Sparkling Wine

Stift Klosterneuburg KLOSTERSEKT NV

It has refreshing flavors such as green apple and citrus, and is rich in acid and minerals. A wine that has been exposed to yeast for 9 months to extract umami and goes well with dashi.

Gesellmann Blaufränkisch Rose Brut 2015

Organic farming brings out the elegance of the grapes. In addition to the flavor of red fruits such as cherries and berries, it also has a spicy feel and is rich in beautiful acidity. Fermented and aged in the bottle for 40 months, the fine, creamy bubbles envelop the umami of the ingredients.

Leth Roter Veltliner Klassik 2021

Flavors such as baked apples and aged citrus fruits have a pleasant bitterness typical of the Gris variety, and a long aftertaste. High acidity and low residual sugar are in harmony. It is a local grape variety with a small production volume in Austria.

A historic winery where the house where Beethoven lived and composed his 9th symphony still exists. Traditional Viennese mixed wine. It is dry, with a firm acidity and flavors of grapefruit, nuts, herbs and citrus.

A world heritage vineyard along the Danube. A wine with flavors such as ripe white peaches, fresh acidity and a firm structure. The hard minerals are also outstanding, and it goes well with Ayu (sweetfish) and Sansai (wild vegetables).

Hajszan-Neumann Wiener Gemischter Satz Ried Weisleitens 2018

The next maker acquired by Mr. Wieninger, who increased the reputation of Gemischter Satz (mixed planting and mixed brewing). Because of the north-facing slope, it has crisp acidity and umami. In addition, it has a salty minerality that makes it a perfect pairing with shellfish.

Roland Velich, the wine maker, who visited the Tsukiji market with our restaurant sushi chef, later wanted to make a white wine to pair with Japanese fish. The umami that gently envelops the food and the rich minerality that spreads in the mouth are unique.

The wine is actively exposed to the air to bring out the rich and mature flavor, and by blending wines from 3 vintages, the wine has a wonderful balance of fruit and acidity.

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Orange Wine

Malat Raw Gelber Traminer 2020

Orange wine is a white wine made by soaking (fermenting) grape skins and twigs in grape juice, just like red wine. In addition to lychee, citrus, and refreshing sourness, the individuality of the variety, such as umami and bitterness, and the goodness of orange wine pair well with Japanese food.

Heinrich Roter Traminer Freyheit 2021

An unfiltered and unfinned wine made from grapes harvested in mineral-rich soil and aged for 17 months in an amphora. A gorgeous fruit incense, a salty taste derived from the soil, a beautiful acid, and the umami of yeast are mixed together. A very high-quality orange wine, it is excellent to pair with bright fish and dishes using dashi soup stock.

Groszer Wein Gemischter Satz Rose 2021

Gemischter Satz (mixed plantation mixed brew) has a fresh taste of red fruits, umami, and a salty minerality that goes well with Japanese food. Overall very elegant and a good pairing with almost all Edomae sushi.

It has aromas of black cherry and raspberry mixed with roasted notes. The tannin is also soft, and it is a good pairing with boiled conger eel, tuna zuke, and white fish boiled in soy sauce. It is a wine that represents the oldest production area in Austria and is only made in good years.

Red wine made by a team of three wineries representing Austria. Aromas include blackberry and ripe cherry, along with coffee and toast. The tannins are firm and the taste is juicy. Recommended for those who are looking for a wine with a strong taste.

Hiedler Pinot Noir G-Stück 2019

G stands for “Ganz” (whole) in German, meaning that the entire Pinot Noir is expressed in wine. In addition to the red fruit flavor and light aging nuances like roasted almonds, you can feel herbs and spices. It is a wine with a very long aftertaste, with a mix of acidity and fruitiness. Hand-harvested grapes from the best single vineyard are extracted by stepping in a vat like 1000 years ago. Naturally fermented and barrel aged.

This wine was decided to be imported to Japan because Okada of our shop visited the winery and purchased it directly. It is made very carefully using the biodynamic method. It has ripe citrus, herb and spice flavors combined with acidity. It has a gentle umami flavor that complements the taste of Japanese soup stock and enhances the taste of meals.
