Le Grand Clément

Clément Rum - Grand Marnier - Lemon - Sugar - Orange Bitters

Featured Spirit: *Clément Rhum Agricole Blanc, Le François, Martinique*

Habitacion Clément is a historic rum distillery from Le François in The French Caribbean's Martinique Island. Honore Clément, the illustrious French doctor, transformed a struggling sugar plantation in 1887 into the impressive distillery seen today. Ushering in a rum renaissance, this provision allowed a much needed revitalisation for the economy of Martinique.

The Rhum Agricole Blanc featured herein was distilled from its own sugarcane plantation and aged in the distilleries' stainless steel tanks to preserve the natural beauty of the produce. Inspired by the history and the production ethos that Habitacion Clément has religiously produced with impeccable consistency, we have created this drink, *Le Grand Clément*.

We've incorporated the classic tropical flavors of this rum with crisp citrus flavors of Grand Marnier, zested it with bitter orange oils, to create a masterpiece, both visually and on the palate. Tropical sandy beach vacation with a hot lifeguard beside you. Life's a treat!

When there was the thought of pulling a brewery together, we knew that we wanted the beer to be built on quality and authenticity. If it wasn't going to be great, we weren't going to make it. The Lost Plot, Shiraz, Roussanne

Grampians, Victoria | 2020

Established by the Nix family in collaboration with winemaker Paul Olds, who is known for his work on southern French winery Les Clos Perdu (translates to "the lost vineyard", great wordplay!), this is a project that looks for the best quality and sometimes forgotten fruit, around the state of Victoria. Working from Nagambie to Heathcote to Mornington, there's no varietal limit to their creativity.

Paul has now passed the winemaking baton to the very capable hands of the talented Matt Campbell who continues the tradition of gentle handling and minimal mucking around to produce beautiful small-batch wines that truly reflect their sense of place.

Bright ruby red. Berry compote with baking spices on the nose. Nutmeg, anise and dried herbs. Palate is soft and supple with red fruits framed by tightly woven tannins and mellow acidity.

Giaconda

Beechworth, Victoria

Giaconda vineyard was established by Rick Kinzbrunner, a mechanical engineer who became interested in wine in the early 1970's. Rick then spent the next ten years working in the industry, traveling and following his passion for wine. After a brief stint in New Zealand, he studied at Davis University in California and worked at some of the most respected wineries in the Napa and Sonoma Valleys (namely Stag's Leap, Simi and Matanzas Creek). In Europe he worked for the Moueix group in Bordeaux, co-owner of the fabled Chateau Petrus.

After returning to Australia in 1980 to take up a position as assistant winemaker at Brown Brothers in Milawa, Rick purchased land in the nearby Beechworth wine region - at the foothills of the beautiful North-East Victorian Alps. Planting commenced in 1982 and the property is now devoted solely to Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Shiraz. A separate planting of Nebbiolo has also been established close to the Beechworth township at Red Hill. Total area under vines at the Giaconda Estate Vineyard is now 4 hectares. Annual wine production is approximately 2,500 dozen bottles.

Originally purchased in the 1950s as part of the larger grazing farm 'Bundaleer', 'Bindi' is a 170-hectare farm of which 7 hectares are planted to Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. Fifteen hectares are dedicated to managed plantation eucalypts for high grade furniture timber whilst the remainder of the land is maintained as remnant bushland and important indigenous grasslands.

The Bindi vineyard is the fundamental focus of the family's endeavors. Their vineyard and winemaking philosophy is to seek balance and purity in the expression of various individual vineyard sites and this philosophy is applied to farming and conservation.

The Henschke family's grape growing and winemaking tradition spans six generations, from outstanding sustainable vineyards in Eden Valley, Barossa Valley and the Adelaide Hills. The small-medium wine business has an annual crush of 700 tonnes and employs around 50 staff.

Stephen and Prue Henschke manage the 105 hectares of vineyard, spanning from Eden Valley to Lenswood in the Adelaide Hills wine region.

There are many things that make Vasse Felix the special place it is: the incredible environment and climate of Margaret River, their secure family ownership, their treasured heritage, and their priceless vineyards. But above all, it's the dedication of the entire team to continue Dr Cullity's original aim for Vasse Felix: "to make the best possible wine".

The introduction of Penfolds Grange in 1951 forever changed the landscape of Australian fine wine. Peter Gago, Penfolds Chief Winemaker and only the 4th custodian of Grange, relishes the opportunity to bring Penfolds to the world stage and is an enthusiastic ambassador and natural educator. Penfolds came to the attention of the US market when 1990 Grange was Wine Spectator's 'Wine of the Year'. Since then, Penfolds Grange has become one of the most collectable wines of the world and was honored to grace the front cover, once again, of Wine Spectator, with declarations of Grange as Australia's Icon.

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Torbreck

Barossa Valley, South Australia

Torbreck, founded in 1994 by David Powell, is situated at Marananga on the western ridge of the Barossa. Since that time he has produced some of the world's finest 'Rhone varietal' wines, exclusively from Barossa fruit; this has been acknowledged by the wine press in Europe, America and Australia. The overwhelming majority of his vines are dry-grown, nearly all are 80 - 125 years old and are tended and harvested by hand.

The wines have an extraordinary combination of power, intensity, complexity and great finesse, and bearing in mind the age of the vines and the laughably low yields, no Torbreck wine could ever be accused of being heavy, cloying or over-extracted.

Mount Pleasant Wines was established in 1921 by winemaker Maurice O'Shea, regarded by many as a Master Blender and the pioneer of Australian table wine.

Recognising O'Shea's talents, Griffith-based winery, McWilliam's Wines, acquired Mount Pleasant 1941, retaining O'Shea as the Chief Winemaker until his passing in 1956.

To this day, Mount Pleasant continues to produce wines from their estate-owned vineyards in the Hunter Valley, some of which are among the oldest in the region. It's precisely these vineyards which have helped cement Mount Pleasant's reputation as an iconic Hunter Valley winery.

Mr. Anderson is a self-taught winemaker (well, almost self-taught: he did look up information on pH levels in a winemaking book once) yet consistently produces more inspired wine than any gaggle of enology school graduates could ever hope to make. He is completely hands-on from the planting of his vineyards all the way through bottling the finished wine. He even loads up his van and delivers the wines personally to his mailing list clients all over Australia! Visiting David is like visiting a mad scientist. He's got maverick single barrels, experimental barrels, wines made for friends, odds and ends all over the place. Everything is made in the inimitable Duck style. There's a dust-covered chemistry set in the corner that David points to and laughs at as he passes by. He makes wine by intuition rather than by formula.
