Sütő. Soil is settled clay with a high content of iron and lime, which gives wines with minerality and fine acidity. The wine has been with the lees for 10 months before it was bottled unfiltered, unclear and without added sulphur 790

HUNGARY

2019 BENCZE BIRTOK CHENIN BLANC

BALATON | BADACSONYI | BIO

Finely tuned, fresh and fruity unfiltered biodynamic Chenin Blanc from Hungary. The handpicked whole bunches were pressed and set to ferment in 330 liters of terracotta amphorae and 300-400 liters of old oak barrels. After about 11 months, the wine was bottled without clearing or filtration and without any added sulphur 750

2017 ATTILA HOMONNA 'HATÁRI' TOKAJI FURMINT

TOKAJI | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

Unlike many other winemakers in the region, Attila does not strive for power and fruity sweetness. Instead, it is finesse, minerality and high acidity that are his goals. He gets this through early harvesting, long fermentation in cool cellars, natural yeast, old vines and low harvest yields. Growing up takes place in old barrels until Attila thinks they are ready to be bottled. Grape material from over 120 years old vines. The wine was allowed to ripen for a year in large old oak barrels. Wet pebbles, fresh sourdough bread, toasted chestnuts, Darjeeling tea, lilacs and fresh pears. The acidity is razor sharp 950

2019 SOMLÓ KINCSE TRAMINI

NAGY-SOMLÓ | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

With only 438 hectares, Somló is the smallest wine region in Hungary. The region is characterized by a barren, mineral-rich volcanic soil that produces amazing wines, which already the Romans discovered. Tramini is the local name for the grape Savagnin, well-known from Jura in France. Here the expression is different from what we usually get from Jura. In addition to the characteristic spiciness and high acidity, there is also a salty smoky minerality, acacia honey, floral in the form of roses, dried apricots, William pears, and tropical fruits such as lychee. 2018 SHIMANOUCHI FUJIMARU 'DELA TABLETOP'

TOKYO | KANTŌ

Delaware is a *vitis labrusca* grape, i.e. a grape of North American origin, but has been grown in Japan for many years. You can find it mainly in Yamagata in the north. Here we find a palpable scent of jasmine flowers backed by tones of fennel and wild herbs. The acid is fresh, long and food-friendly 750

2020 PIERRE FRICK 'ROT MURLÉ' PINOT GRIS MACÉRATION PUR VIN - SANS SULFITE AJOUTÉ

ALSACE | ECOCERT/DEMETER

Alsace natural wine pioneer Pierre Frick, who has worked biodynamically since 1981, is careful to point out that he does not make (*fabriquons*) wine – he breeds (*élevons*) wine. The red soil in Rot Murlé, Alsace, is telltale of its high iron content, but at the same time the red color hides the fact that the soil is also calcareous (which helps bring out the acidity in the wine). Whole bunches were macerated for 7 days before being gently pressed. The wine was then allowed to ripen with the lees in large very old oak barrels for a full year. ALSACE | ECOCERT/DEMETER

Since the 1970s, the family has been growing organically and in 1981 they started working biodynamically. Today, Domaine Pierre Frick is one of the most prominent producers in Alsace and one of the main proponents of biodynamic winemaking. Voyages is a mischievous blend where the grape mix varies from year to year. In the 2019 vintage, they have hit it big and included basically all their grapes – Riesling, Muscat, Silvaner, Gewürztraminer, Pinot Gris, Pinot Blanc and directly pressed Pinot Noir. MV J.M DREYER "TRI-AUX" 18/19/20

ALSACE | BIO/DEMETER

Three vintages Auxerrois (2018/19/20) that have had to be macerated separately for different lengths depending on how each vintage behaved. As always when it comes to Jean-Marc's wines, harvesting by hand, old oak barrels that are not topped up, and of course no filtration and no added SO₂850

2020 REYNALD HEAULE "O" MACÉRATION PINOT GRIS

LOIRE | BIODYNAMIC (NOT CERT.)

The hand-harvested grapes are destemmed and then left to lie with skin contact for 10 days. Fermentation with natural yeast in fibreglass tanks. The wine is allowed to ripen 6 months in older used oak barrels of 600 liters. When the wine is ready, it is bottled unfiltered and without added sulphites. 2019 2NATURKINDER "WEINSCHWÄRMER" PINOT GRIS

FRANKEN | BIODYNAMIC (NOT CERT.)

Weinschwärmer is the German name for a moth that the local bats in 2Naturkinder's vineyards like to munch on. 2021 WEINGUT SCHÖDL 'BLOODY MUSCAT IN NATURA'

NIEDERÖSTERREICH | WEINVIERTEL | ORGANIC

As the name gossips about, it's about a skin-macerated Roter Muskateller, a pink-shimmering mutation of the more common Gelber Muskateller. 10 days of skin-macerated has given a deep taste with soft tannins and floral creamy freshness with notes of roses, peaches, thyme. No added sulfur820

2017 MILAN NESTAREC "UMAMI"

MORAVIA | BIO (NOT CERT.)

The young but experienced winemaker Milan Nestarec has a thing for Asian food, and to that end he has created this cuvée. Blend of Traminer, Riesling, Müller Thurgau and Palava. Loess, ranks 6-15 years. The grapes were given 3-5 days of maceration (deseeded) in open vats, which gave structure but no tannins to speak of. 2 years on oak and acacia barrels. Natural yeast, no filtration or clearing. No added sulfur.....860

2017 MILAN NESTAREC "GINTONIC" SAUVIGNON BLANC

MORAVIA | BIO (NOT CERT.)

"Feeling supersonic, Sauvignon Blanc is my Gin Tonic", the young wayward wine maker Milan Nestarec sings. An odd but super tasty sauvignon blanc, backed up by a few splashes of Riesling and Pinot Blanc – light orange with one week skin contact for 1/3 of the grapes. Unfiltered no added sulfur. Fresh hints of grapefruit, passion fruit and oranges.....940

SPAIN

2020 COSTADOR "METAMORPHIKA" MUSCAT BRISAT

CATALONIA | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

Muscat from old bush vines in the Mediterranean hills of Conca de Barberà. Brisat is the old Catalan word for skin-macerated wines. The grapes lay with shell contact for six weeks in amphora followed by 8 weeks on old French oak. Flowers, rooibos tea, dried fruits, Mediterranean herbs and fine tannins. The wine comes in a ceramic bottle made from clay from the vineyard. No added SO₂.....750

2019 COLLECAPRETTA "TERRA DEI PRETI"

UMBRIA | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

The Trebbiano Spoletino grape, not to be confused with Trebbiano Toscana (Ugni Blanc), is very rare. Spontaneous fermentation with one week of skin maceration of whole grape bunches, then soft pressing and four months of storage in stainless steel tank. No clearing or filtering. Complex taste with hints of flowers and stone fruits.....780

2017 MARIE & OLIVIER HORIOT ROSÉ DES RICEYS "EN BARMONT"

CHAMPAGNE | CORBIERS | BIODYVIN

Rosé de Riceys is a historic wine style in Champagne that produces serious age worthy wines that are somewhere between rosé and red. 100% Pinot Noir fermented with natural yeast and given seven days of maceration "semi-carbonique" (10% foot-trampled grapes, the rest whole bunches). Ten months of ageing in used Burgundy barrels. Bottled 19-07-16 without prior clarification or filtration960

2021 ROMAIN LE BARS TAVEL ROSÉ

RHÔNE | SOUTHERN RHÔNE | TAVEL | BIODYNAMIC (NOT CERT.)

Romain Le Bars consists of the young progressive winemakers Valentin Valles, Sébastien Chatillon, Gregory Guillaume and Charles Soulier who in a short time put the southern Rhône on the natural wine map. Here a blend of 60% Grenache and 40% Syrah grown in clay and limestone. Direct pressing followed by spontaneous carbonation fermentation in small old oak barrels. No additives and no clarification or filtration. A serious Tavel rosé that offers flowers, red berries and fine freshness and texture790

2017 DOMAINE MARQUIS D'ANGERVILLE VOLNAY 1ER CRU "CHAMPANS"

BOURGOGNE | CÔTE DE BEAUNE | VOLNAY | ORGANIC/BIO

Domaine Marquis de Angerville is considered one of the top producers in Volnay and their wines are some of the most sought after in the entire Côte d'Or. The vines grow in limestone soil on slopes to the southeast. Rocky and meager soil of limestone and marl with clay. Spontaneous fermentation of whole bunches in open oak stands for two weeks. The wine matured in Georgian qvevri of 1200 liters. No clarification or filtration and no additives1250

2020 DOMAINE DE CHASSORNEY & FRÉDÉRIC COSSARD GEVREY-CHAMBERTIN "LES GENEVIÈRES"

BOURGOGNE | CÔTE DE NUITS | GEVREY-CHAMBERTIN | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

When Frédéric Cossard makes wine from his own grapes, they are sold under the name Domaine de Chassorney. For this wine grapes were bought from *lieu-dit* Reniard and then Frédéric sells the wine under his own name. 100% Pinot Noir, from 30-year-old vines growing in a flatter position in the southern part of the appellation east of Griottes-Chambertin and RN74. Soil of iron-rich red clay and limestone. Spontaneous fermentation of whole bunches in open oak stands for two weeks. The wine rested in large Georgian qvevris. No clarification, filtration and no additives. Stylistically, the wine is lighter, more open and more elegantly blooming than you would expect from Gevrey-Chambertin, which we only see as an advantage1750

2020 DOMAINE DE CHASSORNEY & FRÉDÉRIC COSSARD BOURGOGNE "BEDEAU" QVEVRIS

BOURGOGNE | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

100% Pinot Noir from 40-50-year-old vines growing in calcareous soil in Volnay and Nuits-Saint-Georges. Most of it is Frédéric's own grapes. Spontaneous fermentation of whole bunches in open oak stands for two weeks. After pressing, the wine matured in Georgian qvevris of 1200 liters, buried in a raised plane at the far end of the cellar. No clarification or filtering. No addition of sulphites. As usual with Frédéric's wines, it is all about floral elegance and precision, rather than power and bombast990

2020 JEAN FOILLARD FLEURIE

BEAUJOLAIS | FLEURIE | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

Grapes from Jean's about 1ha small plot in Fleurie (grand cru). The old vines grow in very barren pink limestone, which contributes to an incredible concentration and length of the wine. Traditional carbonic fermentation. 12 months in old oak barrels and another 1 year in the bottle. No clarification or filtering. Minimal addition of sulphites in bottling990

2019 ARNAUD COMBIER FLEURIE

BEAUJOLAIS | FLEURIE | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

100% Gamay coming from a small plot of pink granite soil. The grapes underwent traditional carbonic acid fermentation in tank with natural yeast, after which it was allowed to rest in old oak barrels with the yeast precipitate. In the glass you will find exactly what you want to find from a grand cru Fleurie – purity and elegance with finely tuned fruit, subtly backed by dried spices and rose petals. No added sulfite750

2021 JULIE BALAGNY 'MINOUCHE' FLEURIE

BEAUJOLAIS | FLEURIE | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

100% Gamay where the grapes come from *lieu dit* La Madone in Fleurie (one of 10 cru areas in Beaujolais) purchased from Julie's friend Sylvain Chanudet at Domaine de Prion. 2021 was (finally!) a cold vintage which is why the alcohol content clicks in at a modest 12.5%. Spontaneous fermentation of whole bunches under carbon dioxide (macération carbonique) with three weeks of passive maceration in closed fiberglass tanks. After pressing, the wine ripens in older Burgundy barrels. No clarification or filtration and no additives850

2020 CLOS BATEAU BEAUJOLAIS 'JOUJOU'

BEAUJOLAIS | VIN DE FRANCE | ECOCERT

Clos Bateau was started in 2019 by Dutch Sylvie and Thierry after a career in Amsterdam's restaurant world. With their two children in tow, they bought 5.5ha of wine land in Lantignié. The transition to certified organic farming was quickly initiated. They also planted fruit and nut trees to promote biodiversity. "JouJou" comes from 50-year-old vines of Gamay from the vineyards of Les Monthieux and Montmerand with pink granite soil with clay and quartz. Semi carbonated maceration. Fermentation and aging in steel tank. 15mg/l added sulfite when bottling. Elegant and aromatic, bright and juicy with cherry fruit, a touch of white pepper..... 780

2020/2021 JAN VAN ROEKEL 'SO WHAT GAMAY'

BEAUJOLAIS | VIN DE FRANCE | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

The Dutchman Jan van Roekel runs a wine bar with his own imports in Amsterdam. His great interest in wine has driven him to make wines himself. He buys the grape material from his good friend Romain des Grottes in Beaujolais. The vintage gets to decide how the grapes are treated, but the recipe is always about minimal intervention and no additives. Here a blend of the 2020 and 2021 vintages that really gives us the definition of an easy-drinking party wine, while having gastronomic saltiness and structure 770

2020 LES PIEDS SUR TERRE 'LES TROUILLOTS' TROUSSEAU

JURA | CÔTES DU JURA | ECOCERT

100% Trousseau from vines that are over 35 years old, planted on soils from the Triassic era which consist of calcareous marl. The vineyard is south-facing and all the grapes are harvested by hand when it has reached full maturity. After harvesting, maceration with whole bunches takes place in stainless steel tanks for 12 days. The wine is then aged in stainless steel vessels until the following spring when it is bottled unfiltered. Raspberry juice with a good splash of lemon and a little spiciness 950

2011 CHÂTEAU D'ARLAY PINOT NOIR

JURA | CÔTES DU JURA | ORGANIC

The renowned château in Jura took on its current form in the 1700s, but the place has been vineyards since the 1100s. Their red Pinot is made from grapes from 25-50 old vines that grow in calcareous soil. The grapes are destemmed and fermented with their natural yeast, after which it rests 4 years in large old oak barrels of about 6000 liters. Seductive scent of forest undergrowth, leather and mineral mixed with dried spices you find in the Vietnamese pantry, and also fully ripe strawberries, orange sauce and cola. Extremely affordable wine in the middle of a superb drinking phase 880

2020 PATRICE BÉGUET – NÉGOCE 'FRESH IMPRESSION RED'

JURA/RHÔNE/LOIRE | VIN DE FRANCE | ORGANIC

Strictly speaking, not a Jura wine but a multi-address négociant wine vinified by Patrice at Domaine Béguet in the Jura. The wine consists of 60% Grenache Noir from Claude Ughetto (Provence), 30% Gamay from Domaine Lindron Chartier (Loire-Atlantique) and 10% Poulsard from Patrice's own vineyards. 80% of the grape material was pressed directly and the remaining 20% are allowed to macerate with the skin. Start by admiring the color before emptying the glass! The bright seductive ruby red hues tell us what's to come – it's lively and at the same time graceful, red berries and cherry aromas mixed with smoky tones and fine minerality. Fresh impression, indeed! 750

2020 NICOLAS CARMARANS 'MAXIMUS' FER SERVADOU

AVEYRON | VIN DE FRANCE | ORGANIC

If Aveyron is France's most forgotten wine region, then the district's blue signature grape Fer Servadou is even less known. Nicolas Carmarans is working to change that, and for that reason he makes wine with 100% of the grape instead of using it to add rustic flavor and color to cuvées, which is the general rule. Grapes from 20-50 years old vines growing in red iron-rich clay in terraces. Harvesting by hand, natural yeast, carbonic fermentation for two weeks and aging in old oak barrels. No filtration and no additives. The taste is rustic yet fresh – however contradictory that might sound 780

2021 NICOLAS CARMARANS 'FER DE SANG' FER SERVADOU

AVEYRON | VIN DE FRANCE | ORGANIC

Grapes from about 70-year-old vines that grow in terraces with a soil of calcareous clay. Harvesting by hand, natural yeast, with maceration for two weeks and then ageing in old oak barrels. No filtration and no additives. A tricolor of currants interspersed with jalapeño, dried spices and a nice tongue tickling minerality 890

2019 REYNALD HÉAULÉ 'A CONTRE COURANT' ROUGE

LOIRE | VIN DE FRANCE | ORGANIC

Reynald often works with unusual field blends. Gamay, Pinot Meunier, Pinot Noir and Cabernet Franc coexist here and give a slightly unusual taste palette where you can still say that the characteristic spiciness of Cabernet Franc dominates. Spontaneous fermentation with natural yeast. The wine matured in old oak barrels of 225 liters for 18 months. Unfiltered and no added sulphur..... 735

2021 LE CASOT DES MAILLOLES 'COMAX ETHYLIX XXI'

LANGUEDOC-ROUSSILLON | ROUSSILLON | TARERACH | VIN DE FRANCE | ECOCERT

Blend on Syrah (80%) and Marsanne (20%) from logs of 20-25 years of age growing in terraces at an altitude of 550-600 meters with granite soils. By directly squeezing half of the destemmed grapes, Alain Castex has produced a wine that ticks off all the flavor boxes for the powerful grape Syrah, but at the same time retains a resilient food-friendly freshness. No additives of course..... 750

2019 LES CAVE DES NOMADES 'CAMINO ROJO'

LANGUEDOC-ROUSSILLON | BANYULS | VIN DE FRANCE | BIO

Blend with traditionally vinified Grenache and directly pressed Syrah. The grapes are tended to using biodynamic methods. Natural yeast and no clearing or filtration. Super fresh yet with pronounced dark fruits filled with natural energy. On the back of the bottle you can read "*Contient de l'amour et des sulfites naturels issus de la fermentation*" – "contains love and natural sulphites from fermentation"820

GERMANY**2011 BERNHARD HUBER 'SCHLOSSBERG' SPÄTBURGUNDER GROSSES GEWÄCHS**

BADEN | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

Bernhard Huber. a.k.a *The Wizard of German Pinot Noir*, sadly passed away in 2014. This vintage is thus one of Bernhard's last. In Schlossberg, wine has been grown since 1492. The steep slope requires manual work and the skeletal soil with bright yellow limestone is geologically rare at the foot of the Black Forest. The wine has great inner warmth and depth, fantastic structure, pronounced minerality and dense fruit1790

2018 ENDERLE & MOLL 'LIAISON' PINOT NOIR

BADEN | ORGANIC/BIO (NOT CERT.)

Enderle & Moll have earned themselves a cult following in the wine world, with their natural wines with great structure and freshness. Here we are offered floral, mineral rich elegance with tart cherries, cranberries, dried herbs and mushrooms..... 750

2018 ENDERLE & MOLL 'BUNTSANDSTEIN' PINOT NOIR

BADEN | ORGANIC/BIO (NOT CERT.)

Hand-picked grapes from vines growing in red sandstone. Like all Spätburgunder from Enderle & Moll, the wine is about elegance rather than power, although Buntsandstein exhibits slightly more of the latter than their other cru Muschelkalk does..... 910

2018 ENDERLE & MOLL 'MUSCHELKALK' PINOT NOIR

BADEN | ORGANIC/BIO (NOT CERT.)

Hand-harvested grapes from 70+ years old vines grown in limestone soil (one of the oldest vineyard locations in all of Germany). The grapes are pressed in a small basket press after 4-6 weeks of maceration. 90-100% whole cluster, spontaneous fermentation natural yeasts and finished in a large 1500L barrel. The wine is then aged in used oak barrels from Domaine Dujac. No fining or filtration, minimal addition of SO₂. To call this among the best and most Burgundian reds that can be found outside of France is no cliché..... 910

2019 TOMISLAV MARKOVIC 'WINDSPIEL' SPÄTBURGUNDER

BADEN | ORGANIC (NOT CERT.)

Tomislav worked as a banker but when his uncle introduced him to the world of wine, he switched career, which we of course are grateful for. In Rheinhessen he works with Riesling and in Baden Pinot Noir. He farms naturally and adds only a minimum of sulphur when bottling. Ripe dark cherries with a knife-edge peppery spice, cocoa and some spicy oak barrel tones and nice soft tannins 760

2019 STEFAN VETTER SPÄTBURGUNDER STEINTERRASSEN

FRANKEN | GAMBACHER KALBENSTEIN | ECOCERT

Stefan is a pioneer in biodynamic methods in Franken. Grapes from two small plots between the river Main, with a soil of marine limestone. Spontaneous fermentation of whole bunches and some partially destemmed/crushed ones. Fermentation in open plastic jars for 10 days. The wine rested 12 months in a used 500-liter barrel of old oak. No clarification or filtration only a minimal addition of SO₂..... 790

SWITZERLAND

2017 DOMAINE JULIEN GUILLON CUVÉE MATEO' PINOT NOIR

VALAIS | BIO

Wine from Switzerland is not a common sight on Swedish wine lists, which is simply due to the fact that the Swiss drink up most of it themselves. Julien Guillon is rising star in Switzerland. His vineyards are located at 900-meter altitude in the slopes of the Alps, which means cool climate and wines with a distinct natural freshness. The natural theme is followed up in the wine cellar = no added sulphur and unfiltered1100

2019 VALENTINA ANDREI GAMAY

VALAIS | SAILLON | BIO

The vines grow on barren granite soil (just like in the gamay "home region" Beaujolais in France), in terraced vineyards in the villages of Fully and Martigny. The vines are between 39 and 61 years. Fermentation on steel tank. Maceration with pigeage done by hand. Aging takes place on old barriques (small French oak barrels). Scent with an abundance of forest berries and forest floor, silky tannins and fine texture800

2019 OBRECHT 'TROCLA NERA' PINOT NOIR

JENINS | GRAUBÜNDEN | DEMETER

Christian and Francisca Obrecht are the fifth generation to run the small family winery on just under seven hectares in the middle of the village of Jenins. They work with nature and have been biodynamically certified by Demeter since 2017. Weingut Obrecht specializes in Pinot Noir and their flagship wine "Monolith" is considered one of Switzerland's very best. In the entry level wine "Trocla Nera" we find ripe red berries, elegant notes of tobacco and licorice, but above all the wine stands out with a wonderfully smoky minerality that brings to mind the volcanic slopes of Etna, Italy950

AUSTRIA

2021 WEINGUT SCHÖDL 'SANKT IN NATURA' SANKT LAURENT

NIEDERÖSTERREICH | WEINVIERTEL | LOIDESTHAL | BIO (NOT CERT.)

The grapes were harvested by hand in mid-September. 80% destemmed and 20% whole bunches were allowed to ferment together in large oak yeast for 10 days. After another 14 days of skin contact, the wine was pressed and allowed to rest in a 300-liter old oak barrel with a constant temperature of 14° C. Bottling without filtration or clarification with only a minimal amount of sulfur. Fleshy and juicy with a raw, vibrant mischievousness. Notes of black tea, herbs, spices and dark fruits760

HUNGARY

2019 BENCZE BIRTOK PINOT NOIR

BALATON | DEMETER

Very vibrant, fresh and fruity unfiltered biodynamic Pinot Noir from Hungary. The vines were planted in 1999. Ten days of fermentation in open tanks without stems. The wine lay and rested with the lees in stainless steel tanks for 5 months before being bottled without filtration or clearing. Only 10 mg/l added sulphur..770

2019 BENCZE BIRTOK 'ATLAS' PINOT NOIR

BALATON | RÓKALYUKI | DEMETER

Istvan Bencze has a small patchwork of vineyards on the side of mount Szent György in Badacsony, Hungary. He harvests early to preserve the acidity and works with minimal intervention. "Atlas" is the winery's flagship among the reds. Ten days of fermentation in open vats where half of the grape material was destemmed and the remaining underwent carbonation fermentation to bring forth the fruitiness. The wine rested for 6 months in old 2,500-liter oak barrels. No clarification, filtration or addition of sulphur. Red berries and earthy notes are at the forefront, incredible balance, soft tannins and a seductive finely tuned elegance850

2017 OSZKÁR MAURER 'KADARKA 1880'

SUBOTICA-HORGOŠKE PEŠČARE | DÉL-CSONGRÁD | ORGANIC

The vineyard Nosza Högyek is home to the oldest vines of Kadarka in the world, and Oszkár cares tenderly with biodynamic methods. It is only at particularly favorable vintages that he bottles the wine as "1880". Kadarka is often described as the Pinot Noir of Eastern Europe. In Kadarka wines you will often find notes of lingonberries where Pinot Noir pulls more towards sour cherries840

GREECE

2018 THYMIPOULOS 'NAOUSSA ALTA'

MACEDONIA | XINOMAVRO | ORGANIC

In Naoussa, the Thymiopoulos family has been growing the Nebbiolo-like Xinomavro grape for many generations. The vineyard is cared for with organic and biodynamic methods. The soil consists of limestone and volcanic rocks. 18 days maceration and fermentation with natural yeast for 1-3 months in old French oak barrels. Unfiltered and with minimal sulfur added. We are treated to strawberries, rose hips, bay leaves, cinnamon and elegant tannins in this affordable Greek response to Italy's pride Barolo690

NEW ZEELAND

2017 SATO 'PISA TERRACE' PINOT NOIR

SOUTH ISLAND | CENTRAL OTAGO | ORGANIC

The enthusiasts Yoshiaki and Kyoko Sato want to show the world that so-called natural wines are not at all about taste (volatile acids and funkiness) but pure wines without additives. Blend on three separate fermentations from the same location – two with completely stalked grapes and one with whole bunches. All three have fermented spontaneously. Careful manual pressing once a day, then pressing in vertical basket press. A total of three weeks of maceration. 19 months on French oak, of which 13 percent new barrels. 5 mg/l sulphur added for racking and 10 mg/l when bottling. No clearing or filtering.....840
