Welcome to the Pane e Vino Wine Bar & Academy! It is my honor to welcome you into our home to explore the world through wine, one glass at a time. We are excited to offer you a highly-curated wine list with over 250 individual bottlings, *all available by the glass*. Wine selections will be changing regularly, and we also offer flights, barrel-aged cocktails, specialty cheeses, and charcuterie.

As a concert pianist, I have enjoyed the remarkable opportunity to travel and explore the world. My love for food and wine began as a 19 year old when I took my first trip to France for concerts in the Loire Valley. I was treated to incredible food and wine, and experienced the central place that these delights had in the daily lives of my hosts. I was picked up at the airport by a jolly Frenchman named Claude in a vintage WWII American Army Jeep and taken immediately to lunch which included bottle of Loire Valley Rosé! While living in New York, I had my first tastes of fine dining and began buying and tasting wines that had life and character, starting primarily with the wines of Châteauneuf-du-Pape from France's Rhône Valley. By the time I started my doctoral degree, I was fully committed to studying, experiencing, and tasting wines from around the world, and started a small but enjoyable cellar, buying wines at auction and beginning to understand the intricacies of the winemaking process. In 2006, my wife and I made our first trip to Italy, tasting wines from Montalcino, Super Tuscans from around Tuscany, and incredible Syrah from Cortona. I was hooked. The wines of Italy became my passion and I began an exploration that continues today. We got engaged on a trip to Napa in 2008, and our mutual exploration of the wine world has never stopped!

In 2010, I founded a contemporary music festival in Cortona, Italy, and began leading groups of musicians (up to 40 people) on tastings at some of the finest wineries in Tuscany. During these annual adventures, my wife and I would enjoy vacation time following our festival, and began visiting dozens of wineries and regions around Europe, making lifelong friends and experiencing many incredible encounters with amazing winemakers and chefs.

In 2019, I founded Uncorked Pianist, LLC as a new venture to share my passion for wine and food with others through tastings, tours, personal cellar management, and other wine-related events. This led to my completion of certifications and exams in 2021 from the Court of Master Sommeliers (Certified Sommelier), Wine & Spirits Education Trust (Level 3 Award in Wine), and Society of Wine Educators (Certified Specialist in Wine), and the development of the East Lawrence Wine Academy & Tasting Room, now known as Pane e Vino.

Pane e Vino is where I hope to recreate many of the experiences I have had in Italy, where I have been invited into the homes of winemakers and shared glasses and stories about their culture, history, and the deep passion they have for their work. As a work/live space, you will be entering our living room and enjoying wines, cheeses, and charcuteries all curated from my own experiences. Weekly classes discussing wine regions, individual grape varieties, and the winemaking process will be features of our programming, while the Tasting Room will be open for regular service on the weekends, and free concerts of classical music will be offered each month. In addition, I will be offering guided tours to wine regions around the world that will include highly personalized services and experiences. I look forward to welcoming you to the Tasting Room!

Pane e Vino is excited to offer a comprehensive wine list featuring over 250 individual selections with every wine (including champagne and sparkling wine!) available by either the glass or by the bottle. Small pours of either 2 or 3 ounces can be combined together to create flights of your own design, or you can have us create a flight for you. Wines are organized by the primary grape variety, and range in price from \$20/bottle to over \$300/bottle, with special attention given to small producers, natural/organic/biodynamic producers, and winemakers/owners from underrepresented communities.

Small plates are listed on our daily menu, which also features special flights and discounted wines by the glass.

Classes / Dinners / Tastings

Pane e Vino offers regular classes, wine dinners, and special tastings covering the world's wine regions, grapes, producers, and cultures. Classes are by reservation only and are usually limited to 10 guests per class. Please visit our website to learn more and RSVP.
